The Fightin Phils return home and begin a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the first-of-18 matchups this season between the teams, and first-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Hartford won the 2024 season-series over Reading 10-8. Following this week, the Fightin Phils go to Hartford from July 29-August 3 and Sept. 2-7.

Game 61 Recap

It was a quiet day offensively as the Fightin Phils were shutout for the fourth time this season, in a 5-0 loss to New Hampshire. Reading was held to just one hit, which marked the first time that's happened since June 8, 2022. Reading's lone hit came from Carson DeMartini, who also stole his fifth base of the week. The R-Phils also worked four walks and Ĉade Fergus stole his seventh base of the week. Mitch Neunborn started a bullpen game for Reading and allowed one run over three innings, with a season-high five strikeouts, and took the loss. New Hampshire put the game out of reach with three runs in the seventh.

With home runs in back-to-back nights, Cade Fergus now leads Reading with seven home runs on the season. Between Reading and Lehigh Valley (AAA), Fergus has clubbed 12 home runs this season. A mark that is second amongst Phillies minor leaguers, trailing only Otto Kemp, who had 14 before his call-up.

When There's a Wil, There's a Way

Wil Crowe turned in another spectacular start on Friday night, allowing one run on three hits over five innings, with seven strikeouts. Before Rob Brooks hit a solo home run in the fifth inning, Crowe had tossed 15.1-straight scoreless innings on the mound. It's the longest scoreless-inning streak by a R-Phils starter since Ethan Martin went 19.2-straight scoreless from Aug. 16-Sept. 3, of the 2015 season.

Felix Reyes continued his impressive week with three hits, two runs, a double and home run on Friday night. Through five games last week, Reyes slashed .389/.476/.944 (1.420 OPS). He added six runs, two doubles, one triple, two home runs and four RBI. With Keaton Anthony's promotion to Triple-A, Reyes now leads the Fightin Phils in average, slugging percentage and OPS.

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller continues to be a threat on the base paths. After two-more stolen bases on Wednesday night, Miller is alone in first place in the Eastern League with 24 stolen bases, three clear of second place. In the Phillies organization, Miller is second, behind Oscar Mercado, who has 25.

Binelas Brings the Boom

Alex Binelas' strong week continued with a two-run double on Saturday night. This comes after he turned in the best game for Reading on Thursday night since signing with the Phillies on May 26. He had two hits, a run, his first Reading home run and a career-high five RBI. His five RBI marked the third time a Fightin Phil posted five RBI in a game this season. Over five games last week, Binelas slashed .385/.500/.692 (1.192 OPS), with three runs, a double, home run and nine RBI. His nine RBI were the most in the Eastern League last week.

In the Bigs

On Monday night, multiple former R-Phils had stellar games for the Phillies. Mick Abel started and allowed one run over five innings, earning his second career win. Orion Kerkering stayed red-hot as he fired a perfect ninth inning to earn his first career save. Otto Kemp has also been a strong addition for the Phillies. Over nine games, Kemp it hitting .303, with four RBI. He had a three hit game on June 9 and a four-hit, three-run, contest on June 15.

After four-more home runs Friday night and one Saturday, the Fightin Phils lead the league in home runs hit since the start of last week (June 3) with 16 total. Reading's four home runs on Friday night tied a season-high.

June 17, 1971: At Reading, Mike Schmidt makes his professional debut, playing shortstop for Philadelphia in an exhibition game against the R-Phils. His solo home run to left field in the 7th inning provides the winning run in a 4-3 decision for the big club.

Hartford enters tonight with a 32-31 record, 11-games back of first half champion Binghamton. The Yard Goats dropped four-of-six against Akron last week, including losing the final three games. After this week, Hartford returns home to face New Hampshire. Hartford's roster features eight of Colorado's top-30 prosepcts: Cole Carrigg (2), Seam Sullivan (8), Benny Montgomery (13), Kyle Karros (18), Wlinton Herrera (20), Jack Mahoney (24), Dylan Jorge (27) and Connor Staine (30).

Goat on the Bump

Righty, and Rockies' No. 30 prospect, Connor Staine starts tonight. This season, Staine is 1-4, with a 3.92 ERA (19 ER, 43.2 IP) over 11 starts. On Wednesday vs Akron, Staine allowed no runs over just two innings of work. Staine spent 2024 with Spokane, going 4-6, with a 4.48 ERA over 20 appearances. The 24-year old was a fifth round pick out of Central Florida. Staine pitched for Maryland from 2020-21, and Central Florida in 2022.

Fausnaught turned in one of his best starts of the season last time out, as he surpassed five innings for the first time this season. He went six innings, scattered five hits and allowed just one-earned run. Both runs came in the top of the third inning. Eddinson Paulino hit a two-out solo home run to right-center field. Then, Charles McAdoo reached on a two-out error, which allowed him to score on a Jace Bohrofen double, which was a dropped pop up to shallow center. Aside from that, Fausnaught posted zeroes in the other innings he piched and actually left in line for the win, with Reading up 3-2, after the sixth inning. Fausnaught was relieved by Andrew Bechtold in the top of the seventh inning.
