Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Jumbo Shrimp continue their series tonight at First Horizon Park with the teams splitting the first two games. Right-hander Carlos Rodriguez is on the mound for Nashville and will face off against Right-hander Darren McCaughan for Jacksonville.

Carlos Rodriguez: The 22-year-old makes his 21st appearance (18th start) for the Sounds this season. In his last outing at Durham on August 16, he took a tough-luck loss where he carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning but gave up a three-run blast which decided the game. Rodriguez has pitched very well in his last five outings which included 6.1 scoreless on August 10 at Indianapolis and 4.0 scoreless at Gwinnett on July 30. The Nicaraguan made three appearances for the Brewers in June after he was named the International League Pitcher of the Month in May. He has racked up accolades in the minor leagues with two Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year awards, the Southern League Pitcher of the Year in 2023, and numerous Pitcher of the Week/month awards. Rodriguez moved to Miami when he was eight years old and attended Florida SouthWestern State College. He started the first WBC game ever for Nicaragua against Puerto Rico in 2023 before he had even reached Double-A.

Darren McCaughan: The 28-year-old makes his 10th start for the Jumbo Shrimp this season. In 2024, he made appearances for Columbus, Cleveland, Jacksonville and Miami. He started the season with Cleveland but was designated for assignment on June 30 which led to his arrival to the Marlins organization. He has made three appearances with the Marlins with his most recent two coming on August 6/8 vs. Cincinnati. His last outing came for the Jumbo Shrimp where he tossed 6.0 innings with one earned run allowed and five strikeouts. McCaughan has made 10 total MLB appearances (one start) for the Mariners, Guardians, and Marlins with his MLB debut coming in 2021. He was drafted in the 12th round in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Mariners from Long Beach State. The former Dirtbag spent three seasons at Long Beach State and was a member of Team USA's 2016 Collegiate National Team. In the minor leagues, he won numerous Pitcher of the Week awards and was the Texas League Pitcher of the Year in 2019 with the Arkansas Travelers.

Blanked: Last night's loss marked the ninth time that the Sounds have been shutout this season with two of them occurring in the last 11 games. On the flip side, Nashville has shut out their opponents six times this season with three in the last 10 games. The offense has struggled in August, posting a Triple-A worst .218 batting average through their first 18 games in the month. The Sounds also rank towards the bottom in runs scored (67), OBP (.307), and OPS (.657) in August. Coming into the month, Nashville's previous lows for a given month in batting average was .231 and OPS .701 which was in May.

Wesame Street: Wes Clarke had a single and a hit-by-pitch to extend his on-base streak to 18 games. It is tied for the second-longest active on-base streak in Triple-A and ties Isaac Collins for the longest by a Sound this season. Since the run began on July 21, Clarke is batting .276 (18-for-65) with eight extra-base hits, 15 RBI and 12 runs scored.

Raging Bullpen: The bullpen continued to be elite with 5.1 innings and only one earned run last night. Nashville relievers continue to lead Triple-A in ERA (3.57) and are tied for first in WHIP (1.35) with Omaha. The Sounds' pen has also allowed the least amount of home runs (42) with the second least being Salt Lake with 48 home runs given up.

Future Brew Crew: The Sounds currently have four of the top 30 Brewers prospects, per MLB Pipeline. They are RHP Jacob Misiorowski (No. 3), RHP Logan Henderson (No. 10), RHP Craig Yoho (No. 20), and RHP Carlos Rodriguez (No. 21). Misiorowski is also No. 66 on the MLB Top 100 prospect list.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 746-641 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,338-2,161 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Rodriguez's fourth career appearance versus Jacksonville. He made his lone 2023 Triple-A start against the Jumbo Shrimp and pitched in Jacksonville on May 17 and June 29. In his appearances this season he is 1-1 with eight earned runs allowed in 10.0 innings.

2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Was Nashville's Opening Day starter at Toledo on March 29...took loss
- Earned first win of season on April 28 at Louisville (5.0 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 6 BB, 1 K)...was just the fourth time a Sounds starter earned the win despite walking six since 2005 and the first since Johnny Hellweg on May 16, 2013 at Salt Lake
- Struck out nine in his best outing at the Triple-A level on May 4 vs. Norfolk
- Made his MLB debut on June 11 versus Toronto...3.2 IP, 7 H, 2 ER, 1 BB, 4 K
