**SEA DOGS AND RUMBLE PONIES SPLIT DOUBLEHEADER** - Portland and Binghamton split the doubleheader last night with the Sea Dogs taking game one, 5-2 and dropping game two 8-2. Despite an early for Binghamton in game one, Portland secured the victory after a four-run sixth inning highlighted by a two-run double by Pedro Castellanos. In game two, it was a two-run game after Devlin Granberg connected with his sixth homer of the year. Then Carlos Rincon hit a grand slam to secure the 8-2 win for the Rumble Ponies.

**MURPHY SHINES** - Chris Murphy made his Double-A debut last night in game one of the doubleheader. Murphy spun 6.0 innings allowing two runs on seven hits while walking one and striking out eight batters. The eight strikeouts were one shy of tying his career-high nine. Murphy's fastball topped out at 97mph.

**GRANBERG DELIVERS** - Devlin Granberg hit his sixth home run of the year last night in the second game of the doubleheader. Out of the six homers, four of them have been multi-run dingers.

**WHERE DO WE STAND** - The Portland Sea Dogs are currently tied for second place in the Northeast League with the Akron RubberDucks. The RubberDucks and Sea Dogs are 1.5 games behind the first place Somerset Patriots. The Patriots are currently on a six-game winning streak and the Sea Dogs will travel to face them next week.

**TEAM USA IS LOOKING FOR GOLD** - With its 7-2 victory over South Korea, Team USA baseball is one win away from its first gold medal since the 2000 Olympics (and second ever). The Americans will face Japan in the championship game, whom they lost to earlier in the week. Former Sea Dog Jack Lopez went two-forfour with a run and two RBI.

**ON THE MOUND** - RHP Josh Winckowski will be on the mound for the Sea Dogs. He last pitched 7/30 vs New Hampshire and tossed 6.0 innings allowing four runs on six hits while walking two and striking out five. Winckowski has faced the Rumble Ponies once. He pitched 3.0 innings 6/16 @ Binghamton allowing four runs on six hits while walking two and striking out two and gave up one home run.

The tide finally turned on Wednesday, when Boston snapped its slump with a 4-1 win against the Tigers at Comerica Park. J.D. Martinez struck first, clubbing a leadoff home run in the second inning to get the Red Sox on the board. Martinez entered the series 2-for-25 in his previous six games. The long ball was Martinez's first at Comerica Park since the Tigers traded him to the D-backs on July 18, 2017. Alex Verdugo -- who had smashed the ball anywhere a glove was waiting lately and was visibly frustrated about it -- finally got his break, as well, driving a ball to the wall and just out of right fielder Robbie Grossman's reach for a double in the sixth inning. While Verdugo didn't go deep, no one wore a bigger smile than the 25-yearold who'd hit just .167 across his past seven games

Despite Connor Seabold's best start in a Worcester Red Sox (42-36) uniform, the WooSox had their four-game win streak snapped on Wednesday night, a 7-3 loss against the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (47-28) at PNC Field. In his third Triple-A outing, Seabold delivered six scoreless innings and 10 strikeouts. The right-hander allowed two total baserunners: a walk in the third and a single in the fourth. The WooSox offense did its part for Seabold early in the game, starting with a third inning double from Ryan Fitzgerald, his third straight game with an extra-base hit. After a Grant Williams sac-bunt, Yairo Muñoz came to the plate with a 25-game hit streak and the go-ahead run 90 feet away. And for the 26th straight game, Muñoz came through with a knock, this time a sharp line drive down the right field line to plate Fitzgerald. The RBI single gives the 26-year-old the longest hit streak in modern day Red Sox Triple-A history, surpassing Jacoby Ellsbury's 25-game stretch in 2007.
