TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue a six-game series with Reading, Altoona is 5-3 against the Fightins this year.

LAST TIME OUT: Matt Gorski drove in 3 and Altoona poured on 5 late-inning runs to secure an 8-0 win over Reading. Kyle Nicolas tossed 5.2 scoreless innings with 6 K's and Endy Rodriguez picked up 2 hits and 2 RBI in the victory.

ANOTHER RECORD FALLS: With Henry Davis' 2-run homer on Tuesday, September 13 against Reading - Altoona has now set their franchise record for home runs in a season at PNG Field with their 68th homer of the season. Altoona surpassed the previous mark of 67, set in 2005, led by the Jose Bautista/Josh Bonifay/Brad Eldred Curve. Lolo Sanchez's homer on Wednesday night pushed the record to 69.

SHACK ATTACK: Aaron Shackelford leads Pirates minor leaguers with 26 home runs, passing Josh Bonifay for the second-highest single-season total in franchise history (Adam Hyzdu - 31, 2000). Shackelford and Matt Gorski are the first Pirates minor leaguers to homer at least 24 times in the same season since 2007 (Jonel Pacheco and Steve Pearce in 2007). Shackelford's 28 extra base hits and 14 homers in the second half (6/28 - Present) are 2nd-most among Eastern League players.

WE'VE ENTERED A HOUSE OF WORSHIP: With right-hander Quinn Priester's dominant outing on Friday, September 9 at Erie, he lowered his ERA to 2.13 with Altoona, the 2nd-best mark among qualified Double-A pitchers since his debut on June 19. Akron's Tanner Bibee is the lone Double-A pitcher to record a better ERA in that timeframe (1.61). Priester also ranks 8th in IP (71.2) and 9th in WHIP (1.12). Quinn was named the Eastern League's Pitcher of the Week, the second weekly award collected by the Curve this year following Mike Burrows on May 29.

PLAYOFFS?1?1?1: Several times in the last week, Altoona has brought themselves closer to sneaking into the postseason. With 4 games to play, Altoona stands 3.5 games back of first place and would be eliminated from contention with a loss tonight or an Erie/Bowie win. | Overall Record.

20/20 VISION: Infielder Andres Alvarez has recorded the first 20/20 season in Altoona's franchise history with his two-run home run on Sunday, September 4 against Akron. With Aaron Shackelford already hitting the total, Altoona has 2 players with 20 HR on the same team for the first time since 2005 (Jose Bautista/Josh Bonifay) and just the third time in 24 seasons of the franchise's history. Alvarez and Shackelford have recorded the 11th and 12th 20-homer seasons in franchise history.

Matt Gorski has since joined the 20/20 club with his 20th stolen base of the season on Sunday, September 11 at Erie. While the majority of Gorski's production has taken place in Greensboro this year<u>, he and Alvarez are the first duo in Pittsburgh's minor leagues to record a 20/20 season since 1992 when Keith Thomas and Al Martin both did it. 20/20 seasons by Pirates minor leaguers since 1992 include: Adam Boeve (2007), Craig Stansberry (2005), J.J. Davis (2003), Chad Hermanson (1998), Jose Guillen (1996)</u>

ENDY'S POP: Catcher Endy Rodriguez homered from both sides of the plate in Altoona's 13-7 win over Akron on Thursday, September 1. It was just the 5th time in franchise history that Altoona had a player homer from both sides of the plate and first time at PNG Field. **Rodolfo Castro** last turned the trick on 6/5/21 at Richmond. Others to homer from both sides of the plate in the same game in franchise history include: **Shawn Garrett** 5/2/03 at Reading, **Hector Gimenez** 5/5/10 at Richmond, **Shelby Ford** 5/15/10 at Richmond.

In his 28 games since joining the Curve on August 9 at Binghamton, he's batting .370/.452/.722/1.174 with 14 2B, 8 HR, 32 RBI, 16 BB and 1-1 SB. Since his promotion he ranks T-1st in 2B, 2nd in XBH (22), 7th in SLG% (.722), T-8th in RBI (32) and 9th in OPS (1.174) among all minor league players. He is the lone player in MiLB w/ 35+ 2B, 20+ HR, 50+ BB and less than 100 K (h/t Josh Norris of *Baseball*

NICKY G IS BACK: After missing 10 weeks of the season with a right foot injury, Infielder Nick Gonzales has reached base safely in 22-of-24 games since his activation batting: .277/.410/.468 (26-for-94) with 12 2B, 2 HR, 16 RBI, 17 BB since his return.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 156 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 4 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, Liover Peguero (27), Jared Triolo (24), and Andres Alvarez (20), with 20 stolen bases for the second time in franchise history: first since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

THE FIGHTINS, BABY, THE FIGHTINS: Managed by Shawn Williams, Reading has received two of the Phillies' top pitching prospects to their roster since Altoona last saw them in RHP Mick Abel and RHP Andrew Painter, the top two prospects in the system according to MLB.com. The team also features OF Johan Rojas (No. 5), OF Ethan Wilson (No. 8), OF Jhailyn Ortiz (No. 17), RHP McKinley Moore (No. 24), and RHP Andrew Baker (No. 30).

THE FIRST FIGHTER: Taylor Lehman starts a bullpen day for the Fightins. A Pittsburgh native who attended Keystone Oaks, HS, Lehman played his college ball at Penn State and was drafted in the 34th round in 2014 by the Miami Marlins. Lehman has started 3 bullpen games for Reading this year, totaling 13 apperances and a 1-1, 4.08 ERA

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the first round (18th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Cary-Grove High School in Cary, Illinois...Signed on June 10, 2019

CURVE CUTS: Charles Quinn Priester... Was committed to play collegiately at Texas Christian University before his selection in the 2019 draft... Signed for a bonus of \$3,400,000 by Pirates scout Anthony Wycklendt... Is a 2019 graduate of Cary-Grove (IL) High School, where he posted an 8-2 record and 1.00 ERA as a senior... Was named the 2018-19 Gatorade Illinois Player-of-the-Year... Was a two-sport athlete in high school; also played wide receiver and defensive back on the high school's football team that went 14-0 and won a Class 6A state championship in 2018 where he caught a 3-yard touchdown pass in the championship game against Crete-Monee HS... Played quarterback as an underclassmen before moving to receiver during his senior year of high school... Turned down an offer of a dual scholorship from Northwestern University to play football and baseball for the Wildcats... Was named a 2019 Rawlings Perfect Game pre-season All-American... Was also ranked as the 19th-best prospect by MLB Pipeline in the 2019 draft...
