TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game series with the Somerset Patriots, their only meetings of the season.

LAST TIME OUT: Henry Davis made a statement in his Double-A debut with a go-ahead 2-run homer in the 5th inning and the Curve bullpen made it stand up in a 4-3 win. Jared Triolo added three hits and Luis Ortiz struck out 8 in 4.2 IP to start the game.

HE'S HERE: On Tuesday, May 10 the Curve added C Henry Davis to the active roster. Davis, selected No. 1 Overall in 2021 out of Louisville, is the first position player selected first overall to join the Curve. Previously, three players picked No. 1 overall played for Altoona: RHP Kris Benson (1996 / 2002 Rehab), RHP Bryan Bullington (2001 / 2004 with Curve), and RHP Gerrit Cole (2011 / 2012 with Curve).

Davis and Gonzales (7th overall) account for Pittsburgh's last two first-round draft picks, marking the just the second time in franchise history that Altoona has had two players selected in the top-10 of the draft on the active roster at the same time, first time since RHP Jameson Taillon (2nd Overall) and RHP Gerrit Cole (1st overall) called Peoples Natural Gas Field home in the final weeks of the 2012 season.

AND HE'S OFF TO A GOOD START: Henry Davis reached base three times and rocked a two-run homer in his team debut on Tuesday, May 10. The homer traveled an estimated 407 feet down the left field line and had an exit velocity of 110.

NOTHING LOLO ABOUT THIS: Lolo Sanchez had a solid run of work on Altoona's road trip to Akron and Erie. In his 12 games on the trip, Sanchez picked up 7 multi-hit games and batted .359/.480 OBP with 4 2B and 4 RBI. He drew a career-high 4 walks on Wednesday, May 4 in a 12-5 loss to Erie. Entering play on Tuesday, May 10, he ranks 8th in the league in batting average (.301) and T-9th in OBP (.402).

ALL HAIL PEGGY: Entering Wednesday's game with Somerset, Liover Peguero has his name all over the Eastern League leaderboard. He is 2nd in hits (32), 2nd in XBH (13), T-2nd in BA (.333), T-3rd in RBI (19), 5th SLG% (.542)

BURROWED: Altoona's Mike Burrows continued his dominant start to begin the season on the road trip to Akron and Erie. Burrows has been unscored upon in four of his starts this year and allowed 2 runs or fewer in each outing. Following play on Sunday, May 8, he ranks all over the EL Leaderboards: 3rd in ERA (1.35), 4th in WHIP (0.83), 5th in BAA (0.83), T-8th in K's (35) and 9th in IP (26.2).

OFF TO THE SHOW: For the first time in franchise history on Tuesday April 26, Pittsburgh recalled two players to their major league roster on the same day directly from Altoona. With Bryan Reynolds and Cole Tucker hitting the COVID IL, the Pirates brought Jack Suwinski and Tucupita Marcano to the major league roster. Suwinski went 1-for-5 in his major league debut with a single in the 9th inning off Milwaukee's Jose Urena. Marcano went 1-for-2 off the bench with a double in the eighth inning.

Previously only ten players had been called up direct from Altoona with INF Rodolfo Castro being the most recent in 2021. Prior to Castro RHP Nick Kingham was recalled to Pittsburgh in 2018, though before Kingham it hadn't happened since 2008 with RHP Yoslan Herrera. The list of players recalled to Pittsburgh from Altoona includes: C Yamid Haad (1999), LHP Brian O'Connor (2000), RHP Steve Sparks (2000), RHP Ian Snell (2004), OF Ray Sadler (2005), RHP Romulo Sanchez (2007), RHP Luis Munoz (2008), and RHP Yoslan Herrera (2008). RHP Beau Sulser also made his major league debut on Tuesday with Pittsburgh, giving the Curve 176 alumni who have made their way to MLB.

STOLEN HEARTS: Altoona has began the season with an aggressive attitude on the basepaths. The Curve, with 38 stolen bases in 45 tries on the season, are third in the Eastern League 27 games. Hartford leads the league with 56 stolen bases, though Altoona has the 3rd best success rate in the league at 84% (Hartford, 90.3%).

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 34 home runs on the young season, tied for 14th-most by a pitching staff in minor league baseball and second-most in the Eastern League behind Hartford (38). The Curve have allowed a home run in 19 of 28 games (68%) played this year.

THIS RULES: 2022 has several rule changes that will be in effect in the Eastern League. The bases are now 18" in diameter instead of 15". The rule that limited infield shifts, which was in effect in the second half of the 2021 season, requires teams to have two infielders on each side of second base and be on the infield dirt at the time the pitch is thrown is also in effect. As well, pitchers will no longer hit with MLB installing the DH in all games.

