**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Altoona Curve, 10-6. **Allen Cerda** opened the scoring with a two-run homer in the second inning, his second in six games played with Richmond. In the third, **Kervin Pichardo** hit a solo homer for Altoona to close the score to 2-1. **Will Wilson** brought in a run with a groundout in the third to open a 3-1 lead but **Tsung-Che Cheng** responded with a solo homer in the top of the fifth to make the score 3-2. In the bottom of the fifth, **Carter Howell** hit an RBI triple and then scored on a groundout by **Wilson**. **Christian Koss** hit a two-run double to extend the lead to 7-2 in the sixth. In the top of the seventh, the Curve scored four runs to close the score to 7-6. The Flying Squirrels added three insurance runs in the bottom of the eighth. **Andy Thomas** hit an RBI triple, **Koss** added a run with a single and **Grant McCray** hit an RBI single to open a 10-6 lead. **Carson Ragsdale** picked up his second win of the year with a season-high 5.2 innings, allowing two runs. He also tied his season high with nine strikeouts. **Nick Swiney** threw 1.1 scoreless innings and **Tanner Kiest** recorded the final four outs for his second save, striking out three.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, in the third of a six-game series at The Diamond. This series marks the first meetings between the two teams this year. The Curve return to Richmond for a six-game series from Aug. 20-25. The Flying Squirrels play two six-game sets in Altoona this year, the first from July 30-Aug. 4 and the last to close the regular season from Sept. 10-15.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 13-6 in their last 19 games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They had won five-of-six in two straight series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond last week.

**THE CURVE** are in last place in the Southwest Division. They are 2-6 in their last eight games since May 26. Altoona's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 3), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 6), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 8), OF/1B Jase Bowen (No. 19) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26). There are seven Altoona players on Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects list, including Chandler (No. 3), Solometo (No. 5), Harrington (No. 6), Cheng (No. 7), Ashcraft (No. 10), Bowen (No. 26) and Gonzalez (No. 27).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Nick Sinacola** makes his Double-A debut. He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. He last pitched last Tuesday at Hillsboro and worked five scoreless innings in a no-decision. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (.190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. *For more on Sinacola, see page two.*

**FOR ALTOONA:** Right-hander **Braxton Ashcraft** makes his 10th start of the season. He last pitched on Friday against the Sea Dogs and allowed one run over six innings with seven strikeouts. This season, he is ranked 10th in the Eastern League in WHIP (1.14). Last season, Ashcraft pitched at three levels with the Pirates organization, going 0-3 with a 2.39 ERA in 19 starts. He reached Double-A with Altoona in June and went 0-1 with a 1.35 ERA across eight starts. He has made one start in his career against the Flying Squirrels, throwing three scoreless innings on April 4, 2023 at PNG Field. Ashcraft was selected by the Pirates in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Robinson High School in Texas. He is currently rated by MLB.com as the No. 6 Pirates prospect and No. 10 by Baseball America.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,084).

**TAKE IT FOR GRANTED:** In his last 20 games since May 15, **Grant McCray** is batting .354 (23-for-65) with two homers, eight doubles, three triples, nine walks, 10 RBIs and 15 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .219. McCray is tied for second in the Eastern League in triples (3), tied for fourth in doubles (13) and tied for fifth in extra-base hits (22). Last Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week after he hit .550 (11-for-20) with a homer, three doubles, two triples, four walks, eight runs scored and five RBIs for the previous weeks' series in Bowie. Prior to going 0-for-1 on Friday night, McCray had reached base in 14 consecutive games dating back to May 12, which was tied for the third longest active streak in the Eastern League and is the longest by a Flying Squirrels player so far this season.

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** **Andy Thomas** is batting .327 (17-for-52) over his last 16 games since May 15 with a homer, five doubles, a triple and 13 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .243. Thomas has picked up two hits in five-of-his-last-14 games played dating back to May 16 and has picked up five doubles in that same stretch. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. On Wednesday night, Thomas came off the bench and hit an RBI triple in the eighth inning for an insurance run, the second triple of his professional career.

**OPEN THE GATES:** This season, **Evan Gates** has posted a 1.48 ERA (5 ER/30.1 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League (min. 30 IP). Gates posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) over his first 12 appearances of the season through May 18. After allowing four runs (three earned) in his two outings last week against the Baysox, he pitched 3.1 scoreless innings on Friday against the SeaWolves, the longest outing of his career, and struck out four batters. In that appearance, he issued a walk to the first batter he faced before retiring the next 10 batters in order to finish his night. Gates followed with a six-out save against the Curve in a combined shutout on Tuesday night. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in 2022, Gates has pitched 65 Double-A games, combining for a 3.33 ERA (35 ER/94.2 IP).

**SETTING THE TABLE:** Over his last five games since May 31, **Carter Howell** is batting .429 (9-for-21) with two doubles, a triple, a walk, two RBIs and one run scored. He has picked up two hits in four of those five games, including each of his last three games played. In his 20 games batting in the Flying Squirrels' lineup this year, Howell is batting .309 (25-for-81). He is also batting .349 (15-for-33) when leading off an inning. This season, he is batting .435 (10-for-23) in the first inning.

**BLANK SPACE:** Three of the Flying Squirrels' last four wins have been shutouts. They shut out the SeaWolves twice last week. Last Tuesday, **Hayden Birdsong** covered six scoreless innings before **Nick Swiney** and **Tyler Myrick** worked the final three in a 5-0 win. On Friday night, **Matt Frisbee** started and pitched 4.2 innings before being replaced by **Evan Gates**, who worked a career-high 3.1 innings. Myrick threw a scoreless ninth to close his fourth save of the year. On Tuesday to begin this series, **John Michael Bertrand** pitched six innings, **Mat Olsen** worked a scoreless seventh and Gates retired the final six outs in a 1-0 win over the Curve. The Flying Squirrels' seven shutout wins this season are tied for second-most in the Eastern League with Harrisburg, trailing only Akron with eight.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).
