PACKED HOUSE: The Omaha Storm Chasers defeated the Iowa Cubs, 6-2, on Saturday in front of 7,061 fans at Werner Park, the largest home crowd of the season. The Storm Chasers have hosted their three biggest crowds of the season in each of the last three home games. **OF Kyle Isbel** hit a solo home run in the second inning and stole his 20th base of the season in the fourth. **INF/OF Ryan McBroom** drove in three with an RBI single in the fourth and two-run double in the fifth. **INF Lucius Fox** tied a career high with three stolen bases, including two in the sixth when he scored Omaha's sixth run. **RHP Eddie Butler** tossed 5.1 shutout innings, allowing just three hits.

20-20 VISION: **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** stole his sixth base at the Triple-A level and 20th of the season on Saturday to clinch the first 20+ home run and 20+ stolen base season for a Kansas City Royals' minor league player since **OF Alex Gordon** hit 29 home runs and stole 22 bases for Double-A Wichita in 2006. Gordon earned Texas League Player of the Year and *Baseball America* Minor League Player of the Year honors. **OF Edward Olivares** (13 HR / 12 SB) is Omaha's only other player with double-digit home runs and steals, while **OF Anderson Miller** (12 HR / 9 SB), **OF Kyle Isbel** (9 HR / 20 SB), **OF Rudy Martin** (8 HR / 18 SB) are also approaching double-digits in those categories.

20+ HOMER CLUB: With MJ Melendez (30), Bobby Witt Jr. (24), Ryan McBroom (21) and Nick Pratto (21), the Omaha Storm Chasers are the only team in Minor League Baseball with four players that have hit 20+ home runs this season. The next closest is Great Lakes (High-A, LAD) which has three players with 20+ home runs. There are three teams that claim two players with 20+ home runs. Melendez' 30 home runs second in Minor League Baseball behind Miami Marlins prospect Griffin Conine (30).

WHAT MORE CAN YOU SAY?: Through 23 games with the Storm Chasers, **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** is batting .293/.364/.606 with seven doubles, eight home runs, 19 RBIs, 23 runs scored, and six stolen bases. He is currently in the midst of an eight-game hitting streak (8/6-pres.) and 18-game on-base streak (7/25-pres.), his longest such streaks at the Triple-A level. The top prospect in the Royals organization and the No. 3 prospect in baseball per *Baseball America*, Witt Jr. was named Triple-A East Player of the Week for Aug. 2-8 after batting .296 (8-for-27) with four home runs—including his first career grand slam—in six games against Columbus.

McBOOM GOES THE DYNAMITE: **INF/OF Ryan McBroom** leads Triple-A East in both home runs (22) and RBIs (65) after driving in three in Saturday's win. McBroom is also second in runs scored (57), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (34), and tied for seventh in total hits (83). He has hit cleanup in Omaha's lineup in 74 of the team's 87 games. In a team-high 82 games, McBroom is batting .266/.336/.522. His 22 home runs are four shy of tying his career high of 26, which he set in 117 games with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in 2019 before being traded to Kansas City.

OUTSTANDING OLIVARES: **OF Edward Olivares** recorded his 23rd multi-hit game of the season on Friday with two doubles, making him one of two members of the Storm Chasers with double-digit doubles (11) and home runs (13). Olivares is currently second in the league in average (.321), seventh in on-base percentage (.390), and third in slugging percentage (.575) in 55 games with Omaha. Olivares has been recalled and optioned by Kansas City five times this season between May 30 and Aug. 10. In five stints (20 games) with the Royals, Olivares is 14-for-57 (.246) with four home runs.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO: In addition to leading Triple-A East in home runs (145), the Storm Chasers are also tops in the league in stolen bases (105). **OF Kyle Isbel** leads the team with 20 steals, while **INF Lucius Fox** and **OF Edward Olivares** have 12, **OF Anderson Miller** has nine, and **OF Rudy Martin** has eight. The Chasers stole five bases in a single game for the fourth time this season on Saturday, as Fox swiped three bags on Saturday, tying his single-game best for steals for the second time this year. Omaha's 105 steals have come in 125 attempts, giving the team an 84.0% success rate that ranks second in the league.

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Jackson Kowar** makes his 14th start (15th appearance) for Omaha and his second start in this series against Iowa. On Tuesday, Kowar pitched a season-low 1.2 innings, allowing a season-high five runs on five hits with all five runs coming in the second inning. The right-hander is currently second in the league with 93 strikeouts while his 3.34 ERA would be the best mark in Triple-A East if he had enough innings to qualify (5.0 IP shy).

FOR IOWA: **RHP Keegan Thompson** makes his fourth start with Iowa since being optioned from Chicago-NL on 7/27 and his second start of the series. He tossed 4.0 scoreless innings on Tuesday, allowing three hits while striking out two and walking one. In 27 outings (one start) which Chicago (NL), Thompson posted a 2.21 ERA in 40.2 innings with 43 strikeouts and 22 walks.
