# FROM THE CROWS NEST

WEEK-LONG FIREWORKS: The Bradenton Marauders return home fresh off a dominant week versus the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels where they took four of six. Despite a heart-breaking loss on Sunday where they lost a 5-0 lead in the ninth, the Marauders impressed on both sides of the ball. Throughout the week, they tallied 32 runs (5.3 runs p/g) and led the FSL with 21 stolen bases in 24 attempts. On the bump, they pitched to 2.68 ERA, limited opponents to a .197 average and led the league over the stretch with 50 strikeouts. On the Fourth, they exploded for a season-high run output in their 14-1 win over the Mighty Mussels. The Marauders finished the night with 16 hits, six doubles and 9 hits with runners in scoring position. Eight of the nine Marauders starters collected at least one hit, and all of them reached base. Yordany De Los Santos finished the night 4-for-6 with two RBI, earning him the first four-hit performance of his career. Overall, he went 8-for-25 with seven runs batted in and six stolen bases.

**ELECTRIC EDWARD:** Pirates No. 23 prospect **Edward Florentino** was named Florida State League Player of the Week on Monday for his dominant stretch from June 30 - July 6. He becomes the first Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Florentino finished the week 8-for-23 (.348), with three home runs, six runs batted in, three doubles and three stolen bases. He blasted his first Single-A longball on Tuesday and capped the week with the first multi-homer performance of his professional career by launching two against Fort Myers on Sunday. Florentino's eight hits and three homers were tied for the most among FSL hitters throughout the week. His 20 total bases were also the most of any player around the league, and second in all of Single-A. Florentino is the Pirates No. 23 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21. In 29 games with the Florida Complex League Pirates, he powered six home runs and drove in 23 runs. His .642 slugging percentage and 1.084 OPS led the FCL before his promotion. In 14 games with the Marauders, he is slashing .286/.357/.592 with nine extra-base-hits. He recently was named the Pirates No. 9 prospect in Baseball America's updated rankings, marking one of the largest jumps in Mil.B.

BIG-LEAGUE PEDIGREE: Left hander Ryan Borucki will toe to rubber for the Marauders as he continues a MLB rehab assignment. The southpaw was placed on the 15-day injured list on June 21 due to 10 wb back inflammation. Through 29 appearances at the big-league level, he posted a 5.26 ERA and limited opponents to a .228 battling average in 25.2 innings. 2025 marks his eighth big-league season, and third with the Pirates. Before signing with Pittsburgh ahead of the 2023 season, the Illinois native split time with the Mariners in 2022, and the Blue Jays from 2018-2022. He joins RHP Beau Burrows, RHP Colin Holderman, RHP Dauri Moreta, RHP Burch Smith, RHP Johan Oviedo, OF Ji-Hwan Bae and INF Tsung-Che Cheng as players with big-league experience to dawn a Marauders uniform this season. This year, he's featured a slider (85.4 mph/41% usage), sinker (93.7 mph/25%), sweeper (81.1 mph/17%) and splitter (83.7%/16%). Big-leauge opponents are batting just 1.103 versus his slider this season and have whiffed at a 39.4% clip.

CLEVARI SETS THE TONE: Right hander Clevari Tejada will follow Major League Rehabber Ryan Borucki for the Marauders in game one of the series. Over 55 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 4.58 ERA and completed five innings four times. Last Tuesday vs Fort Myers, Tejada tossed four shutout innings while limiting the Mussels to just two hits. Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity, as he averaged 94.7 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9 - good for his hardest pitch of the season. Five of his nine hardest thrown pitches this year came during his last outing. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 6-for-39 against it (.154). His splitter has also surrendered just two hits this season (.133) and has generated a 53.8 percent whiff rate.

**CATCHUING UP WITH THE METS:** The Marauders return to LECOM Park for their first and only regular season meeting with the St. Lucie Mets, who clinched a first-half playoff berth in the FSL East, and are currently off to a 9-5 start in the second half. Last season, Bradenton took 11 of the 12 matchups between to two, including all six at LECOM Park. The Mets have a brand-new look in 2025, as they enter the week third in the FSL in runs (398), first in walks drawn (402), and third in on-base percentage (.351). On the other end of the ball, they've recorded the league's second-best ERA (3.68), allowed the fewest hits (544), fewest home runs (35) and recorded more strikeouts than any other FSL club (801). They come to Bradenton having taken three of five from Daytona. Their roster currently features three members of the Mets Top 30 Prospects list by MLB Pipeline.

Entering Tuesday, they lead the entire Single-A level with 80 twin killers - averaging roughly one per game. Only eight teams in all of MiLB have turned more. Moreover, entering the week, Bradenton has induced the third-most grounders in the FSL (840) behind just Clearwater and Lakeland, and have limited opponents to a .227 average on those batted balls - tied with St. Lucie for the lowest in the league. They have pitched to a 43.1 percent ground-ball rate this season.
