The Bowie Baysox fell to the Harrisburg Senators last night by a 5-1 final score. The tone was set early, as a leadoff double by Cesar Prieto in the top of the first was cancelled out when Prieto was thrown out trying to tag and advance to third on a Heston Kjerstad fly out. Just after that, in the bottom half of the first, Baysox starter Houston Roth walked leadoff hitter Robert Hassell III before allowing a two-run homer to the Senators' JT Arruda, giving Harrisburg a 2-0 lead. Still, like many starts for the Baysox this season, Roth was able to settle in after the early damage, as did not allow another base runner in his four frames of work. Bowie would threaten with base runners in five of the six innings they faced Harrisburg starter Jackson Rutledge, but were only able to scratch a single run across in the top of the fifth via a Randy Florentino fielder's choice RBI. The Baysox stranded the tying run at third in the sixth inning after a Coby Mayo one-out triple. The Senators immediately stole momentum in the bottom half, as Baysox right-hander Carlos Tavera struggled to hit the zone in both of his innings out of the bullpen, allowing two singles and two walks as part of a three-run inning for Harrisburg to take a 5-1 lead. The Baysox would threaten in the eighth and ninth, but ultimately left 10 runners on base in the defat.

### **TODAY'S OPPONENT**

The Harrisburg Senators enter tonight at a record of 12-15. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators currently occupy 5th place in the Southwest division and are 3.5 games ahead of the Baysox. Harrisburg has a .211 team average and has hit the fewest home runs (16) of any team in the Eastern League, but has also allowed the second-fewest (16) to go along with a 4.00 staff ERA. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the No. 2 Nationals prospect and No. 30 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, Robert Hassell III, who recently returned from the injured list. He is one of five Top 30 Nationals prospects on the Harrisburg roster, including right-handed pitchers Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 28 WSH), along with left-hander Mitchell Parker (No. 24 WSH) and catcher Drew Millas (No. 30 WSH). The Senators are led by first-year manager Delino DeShields, who has prior coaching and management experience through the various levels of the Reds' organization, in addition to be a former player for the Orioles' organization and playing for the Baysox in 1999.

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Mitchell Parker is projected to get the ball tonight for Harrisburg. Through five starts this season, Parker has really struggled with traffic on the base paths. He's allowed 15 runs (14 earned) off 16 hits and 17 walks in 20.2 innings, but does have 24 strikeouts. His walk rate currently sits at 17.7%, a nearly 10% increase from two seasons ago. Despite these struggles, Parker is coming off what is easily his best start of the season, as he fired six innings of one-run baseball last Thursday in New Hampshire, yielding just two hits and one walk, while striking out four. Parker is the No. 24 prospect in the Nationals's organization, per MLB Pipeline, and has been an organizational all-star for Washington each of the past two seasons. He posted a 2.88 ERA last season for High-A Wilmington in 100 innings - a league-low for any pitcher with 100 innings or more. A fifth-round pick of the Nationals in 2020 out of San Jacinto Junior College - the same school as last night's starter for Harrisburg, Jackson Rutledge. Parker fautres a low-90s fastball, low-80s curveball, along with a changeup and splitter.

### MOUND REBOUND?

After getting off to a strong start, walks and home runs have haunted the Baysox pitching staff in recent games. Bowie arms have allowed the most home runs in the Eastern League this season at 34, with 14 of them allowed in the past seven games. In addition, Bowie has become susceptible to walks in recent contests as well. The Baysox have lost three of their last four games, and in those three losses, they have allowed a combined 20 walks, after having the second-lowest walk total in Double-A (84) entering that stretch.

### **HESTON IS BESTON**

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad launched his sevnth and eighth home runs of the season last week, as he currently sits second in the Eastern League in that category. Beyond the home runs, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - sitting third in the Eastern League in slugging percentage (.638) and second in OPS (1.021) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (14) and total bases (60). Kjerstad has the second-most home runs and the most extra-base hits throughout the Orioles' system, while his OPS is third best and his slugging percentage is second. Kjerstad's standout start to the season earned him Orioles Minor League Player of the Month honors for April.

### HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with his 39 hits and a .375 batting average. Prieto is currently riding a seven-game hitting streak, while registering multiple hits in his past four starts and 12 multi-hit contests in his first 25 games of 2023. Last night's 3-4 performance was also the fourth three-hit game for Prieto this season. His 11-game hitting streak last month is the second-longest in the Eastern League this season and is also the longest streak for any Orioles minor leaguer. Prieto's leads the Baltimore farm in both average and hits as well.

### TANDEM TROUBLES

Bowie's abundance of starting pitching experience is leading to a statistical split based on when each pitcher enters the game. Bowie has had eight different pitchers start multiple games this season, and those pitchers sport a 3.32 ERA with 123 strikeouts in 111 innings when they start their respective games. When those same pitchers enter games as relievers, they sport a collective 6.49 ERA, with only 38 strikeouts in 43 innings.

#### **COACHING STAFF**

#### Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 14-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the heim of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles sys-tem. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlanic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron. Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's Japking career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson as Japked two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Priching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Hermann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox develo-other filling the same role for Aberdean last season.
