#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

**LAST TIME OUT:** In a rain shortened contest on Thursday morning, the Bradenton Marauders dropped game three to the Lakeland Flying Tigers 13-5 in seven innings. Bradenton jumped ahead early with three runs in the first inning. After Lakeland tied the game at four, **Omar Alfonzo** singled home the go-ahead run before the Flying Tigers outscored Bradenton 8-1 the rest of the way.

**SEARCHING FOR THE LONGBALL:** The Bradenton Marauders enter Friday night still searching for their first home run of the season. They are currently just one of eight teams in the Minor Leagues without a longball so far in 2024. They are the only team in the Florida State League who has yet to collect one.

**BUT HE GET'S ON BASE:** Marauders **UTIL Jesus Castillo** has reached base safely in each of the first six games of the season. He is the only Marauder to do so and is just one of six players in the Florida State League currently riding a six-game on-base streak.

**WALK THIS WAY:** **Jesus Castillo's** walk streak came to end at 11 games on Wednesday night in Lakeland. **Castillo** was one of just eight players in Minor League baseball last season to work 100 or more walks. The Marauders infielder is currently ranked second in FSL with six walks on the year only trailing the New York Yankees No. 7 prospect in George Lombard Jr.

**ROSTER MOVES:** Prior to Wednesday's game, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced that RHP Ben Heller will begin his Minor League rehab assignment from Triple-A Indianapolis. The 32-year-old was signed to a Minor League contract in December after pitching in 19 games for the Atlanta Braves last season. Heller has been on the injured list since the end of Spring Training and struck out two in a scoreless inning against Lakeland on Thursday.

**STRIKEOUT KINGS:** In Friday's loss against Clearwater, the Marauders pitching staff collected 15 strikeouts. Last season, Bradenton's staff struck out 15 or more batters in a game eight times. The 15 punchouts were also the fourth-most across Single-A on Opening Day. The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A, HOU) racked up 19 K's against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC).

**A TWIRLING DEBUT:** In his Single-A debut on Friday night, **RHP Carlson Reed** struck out six in four scoreless frames. The six punchouts set a new career-high and tied his collegiate high total as well.

**ROSTER IS HERE!:** On Thursday, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced the break camp roster for the rest of their Minor League affiliates. The roster features six Top 30 prospects between Baseball America and MLB Pipeline. 10 players selected in the 2023 draft are featured on the roster which includes 3rd round pick **Garret Forrester**, 4th round pick **Carlson Reed**, and 6th round draft choice **Hunter Furtado**.

**SPRING BREAKER:** RHP **Khristian Curtis** made his organizational debut on after being named to the inaugural Spring Breakout roster. The 12th round pick out of Arizona State University logged a scoreless frame against the Baltimore Orioles. In his professional debut on Sunday against Clearwater, the right-hander fired 3.0 scoreless innings.

**MARAUDERS IN THE SHOW:** 25 former Bradenton players were represented on Opening Day rosters. In Pittsburgh, the list was headlined by 2019 Marauder infielder Oneil Cruz, Gold Glove Award-winning infielder Ke'Bryan Hayes, and 2023 All-Star pitcher Mitch Keller. Other notables include 6x All-Star and CY Young Award winner Gerrit Cole (NYY), RHP Tyler Glasnow (LAD), and Silver Slugger award winner Josh Bell (MIA).

**WELCOME BACK TO BRADENTON SKIP:** Manager Jim Horner is set to begin his first season as the new skipper for the Marauders in 2024. Horner was the FCL Pirates manager last season and returns to Bradenton after serving as the Bench Coach on the 2021 Low-A Southeast Championship team. The Twins Falls, Idaho native joined the Pirates organization before the 2020 season after managing in the Seattle Mariners organization from 2005-2010, 2013-2015. A former Washington State catcher, Horner played nine seasons in the Minor Leagues and reached Triple-A Tacoma before retiring.

**Last Time Out:** On Opening Day against Clearwater, Reed struck out career-high six in four-scoreless innings. After throwing just six strikes on 17 pitches in the first inning, Reed bounced back over the next three innings. Four of the five runners left on-base were in scoring position.

- Named Opening Day starter. Struck out a career-high six batters in four innings of work. Four of the five runners left on-base were in scoring position.

**Personal:**

- Enters the 2024 season as the Pirates' No. 26 prospect per Baseball America.
- Became the first player from WVU to be drafted by the Pirates since Kim West in 1972.
- Became the highest-drafted Mountaineer since Alek Manoah was selected 11th overall by the Blue Jays in 2019.
- At WVU: Was an All-Big 12 first-team selection in 2023...went 2-1 with seven saves, a 2.61 ERA (38.0 IP, 11 ER) and 60 strikeouts in 25 appearances in 2023.
- Made three appearances (three starts) for the WV Black Bears and the Trenton Thunder in the 2023 in the MLB Draft League.
- Named to 2023 National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Stopper-of-the-Year Award watch list.
- Was West Virginia's Opening Day Starter in 2022 against Central Michigan.
