INDY BITS

ABOUT SUNDAY: Indianapolis dropped its third straight contest and five of six in the series in Louisville, as the Bats used a six-run second inning en route to a 7-1 triumph over the Indians on Sunday afternoon at Louisville Slugger Field. The bottom of the second started with controversy and ended with the Indians trailing 6-0. Michael Troutwein grounded sharply back to Eric Lauer, and the ball caromed off his back to first baseman Matt Gorski. After fielding, Gorski dove to apply the tag to Troutwein, who was ruled safe by first base umpire Austin Jones. Indy manager Miguel Perez argued the call but was eventually ejected for the first time. Following another single, Hernán Pérez doubled home two runs to put Louisville on top. Blake Dunn added a run-scoring double two batters later, and Levi Jordan capped the burst with a three-run home run to left, his second of the season. The Bats stretched their lead to 7-0 thanks to a sacrifice fly by former Indian Erik González in the third inning. Indianapolis plated its lone run in the fourth on a single by Grant Koch and coinciding throwing error by center field Peyton Burdick that allowed Gorski to score.

HOME V. ROAD: While racking up the second-most home wins in the International League this season (13), the Indians also have the least number of road wins (4) out of all 20 teams in the league. They are now 3-4 in series decisions this season, with all three series victories coming at home (vs. Memphis, St. Paul and Buffalo) and all three losses coming on the road (at Louisville [2x], Toledo and Omaha). They have not won more than one game in a series on the road this season.

MALCOM ON BASE: Malcom Nuñez went 1-for-4 on Sunday at Louisville, extending his hitting streak to five games since May 8 and his on-base streak to 12 games dating back to April 24 at Omaha. In the past five games, he owns a .350 batting average (7-for-20) with one run, one double, one RBI, two walks and three strikeouts. His 12-game on-base streak is the fourth-longest by an Indians batter this season and trails only Jake Lamb (16) as the second-longest active streak. In those games, he is hitting .267 (12-for-45) with one extra-base hits, six RBI and five walks. In 32 total games this season, Nuñez is hitting .270 (31-for-115) with 10 runs, 10 extra-base hits and 11 RBI.

HANK ON BASE: Henry Davis was hit by another pitch on Sunday, extending his on-base streak to all six games at Louisville last week. He was hit by pitches four times in his first three games of the week after being hit once in 23 games with Pittsburgh. His on-base percentage currently sits at .407 through his first six games with Indy after being optioned by Pittsburgh last week. In 20 career Triple-A games with Indianapolis from 2023-24, Davis is hitting .313 (21-for-67) with nine runs, six extra-base hits, seven RBI, .483 on-base percentage and .961 OPS.

JAKE ON BASE: Jake Lamb extended his current on-base streak to 16 games since April 18 after being hit by a pitch in the sixth inning on Friday night. During that streak, he is hitting .377 (20-for-53) with 10 runs, seven doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, .456 on-base percentage and 1.022 OPS. He has now reached base safely in 27 of 28 games this season and leads the International League in batting average (.359, 33-for-92) while also ranking sixth in on-base percentage (.452) and ninth in OPS (.995).

TODAY: The Indians and Mud Hens will face off in their first two contests of the six-game series today at 11:05 PM at Victory Field. Toledo took five of six games in their first meeting at Fifth Third Field from April 9-14, after the Indians won the season series a year ago, 14-4. Taking the mound to kick off the set in Game 1 today is LHP Cam Alldred (1-3, 6.92), who took the loss after allowing seven earned runs over 2.0 innings on April 13 (2) at Toledo. Countering for the Mud Hens is RHP Keider Montero (0-1, 3.27), who tossed 4.0 shutout innings with six strikeouts in his start vs. Indianapolis on April 12.

DOUBLEHEADERS: The Indians and Mud Hens have faced off in a doubleheader already this season, with Toledo taking both contests on April 13 at Fifth Third Field, 3-2 and 13-4. At Victory Field, the Indians swept Memphis in a doubleheader on April 6, 5-4 and 7-5.

