Carolina League South Division Championship Series Kannapolis Cannon Ballers (1-1) at Charleston RiverDogs (1-1)

RHP Jake Peppers (7-6, 4.27) vs. RHP Trevor Harrison (2-0, 3.15)

Today's Game: The Charleston RiverDogs (affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays) meet the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers (affiliate of the Chicago White Sox) in the decisive third game of the South Division Championship Series. The RiverDogs are aiming for a fourth-consecutive championship. **RiverDogs-Cannon Ballers Season Series in 2024**: Overall: RiverDogs 13, Fireflies 8. At The Joe: RiverDogs 7, Cannon Ballers 2.

Last Time Out: Trailing entering the top of the seventh, pinch-hitter Enderson Delgado came through with a two-RBI single to left field that gave the RiverDogs the lead for good on the way to a 7-4 victory that kept their season alive on Thursday. Delgado, who started Tuesday's game before being pinch-hit for himself, came off the bench with two on and two outs in the seventh and lined the run-producing hit off lefthander Frankeli Arias. Charleston added to the lead in each of the final two frames. Connor Hujsak made it 6-4 with a sacrifice fly in the eighth and Delagado did more damage with an RBI triple in the ninth to reach the final score of 7-4. Gerlin Rosario worked around a leadoff walk in the ninth to close the game and earn the win. Neither team scored for the first four innings, before the RiverDogs broke through in the fifth, initially loading the bases with no outs. Jhon Diaz opened the scoring with a sacrifice fly and Brady Marget ripped a two-RBI single to left that expanded the margin to 3-0. Kannapolis got one back right away with two doubles in the bottom of the inning, the first from Ryan Burrowes and the second off the bat of George Wolkow. Kannapolis loaded the bases in the sixth inning with just one out against reliever T.J. Nichols. Ryan Burrowes evened the score at 3-3 by booming a double to dead center. Rosario replaced Nichols with men still on second and third and allowed a go-ahead RBI single to Sam Antonacci on the first pitch he threw. That swing gave the Cannon Ballers their first lead and set the stage for Delgado's heroics.

Not Done Yet: The RiverDogs faced a win-or-go-home situation on Thursday and another one tonight. Since the start of the 2021 season, the RiverDogs have played just three games needing a win to extend their season. They are 3-0 in those games and have outscored their opponents 34-10.

Dog Dynasty: The RiverDogs ended a nearly 100-year title drought in the city of Charleston by claiming the Low-A East championship in 2021. The 2022 team followed by winning the Carolina League title with an undefeated run through the postseason. Improbably, the 2023 squad kept the winning ways intact by taking home a third straight title. The last MiLB franchise to three-peat was the Midland Rockhounds from 2014-17. A Double-A affiliate of the Oakland A's, Midland won four straight Texas League titles.

Heating Up Hujsak: Outfielder Connor Hujsak was a menace to pitching staffs down the stretch in the regular season. The 13th-round pick out of Mississippi State collected two game-winning hits during last Tuesday's doubleheader in Columbia, including a walk-off double that sent the RiverDogs to the postseason. On Thursday, he blasted three home runs, becoming the first RiverDogs player to accomplish the feat since Alexander Ovalles in 2021. In five games played last, Hujsak collected eight runs batted in on eight hits.

King of Thieves: The RiverDogs smashed the previous single-season franchise record for stolen bases of 255 set back in 1997. The team finished with 305 stolen bases, placing them second in the Carolina League and third in MiLB as a whole. The RiverDogs are one of just 15 teams since 1900 to steal 300 or more bases in a single season.

1-2 Punch: Gary Gill Hill and Drew Dowd have been a dominant righty-lefty complement at the top of the RiverDogs rotation. Dowd led the league in earned run average and Gill Hill finished third. The pair also closed the regular season among the top five in WHIP, innings pitched and opponents' batting average. Gill Hill is a 19-year-old, 2022 6th round pick out of high school in upstate New York and Dowd was selected out of Stanford in the 2023 draft. The former was named the team's "Top Dogs" award winner this season, becoming the first pitcher since Taj Bradley (2021) to do so.

