THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 2015, The Sounds swept the Redbirds in a double-header in Memphis. Nashville took game one 3-2 and game two 7-3. Barry Zito and Zach Neal each pitched seven-inning complete games and Jason Pridie hit a home run in each game.

Today's Game: The Hot Chickens are back for the final time in 2023 against the Columbus Clippers this afternoon. Yesterday's cancellation makes today's game the rubber match in the five-game series. Right-hander Caleb Boushley starts for Nashville. He'll face Logan Allen who gets the ball for Columbus.

Caleb Boushley: 29-year-old Caleb Boushley gets the ball today for the Hot Chickens. The right-hander is 5-4 with a 4.33 ERA (79.0 IP/38 ER) in 2023. He spun his first quality start of the season last time out in Memphis, allowing one run over 7.0 innings in a win. In his last five outings, Boushley has a 2.83 ERA (28.2 IP/9 ER) and 25 strikeouts. He ranks among league leaders in starts (T-1st), WHIP (5th, 1.32), ERA (6th), opponent average (7th, .255) and innings (8th). The Hortonville, Wisconsin native was named the 2022 Sounds Pitcher of the Year after going 12-2 with a 3.25 ERA in 25 starts. The Brewers acquired Boushley in the Triple-A phase of the Rule 5 Draft in 2021. He was originally drafted in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Padres out of UW-La Crosse.

Logan Allen: 24-year-old Logan Allen starts for Columbus in the series finale. The left-hander is 0-0 with a 1.04 ERA (17.1 IP/2 ER) in four starts for the Clippers. He's also made 12 starts for Cleveland in 2023 (3-2, 3.47 ERA, 62.1 IP, 66 H, 25 R, 24 ER). In his last start, Allen pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in the Clippers 19-2 rout of Nashville in the series opener on July 4. He struck out four on 49 pitches (30 strikes) before his start was cut short due to a rain delay. Allen had his contract selected on April 23 and made his MLB debut that day vs. Miami, getting the win (6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 8 K). In his only previous outing against Nashville, Allen took the loss on July 6, 2022, giving up five runs (all earned) in 4.0 innings. The southpaw was selected in the second round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft.

Bolt's Big Knock: Outfielder Skye Bolt ripped a crucial three-run triple in the fourth inning of Friday's contest on his way to a four RBI game. It was his first game with a triple and at least three RBI since April 20, 2019 with Triple-A Las Vegas at Fresno. It was Nashville's first bases-loaded triple since Jonathan Davis lined one in a 7-0 win vs. Norfolk on June 10, 2022.

One and Done: Friday's Robert Gasser was ejected after one pitch, which hit Columbus leadoff man Brayan Rocchio. He is the first Nashville starting pitcher to not record an out in a start since before 2005. Gasser is also the first starting pitcher in the full-season minor leagues to throw just one pitch since May 20, 2021. On that day, RHP Brett Kennedy threw just one pitch for Triple-A El Paso against Sugar Land - he was hit by a line drive and left the game. The last starter in full-season affiliated baseball to be ejected after one pitch was Double-A Chattanooga's RHP Mario Alvarez on June 29, 2010 against a Huntsville lineup that featured a number of future Sounds.

Rare Cancellation: The canceled game at First Horizon Park was just the second in park history and first since the the home finale was rained out vs. Iowa on August 22, 2017. With tomorrow being the final game before the All-Star break, the teams were unable to play a doubleheader today.

Putting the League on Lock: Despite a tumultuous series so far, Nashville hurlers continue to have the lowest ERA in Triple-A (4.21) ahead of Oklahoma City (4.40). Nashville pitchers lead the level in WHIP (1st, 1.37) and rank among league leaders in fewest hits allowed (2nd, 685), runs allowed (2nd, 395), opponent average (2nd, .248) and home runs allowed (2nd, 84).

Congratulations Abner! Right-hander Abner Uribe was recalled by Milwaukee and made his Major League debut against the Reds, pitching a couple of innings. He is the seventh player to appear for the Sounds and make their MLB debut this season, joining INF Brice Turang & RHP Gus Varland (3/30), OF Blake Perkins (4/19), RHP Lucas Erceg (5/19, w/ OAK), INF Andruw Monasterio (5/28) and LHP Clayton Andrews (7/1).

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect, who is on the injured list, and newcomer right-handed pitcher Justin Jarvis is the No. 30 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 647-555 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Boushley spun a beauty last time out in Memphis on July 3, tossing a season-high 7.0 innings and allowing just one run on four hits. He struck out seven on 97 pitches and 68 strikes. It was Boushley's first quality start of the season. He earned the win in Nashville's 8-2 victory.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley is making his third career start against Columbus, with both prior starts coming at Huntington Park last July. He is 1-0 with a 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP/2 ER) and seven strikeouts.
