Lehigh Valley IronPigs RHP Seth Johnson (NR) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Quinn Priester (0-1, 15.63)/(3-2, 5.18)

TGIF – The Worcester Red Sox close out an eventful week when they play game four of their 6-game series against the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (AAA-Philadelphia) this evening at 6:45 pm. Tonight marks one of only three remaining home Friday games for the WooSox this season (August 30 vs. Toledo and September 13 vs. Syracuse the others) and thus one of three UniBank Fireworks Nights left at Polar Park in 2024. This evening's post-game extravaganza will be set to the music of one of the world's most iconic bands made famous by members John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison, and Ringo Starr. Tonight's game can be seen live on NESN+ and heard on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network.

This Series – Lehigh Valley got on the board in this series with a rain-shortened, 4-1 victory last night in a game that was called after heavy rains dumped on Polar Park with the WooSox batting in the bottom of the 7th-inning. Worcester still leads the series, 2 games to 1 after earning a pair of 1-run victories on Tuesday & Wednesday nights to begin this series by sores of 4-3 and 2-1. The teams will continue and conclude their 6-game series over the weekend with games tomorrow at 4:05 pm and Sunday at 1:05 pm.

What Have You Done For Me Lately – Worcester has won 5 of their last 7 games and they are 9-6 in their last 15 games since July 28 after losing 7 of 8 games from July 20-27. The WooSox have also won 7 of their last 12 home games dating back to July 12.

Countdown - This is one of just three homestands remaining for the WooSox this season (August 27 – September 1 vs. Toledo and September 10-15 vs. Syracuse the others). The Sox have 15 home games remaining and 19 road games left (including the resumption of a suspended game that will finish in Worcester on September 10 beginning at 4:05 pm).

Leading Lehigh – The WooSox are 10-5 in the season-series vs. Lehigh Valley – their most wins and best mark against any International League foe. Worcester is 7-2 here at Polar Park vs. the Pigs while going 3-3 in Allentown, PA. The WooSox have also beaten the IronPigs 38 times in their last 60 meetings dating back to September 11, 2021.

Season Series - Worcester and Lehigh Valley began the 2024 season with a 3-game weekend series in Allentown, PA back from March 29-31 with the WooSox taking the series, 2 games to 1. Worcester went 5-1 at Polar Park vs. the Pigs from April 30 – May 5 winning games by scores of 12-5, 5-2, 4-2, 4-0, and 11-1 while Lehigh Valley's only victory during that series came on May 2, 7-1. The IronPigs took 2 of 3 from the Sox in Allentown from July 19-21 with the WooSox rolling, 14-3 in the opener before the IronPigs won the final two games, 4-3 in walk-off fashion and then 6-4 in the series finale. Worcester leads this current series, 2 games to 1 thanks to their 4-3 and 2-1 victories on Tuesday and Wednesday followed by a 4-1 setback on Thursday.

Stats vs. Lehigh Valley – Sox pitchers are 10-5 with a 3.30 ERA vs. the IronPigs this season (48 ER in 131 IP) while WooSox batters are hitting .257 (122-for-475). Worcester has out-homered Lehigh Valley, 16-11 and out-scored the IronPigs, 80-49 in the 15 games.

One of a Kind – The WooSox have changed their fortunes around when it comes to 1-run games recently. Each of their last three victories have come by 1-run...5-4 in G1 of a doubleheader on Saturday in Syracuse and 4-3 and 2-1 here vs. Lehigh Valley on Tuesday and Wednesday respectively. Worcester has also won their last five 1-run decisions since July 28 and they are now 9-14 in 1-run affairs this season after dropping 14 of their first 18 1-run games.

WooSox Batters Leading the Way – Worcester leads all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories. The WooSox are tied with Norfolk for the league lead with 654 runs scored, while the Sox lead the IL with 594 walks, with 81 hit batsmen (a new Red Sox Triple-A record), and with their .368 on-base pct.

Runs in the Family – Worcester has the 4th best run differential in the league this season at +45 (654 runs scored and 609 runs allowed). Only Omaha (+119), Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (+75), and Syracuse (+64) are better.

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – When Eddy Alvarez was hit by a pitch in Game 1 of last Saturday's doubleheader at Syracuse he became the 80th WooSox player hit by a pitch this season which is a new Boston Red Sox Triple-A record. The previous Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) had been 79 set by both the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022.

August Moon – The WooSox are 7-6 thus far in August. They are batting .252 this month (98-for-389) with a 5.63 ERA (65 ER in 104 IP). Worcester has hit 12 HR and allowed 13 HR and they have been out-scored, 72-63 in August, but they are 7-6.

Close Encounters - In games decided by one run or two runs this season, the WooSox are 16-29 (.356). When games are decided by 3 runs or more, the WooSox are 39-32 (.549).

