TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Comets (Los Angeles Dodgers affiliate) get set for the series opener on Tuesday. Round Rock is coming off a series victory where they took four of six games from Sugar Land (Houston Astros) last week. On Sunday, the Express fell, 4-3, in the series finale. 2B Cavan Biggio delivered a walk-off single to salvage the series for Sugar Land. The Express led 3-1 entering the eighth inning when former E-Train OF Kellen Strahm tied the game with a two-run homer for the Space Cowboys. Round Rock hit into a franchise-record (Triple-A era) six double plays on Sunday.

THE TRAIN KEEPS RUMBLING

Round Rock has won back-to-back series for the first time this year and they are 8-4 in their last 12 games. In the four losses, they have scored a combined eight runs (2.0 per game), while totaling 56 runs (7.0 per game) in the eight wins. Seven of those eight victories have been decided by three runs or fewer, including six by two runs or fewer. Round Rock fell to 2-8 in one-run games this year with their loss Sunday. The Express lead the league in one-run losses with Salt Lake in second (7).

DOUBLEHEADER MADNESS

The Express finished their third doubleheader in seven days on Saturday. They went 5-1 including sweeps of the Space Cowboys on Thursday and Saturday. Round Rock is 28-8 in doubleheaders since 2021 and 24-6 since 2023 (includes suspended games played as two at a later date). They have not lost a doubleheader since July 5, 2019 at Oklahoma City.

HERE COMES THE BRIDE

INF Jonah Bride has a hit in five straight games and seven of last eight. He owns a nine-game on-base streak. He is third in the PCL in walks (19), fifth in OBP (.447) and eighth in OPS (.966). He is hitting .310 (18-58) with two strikes.

THE MARTIN MASH

INF Richie Martin led the Express in hits (9) and RBIs (7) last week while posting a .409 (9-22) average. Through 20 games this year, he is slashing .281/.378/.453 with five doubles, two homers, 12 RBI, 10 runs scored, eight walks and 17 strikeouts. He had six doubles in 79 games last year.

COMETS IN ORBIT TONIGHT

Oklahoma City comes to Dell Diamond for the first time this year. In six-game series, Round Rock is 0-8-2 vs OKC since the start of the 2023 season. The two teams met in OKC three weeks ago with the Comets winning four of six games and Round Rock losing all four games by one run. The Comets have lost four straight games after winning the first two games of the series. OF James Tibbs III leads the PCL in home runs (10).

ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, APRIL 28, 1972

In his third start with his new team, Nolan Ryan was unable to get out of the third inning as the Baltimore Orioles beat the California Angels, 12-2. Twenty-six-year-old future Hall of Famer Jim Palmer tossed a complete game allowing two unearned runs, no earned runs, three walks, and five strikeouts. It was Palmer's first win of the year. By the end of their careers, Palmer was 2-0 with a 1.69 ERA in three head-to-head starts against Nolan Ryan. 1972 was their first matchup; they met again in 1973 and 1975. In 1975 Ryan tossed a complete game and took the loss.

On this April day at Memorial Stadium in Baltimore, Ryan allowed a run in the second inning before loading the bases in the third. He was pulled from the game, and reliever Tom Murphy allowed four runs to score. Ryan's final line was 2.0 innings, four runs on one hit, five walks, and three strikeouts. The Orioles ran away with it by posting seven runs in the fifth. Boog Powell and Brooks Robinson each drove in two runs, while Davey Johnson collected three RBI. After the game, Angels manager Del Harder had his doubts about his new pitcher. Ryan had thrown only 2.1 innings in his previous start and had taken the loss. "We'll decide in the next few days if Nolan will stay in the starting rotation. We can't keep him there if he's going to walk five or six every time," he said.

In his next start against the Milwaukee Brewers, Ryan struck out 14 in a complete-game shutout, and the Anaheim Bulletin referred to him as "the right-handed Sandy Koufax." MANAGER KYLE MOORE
 The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.
 A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI
 Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.
 His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN
 Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.
 Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ
 Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and same role as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.
 The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON
 Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP as a rookie in 2007 and a league All-Star for High-A Bakersfield (2009) and Double-A Frisco (2010) before he was involved in the 2010 trade that brought Cliff Lee to the Rangers.
 He holds a degree in psychology and a graduate degree in sports management.

DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI
 Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and was a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.
 A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.