TOE-TO-TOE WITH TRIPLES: The Indians and Mud Hens are currently tied for the third-most triples in the International League with nine apiece. Victory Field and Fifth Third Field — home of the Mud Hens in Toledo, Ohio — have statistically been the two most triple-friendly ballparks among all 20 IL teams. This season, there have been double-digit triples hit at just three ballparks regardless of team: Fifth Third Field (16), Victory Field (10) and Coolray Field (Home of Gwinnett, 10). Victory Field trails Fifth Third Field in total triples hit dating back to 2021, 140-112. Also in that time, Toledo has narrowly bested Indianapolis in triples, 113-109, regardless of ballpark. In 60 head-to-head contests between the two teams since 2021, there have been 36 total triples hit, 18 by each team.

WELCOME BACK TO THE VIC: Former Indians outfielders and team award winners Bligh Madris (2021 Rookie of the Year) and Ryan Vilade (2023 Gold Glove) make their respective returns to Victory Field this week for the first time since they donned Indians uniforms. In 78 games at Victory Field from 2021-22 before being designated for assignment and claimed off waivers by Tampa Bay, Madris hit .258 (65-for-252) with 21 doubles, three triples, six home runs, and 38 RBI. In 62 games at the Vic for Vilade after being outrighted to Indianapolis to begin the 2023 season, he hit .299 (67-for-244) with 33 runs, 14 doubles, four triples, two home runs and 35 RBI.

THIS DATE IN 2014: Tribe starter Jeff Locke took a no-hitter vs. Pawtucket into the fifth inning and allowed just one hit through 7.0 innings pitched to exit the game with a 3-0 lead. After the bullpen allowed five runs in the top of the eighth to end the one-hit bid and surrender the shutout lead, pinch-hitter Chase d'Arnaud tripled to lead off the ninth inning to spark a five-hit, three-run comeback walk-off win at Victory Field.

GAME 1 PITCHER

Cam Alldred: Southpaw Cam Alldred is set to make his eighth start of the season in today's game vs. Toledo.

Last Outing: Alldred took the bump in Louisville on 5/2 and struck out five in 5.0 innings.

Against the Mud Hens: Alldred has made nine career appearances (two starts) vs. Toledo in his career, going 2-2 with a 8.24 ERA (18er/19.2ip) and 15 strikeouts.

Cam is the Man: Cam Alldred spent the 2023 season as the Indians' ultimate go-to man, making 17 starts and 14 appearances out of the bullpen. He recorded his first career quality start on 6/16 at Iowa (6.0ip, 2r) to kick off a stretch of three consecutive such starts and four total on the season. He went 3-7 with a 4.44 ERA (39er/79.0ip) and 74 strikeouts as a starter and 5-1 with a 7.43 ERA (22er/26.2ip) and 24 strikeouts in relief.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the 24th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft ... Fanned a career-high eight batters for the first time at Louisville on 6/29/23 ... Made his major league debut on 5/12/22 vs. Cincinnati.

GAME 2 STARTER

Michael Plassmeyer: The southpaw Plassmeyer will make his sixth start of the season and third at Victory Field today vs. Toledo.

Last Outing: Plassmeyer took his third loss of the season after giving up two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings against St. Paul on 4/20.

Against the Mud Hens: Plassmeyer suffered the loss after giving up eight runs on eight hits in 1.2 innings in his last start against Toledo on 4/9.

Walk It Off: Of his 14 starts last season with Lehigh Valley, four ended in walk-off fashion – three in favor of the IronPigs. In those three team wins, two of which were come-from-behind victories, Plassmeyer was backed by 27 runs of support.

2023: Began the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts). ... Struck out a season-high seven batters over 6.0 two-run innings on 4/21 vs. Worcester; matched that mark on 9/2 vs. Syracuse. ... Was placed on the 7-day injured list on 5/31 and was transferred to the 60-day IL on 7/25 with an undisclosed injury. ... Made three rehab starts with High-A Jersey Shore and allowed one run with nine strikeouts in 8.0 innings of work. ... Reinstated from the IL on 8/27 and went 2-0 with a 1.52 ERA (4er/23.2ip) and 27 strikeouts in his next five games (four starts) with Lehigh Valley. ... Made his final start of the season with Philadelphia on 9/30 (2) at New York (NL) and surrendered a career-high nine earned runs in 3.2 innings.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Seattle (4th round, 118th overall) in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft. ... Had his contract first selected by PHI on 8/22/22 and made his MLB debut on 8/23/22 vs. Cincinnati. ... Signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on 12/29/23.