Road Hazard – Worcester is 25-32 on the road compared to 1-games over .500 mark at Polar Park this year with their 30-29 home record.

Daydream Believers – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (25-22) than at night (30-39).

Six Below – The WooSox are currently 6-games below .500 with their 55-61 overall record this season. On August 6 (at 50-59) - for only the second time in club-history - they had dropped to 9-games under. On July 27, for the first time this year and the first time in franchise-history, Worcester had fallen to 9-games under .500 (at 46-55). Worcester's low point last year was 6-games under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. Their low in 2022 was also 6-games below on May 15, 2022 at 15-21. And their low point in 2021 during their inaugural campaign was just 3-games under when they started 0-3. The Sox have been over .500 just once this season when they were 2-1 on March 31.

Where Things Stand - The WooSox come into play today with a 20-21 record in the 2^{nd} half and in 6^{th} -place in the division, $4\frac{1}{2}$ GB of Rochester who is atop the IL East with their 25-17 record. Columbus owns the best 2^{nd} half record in the IL at 27-13.

Second Half Adjustments – The WooSox are 20-21 to begin the 2nd half of the season (the final 75 games from June 25 through September 22). Worcester went 35-40 during the 1st half good for 7th-place in the IL East and 11½-games in back of division champ Syracuse who went 46-28 and won the division. However, Omaha from the IL West had the best overall record in the first half and the Storm Chasers earned the one playoff spot as first half champs.

Rankings – Worcester is 8th in the IL in team batting with a .258 average while Lehigh Valley is 11th at .255. On the pitching side, the Sox are 15th in team ERA (5.12) while the IronPigs are 14th with a 5.10 ERA. Sox pitchers have allowed the 2nd fewest HR in the league (118) with only Nashville (117) giving up fewer. And Worcester is 3rd in the IL with 903 LOB.

Series Matters – Worcester is 7-8-6 in their first 21 series this season (7 wins, 8 losses, and 6 splits). Worcester finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Streaks – The WooSox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester's longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester's longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19.

Comebacks and Last AB – Worcester has 29 come-from-behind victories this season including 7 wins in their last at-bat of the game and 2 walk-offs. They have suffered 16 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

Goodbye to July - The WooSox finished 10-13 in July after going 2-1 in March, 10-14 in April, 14-14 in May, and 12-13 in June. This July the WooSox batted .253 with 31 HR along with a 5.05 ERA while out-scoring the opposition, 129-122. Worcester's best offensive month was June (.284) and their best month on the mound was May (4.88).

June Over – The WooSox finished 12-13 in June. The team batted .284 in June with 30 HR – their best month of the year and the 3rd highest average in the league in June. Sox pitchers had a 4.99 ERA during the month with 26 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 160-137 in June.

May Be or Might Be - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month with 42 HR.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA.

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 25 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) UPDATE – The 1st-place Portland Sea Dogs (29-12)/(66-45) won their 6th in a row and came up winners for the 18th time in their last 20 games last night thanks to a 5-3 victory at Binghamton.

RHP Jacob Webb (9-3) earned the win tossing 4.0 innings allowing two earned runs. RHP Christopher Troye recorded his second save of the series with a scoreless ninth inning. At the plate, Nathan Hickey led the way with a pair of doubles, two RBI and two walks. Hickey, Jhostynxon Garcia, and Tyler Miller all recorded multi-hit games.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The Boston Red Sox today recalled 1B Triston Casas from his injury rehab assignment with the WooSox. In addition, OF Tyler McDonough has been transferred from Worcester to Double-A Portland. The WooSox have now made 16 player transactions in the past five days.

Casas began his injury rehab assignment with the WooSox on July 30 and in 11 games he hit .300 (12-for-40) with 7 2B, 1 HR & 7 RBI. Casas, 24, has been on Boston's injured list since April 21 with torn cartilage in his left rib cage. He last played for the Red Sox on April 20th and in 22 games for the Sox this season he is batting .244 with 6 HR & 10 RBI.

Worcester has used 71 players this season (31 position players and 40 pitchers). When Marcelo Mayer eventually makes his debut he will be player #72. The all-time Pawtucket/Worcester franchise-record is 79 players employed by the WooSox last year.

The WooSox have sent 20 different players to Boston since the season started (not counting rehab players). The list...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, INF/OF Jamie Westbrook, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Isaiah Campbell, LHP Bailey Horn, RHP Trey Wingenter, INF/OF Nick Sogard, RHP Brad Keller, RHP Chase Shugart, and C/INF Mickey Gasper. Those 20 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O'Neill, OF Masataka Yoshida, RHP Chris Martin, OF Wilyer Abreu, and 1B Triston Casas who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa, Dalbec, Heineman, Campbell, Westbrook, Grissom, Keller, and Valdez are back with the WooSox. Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona and Wingenter claimed off waivers by the Cubs. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