THE FIGHTING DAN FIORITO'S: Led by former Yankees farmhand, Dan Fiorito, the Somerset roster is headlined by several top prospects according to MLB.com in the Yankees system including: INF Anthony Volpe (No. 8 overall, No. 1 Yankees), LHP Ken Waldichuk (No. 6), RHP Luis Medina (No. 12), RHP Randy Vasquez (No. 16), OF Brandon Lockridge (No. 18), C Josh Breaux (No. 26), and OF Elijah Dunham (No. 27).

ON THE BUMP FOR THE EVIL EMPIRE: Mitch Spence takes the ball for Somerset this morning, his fifth start of the season. Drafted in the 10th round out of Division II USC-Aiken. Another notable alum from USC-Aiken is former MLB pitcher Roberto Hernandez who pitched 17 seasons in the majors with 11 different teams, including the Pirates in 2006 when he went 0-3 with a 2.93 ERA in 46 appearances. Spence went 3-6 with a 3.94 ERA in 23 appearances, 20 starts last season at High-A Hudson Valley.

CAREER NOTES

2022: Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Threw 8.2 scoreless innings to start the season, holding opponents to a .077 batting average against before allowing 6 runs on 6 hits, including 2 HR (4 total) in the second inning of his third start of the season on 4/23 vs. New Hampshire... Threw 5.0 scoreless innings on 4/29 at Akron pitching in front of dozens of family and friends. Canal Park is just 35 minutes from his native Massillon, OH... Threw 14.2 scoreless innings in road games to start the year (0.51 ERA in road games)...

2021: Made his professional debut splitting the season between High-A Beloit and Double-A Pensacola in the Marlins system... Combined to go 6-4 with a 4.18 ERA in 21 appearances, 20 starts... Led all Marlins minor leaguers with 136 strikeouts, ranked second in walks with 49, and sixth in the organization with 99.0 innings pitched... Began the season with High-A Beloit and went 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA in four starts in the month of May, struck out 28 batters in 19.1 innings pitched... Struck out a career-high 11 batters in his fourth professional start on May 28 against Peoria, also allowed five hits and walked two in 4.1 innings... Lasted 3.1 innings or shorter in each of his first three starts in the month of June before picked up his third win of the season on June 19 at Peoria, allowing one run on two hits and one walk in 5.0 innings with five strikeouts... Went a career-high 6.0 innings on July 1 vs Wisconsin and struck out seven, allowed two runs on four hits... Came out of the bullpen on July 13 against Quad Cities following a rehab start by Marlins RHP John Curtiss, picked up nine strikeouts in 4.2 innings... Struck out 10 and allowed just one run in 6.0 innings at Cedar Rapids on July 20 in his final start with the Snappers... Made his Double-A debut with Pensacola on July 27 and fired 5.0 no-hit innings against Mississippi with eight strikeouts... Turned in a dominant month of August with Pensacola allowing just six runs in 25.2 innings pitched, good for a 2.10 ERA... Turned in three straight scoreless starts totaling 16.2 innings between August 10-24... Went a career-high 6.2 innings on August 24 at Mississippi on just 79 pitches... Struck out at least seven batters in nine of his 21 appearances on the season... Held Double-A opponents to a .167 batting average against...

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the second round (61st overall) in the 2020 First Year Player Draft out of Ball State, signed on July 21, 2020... Traded by the Miami Marlins to the Pittsburgh Pirates on November 29, 2021 along with RHP Zach Thompson and OF Connor Scott in exchange for C Jacob Stallings...

CURVE CUTS: Kyle Todd Nicolas... Attended Jackson High School in Ohio where he led the Polar Bears to a 30-2 record and state Championship as a senior... Was named Prep Baseball Report's Ohio Player of the Year in 2017... First team all-state and Federal League Co-Player of the Year as a senior... Went 8-0 with a 0.50 ERA and 78 strikeouts in 56 innings pitched in 2017. Threw 7.0 innings, struck out seven batters and held Lakota West to one run in the 5-1 state semifinal victory... Also played basketball for three years... Was high school teammates with Tigers prospect Dillon Dingler, they both played baseball and basketball for Jackson High School and won state championships in Baseball and Basketball as seniors... Kyle's father, Todd, coached the basketball team... His father played baseball at Youngstown State... Earned his degree from Ball State in Business Administration in three years... Signed with the Marlins for a bonus of \$1,129,700... Road roommates with OF Connor Scott in 2021 in Beloit, rooms with him now in Altoona and on road trips with the Curve...
