# **INDY BITS**

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Edward Olivares and Jose Rojas went back-to-back with home runs, and Thomas Harrington tossed a career-high tying 7.0 shutout innings as the Indianapolis Indians defeated the St. Paul Saints, 3-0, on Saturday night at Victory Field. The Indians rode a 1-0 lead after a run-scoring groundout by Nick Yorke in the first inning against Randy Dobnak. With the Saints offense silenced, Olivares and Rojas tacked on a pair with their two-out solo shots in the sixth inning.

**GONE STREAKING:** The Indianapolis Indians improved to 10-1 vs. St. Paul this season with their fifth consecutive victory in last night's shutout. It is their second five-plus game win streak coming out of the All-Star break following a nine-game win streak from July 23-Aug. 1, which ranks as the second-longest win streak in the Victory Field era. Since the All-Star break, the Indians are tied for the seventh most wins in Minor League Baseball and have the third-most in the International League, trailing Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (19) and Columbus (18)

**THOMAS THE TRAIN ENGINE:** Pittsburgh Pirates No. 5 prospect Thomas Harrington dazzled in his third Triple-A start last night, tossing a career-high tying 7.0 shutout innings with two hits and two strikeouts to earn his first victory in an Indians uniform. The 23-year-old right-hander tossed 7.0 perfect innings before being tagged for his first base hit on a ground ball through the right-side hole. It was his fifth career 7.0-inning outing and third this season after logging his last on July 10 with Double-A Altoona vs. Bowie. Harrington was named the Eastern League Player of the Month for July after going 2-0 with a 0.70 ERA (2er/25.2ip), 32 strikeouts, a 0.82 WHIP and .170 batting average against in four starts prior to being promoted to Indianapolis on Aug. 4.

SHUT 'EM OUT: Thomas Harrington, Ryan Borucki and Geronimo Franzua combined for the Indians fifth shutout this season and second in as many weeks as the pitching staff shut out the Nashville Sounds at First Horizon Park on Aug. 9. It was Indianapolis' third shutout of the Saints this season after logging a pair of 9.0-inning shutouts against St. Paul on April 17 and 21 at Victory Field. Four of their five shutouts this season have come at home against St. Paul and Indianapolis' the Saints St. Paul on April 17 and 21 at Victory Field.

**LET HIM COOK:** Billy Cook, who was traded to Pittsburgh from Baltimore in exchange for RHP Patrick Reilly on July 30, went 3-for-4 with a run and double last night, and has now hit safely in all five games vs. St. Paul this series. His three-hit performance ties his season high, last matched on Aug. 4 vs. Toledo — his second game with Indianapolis. Since making his organization debut with the Indians on Aug. 3, Cook ranks among International League leaders in extrabase hits (T-1st, 8), total bases (2nd, 29), doubles (T-2nd, 6), OPS (5th, 1.134), hits (T-5th, 17), slugging percentage (6th, .674), on-base percentage (8th, .460) and batting average (8th, .395). Cook has now reached base safely in 15 of 17 games since July 26 (1) with Triple-A Norfolk with a .456 batting average (26-for-57), 12 runs, nine doubles, one triple, three home runs and 12 RBI between both teams.

THREE FOR OLLIE: Edward Olivares joined Billy Cook in going 3-for-4 last night, also launching his second Triple-A home run of the season in the sixth inning to plate an insurance run for the Indians. His three hits marked a season-high, which was last matched on Aug. 4 vs. Toledo. His home run was also his first since the last homestand at Victory Field, when he launched a solo shot on July 31 vs. the Mud Hens. In 18 total games with the Indians since being optioned by Pittsburgh, he is hitting .273 (18-for-66) with 13 runs, four extra-base hits and six RBI. Olivares also adds an element of speed to the basepaths for the Indians, with his seven stolen bases tied for seventh-most among all Indians baserunners this season.

JOSE'S HOMERS: Jose Rojas followed Edward Olivares' home run with one of his own on the very next pitch. It was the slugger's 21st home run of the season and third with Indianapolis after beginning the campaign with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. The 21 home runs best his 2022 total of 20 homers and are his most since launching a career-high 31 in 2019 with Triple-A Salt Lake.

BACK-TO-BACK: Edward Olivares and Jose Rojas went back-to-back with home runs in the sixth inning last night, marking the third pair of consecutive home runs for Indians batters this season. They join Billy McKinney / Matt Gorski (April 6 [2] vs. Memphis) and Gilberto Celestino / Grant Koch (June 13 at Jacksonville) to hit back-to-back homers this season.

TODAY: The Indians will look for their second six-game sweep of the season today and first at Victory Field since moving to Minor League Baseball's weekly format in 2021. They opened the series with four consecutive comeback victories and followed it up with a shutout last night vs. the St. Paul Saints, Triple-A affiliate of the Minnesota Twins. The Saints visited Victory Field from April 16-21, with the Indians taking five of six games. The two teams have one more series scheduled in the 2024 season, with Indianapolis heading to the Twin Cities for the final six games of the campaign from Sept. 17-22. Closing out the series for the Indians today is RHP Aaron Shortridge (1-2, 4.87), who has never faced St. Paul in six career Triple-A starts. Countering for St. Paul is RHP Andrew Morris (0-0, 1.50), who made his Triple-A debut with a quality start on Tuesday (6.0ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 1hr, 1bb, 2k).

THIS DATE IN 2019: Facing a five-run deficit in the bottom of the ninth vs. Lehigh Valley, free bases keyed a comeback win for the Indians. The inning opened with a Christian Kelley strikeout but was followed by four consecutive walks to keep the bases loaded for Ke'Bryan Hayes, who was 0-for-4 on the day. A wild pitch scored Hunter Owen to bring the Indians within three runs, and Hayes then crushed a 2-2 slider into the left field lawn to tie the game. Kelley went on to hit a walk-off single in the 10th as the Indians won 8-7 in one of the more dramatic comeback victories in recent Indians history.
