SS JESÚS MADE (77) and **1B BLAKE BURKE** (87) enter today in the top-4 for single-season RBI in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015)... The current single-season record is 89, set by **OF JACKSON CHOURIO** in 2023... The pair represent 2 of the 4 Southern League players with at least 70+ RBI this season.

☞ **OF RECE HINDS** (98, CHA, 2023) is the only Southern League player with 90+ RBI in a season since 2017... **OF TYLER O'NEILL** (102, JAX, 2016) is the last Southern League hitter with a 100 RBI season.

HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

Entering today, the Shuckers have hit 36 home runs in their last 13 games, including at least 1 in 12 games... Across 37 games in the second half, the Shuckers have hit 72 home runs, the most in MiLB and tied for the 13th-most by a Southern League team in the 2nd Half since 2005.

☞ The Shuckers need 16 home runs over the final 32 games of the season to break the franchise record of 154, set in 2022.

GUILARTE'S FIRST

INF DANIEL GUILARTE (1-for-2) recorded his 1st Double-A home run and extra-base hit on Friday night... It marked his 1st home run since June 12, 2026, against Great Lakes with the High-A Wisconsin Timber Rattlers... Entering today, 20 of the 23 players to appear in a game for the Shuckers this season have recorded at least 1 home run.

EYES ON THE CROWN (THE TRIPLE CROWN)

Entering today, **1B BLAKE BURKE** leads the Southern League in all three Triple Crown categories, including a .285 average, 30 home runs and 87 RBI... No Southern League hitter has won the Triple Crown since **1B/OF MIKE REINBACH** (.346, 30 HR, 109 RBI) in 1972 with the Asheville Orioles.

RAKE BURKE

On August 1, **1B BLAKE BURKE** joined **3B ANDREW FISCHER** as the second Brewers minor league player since 2001 with a 30-home-run season... Burke became the 17th player to achieve the feat in Brewers minor league history.

☞ Burke became the 1st Southern League player to record a 30 home run season since **OF ADAM BRETT WALKER** (CHA) in 2015... Burke is the fastest Double-A player since at least 2005 to reach 30 home runs, needing 88 games to reach the mark.

GONE FISH-ING

3B ANDREW FISCHER recorded his 34th home run of the season on July 31, tied with **C BILL FOLEY** (1978) and **OF SIXTO LEZCANO** (1974) for the 4th-most by a Brewers Minor League player in franchise history (since 1970)... His 34 home runs mark the most by a Brewers Minor League hitter since 1985.

☞ Fischer needs 6 more home runs to become the 2nd Brewers Minor League player with a 40 home run season... He would become the first since **CF GORMAN THOMAS** (51) in 1974.