Prized Pups: The RiverDogs roster currently contains nine members of MLB Pipeline's recently updated rankings of Top 30 Rays prospects. The highest-rated player on that list is 2024 first-round pick Theo Gillen who joined the team on August 27. He is followed by 19-year-old pitcher Gary Gill Hill who jumped from unrated before the season to #8. Pitcher Santiago Suarez and outfielder Aidan Smith are not far behind at #9 and #10, respectively. Shortstop Adrian Santana is slotted in at #14 with fellow teenaged RHP Trevor Harrison at #26. Catcher J.D. Gonzalez (#28), infielder Emilien Pitre (#29) and pitcher Jose Urbina (#30) round out that list.

RIVERDOGS FIELD STAFF

Manager: Sean Smedley

Smedley's coaching career began when he was the video coordinator for the rookie-level Princeton Rays in 2016. In 2017, he returned to Princeton, this time as the bench coach. For the next two seasons, Smedley was part of Blake Butera's staff as the bench coach for the Hudson Valley Renegades. The native of Colorado was announced as the manager in Princeton for the 2020 season, but COVID-19 canceled the season and, when play resumed, he joined Butera in Charleston. During his playing days as a catcher, Smedley was a prep standout at Desert Vista High School in Phoenix, Arizona. He played one year of junior college ball at Yavapai College before transferring to Division II Texas A&M International. He went undrafted at the end of his college career but was signed as a free agent by the Rays shortly after the draft's conclusion. In three professional seasons, he appeared in 24 games total between the Gulf Coast League Rays and Single-A Bowling Green. This is Smedley's second season managing the RiverDogs.

Pitching Coach: Levi Romero

Romero returns for a second year as the RiverDogs pitching coach after serving in the same role with the FCL Rays in 2021. Romero was the pitching coach for one of the Rays two entries in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. His professional career began in 2003 when he was signed out of Venezuela by the Houston Astros. In all, he pitched for five years in Minor League Baseball with the Astros and Texas Rangers before embarking on a seven-year international career that included stops in Venezuela and Japan and ended in 2015.

Hitting Coach: Brett Schneider

Schneider heads to the Lowcountry as the RiverDogs hitting coach in his first year as a member of the Rays organization. He spent the previous four years as a hitting coach in the Seattle Mariners farm system, including with the Arizona Complex League Mariners in 2023. His roster in the ACL finished with the most home runs in the 17-team circuit and hit a combined .263. Prior to coaching in the professional ranks, Schneider was a volunteer assistant coach at Florida Atlantic University. He also served as hitting coach for the Green Bay Bullfrogs of the Northwoods League in 2016 and managed the Great Lakes Collegiate League's Richmond Jazz in 2017.

Coach: Ronnie Richardson

Richardson is embarking on his fourth season with the Rays, and second with Charleston, following two years in the Florida Complex League. Richardson previously coached in the Miami Marlins organization, with Hillsborough Community College and in the Northwoods League with the Madison Mallards and Wisconsin Woodchucks. He was selected out of Central Florida University in the 16th round of the 2012 MLB Draft by the San Diego Padres. He played three seasons in their farm system, posting a .262 career batting average.

Athletic Trainer: Halee Williams

Williams begins her fifth year with the Rays and second with the RiverDogs. She served in the same role with the Florida Complex League Rays in 2022. Williams graduated with her bachelor's degree in athletic training from Indiana Wesleyan University. While in school, she interned with the Arizona Diamondbacks and, after graduating, spent a season with the Oakland Athletics. She began working with the Rays in 2019 while completing her Global master's degree in Sports Management and Legal Skills through Instituto Superior de Derecho y Economía and FC Barcelona in 2020. This winter, Williams worked for the Bravos de Margarita of the Venezuelan Professional Baseball League.

Strength Coach: Gio Caraballo

This will be Caraballo's first season as the RiverDogs Strength & Conditioning coach after a brief stint working in Charleston last summer. Caraballo was hired by the Rays in late 2022 and spent last season in the same role with the Florida Complex League Rays at their facility in Sarasota. A New Jersey native, Caraballo began his career with the Houston Astros after graduating from Montclair State University with a Bachelor of Science with a major in Physical Education.
