SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels won the series finale against the Bowie Baysox, 12-5. Bowie scored first in the bottom of the first with a solo homer by Cadyn Grenier. The Flying Squirrels answered with a three-run homer in the top of the second by **Andy Sugilio**, his first of the season, to take a 3-1 lead. The advantage swelled to 4-1 in the third with an RBI single by **Brandon Martorano**. Bowie scored two runs in the third to close within a run. In the fourth, the Flying Squirrels scored four runs to open an 8-3 lead. **Simon Whiteman** hit an RBI double, **Frankie Tostado** drove in a run with a single and **Sandro Fabian** clubbed a two-run homer. In the seventh, **Bryan Torres** and Sugilio hit RBI singles to extend the lead to 10-4. Toby Welk hit an RBI single for Bowie in the top of the seventh to pull the score to 10-4. In the top of the ninth, a run scored on an error and Whiteman worked a bases-loaded walk to open a 12-4 lead. Bowie scored a run in the bottom of the ninth but the Flying Squirrels recovered to end the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. This series marks the first-ever trip for the Patriots to The Diamond. From June 15-20, the Patriots won five-of-six in Bridgewater against the Flying Squirrels. This series marks the final set between the two teams this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won seven of their last nine games. They are in fourth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 2.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .237 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked fourth in the league with a 3.89 ERA for the season.

THE PATRIOTS have gone 7-4 over the last 11 games. They currently lead the Northeast Division by 3.0 games over Portland. For the season, the Somerset offense has hit .245, which is sixth in the circuit. The pitching staff has a 2.90 ERA, which leads all of Minor League Baseball. Somerset is playing its first season as an affiliated team after playing in the independent Atlantic League as a founding member of the circuit from 1998-2020, winning six championships. The Somerset roster includes five players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects, including SS Oswald Peraza (No. 4, No. 97 overall), RHP Luis Medina (No. 7), LHP Ken Waldichuk (No. 27), RHP Glenn Otto (No. 28) and RHP Hayden Wesneski (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Raffi Vizcaino** makes his first Double-A start. He has made 18 appearances for Richmond this season, all in relief. Vizcaino has faced Somerset twice, posting scoreless outings on June 15 and 19. He is making his first start since July 8, 2018, when he was with High-A San Jose. He moved into a full-time relief role during the 2019 season and reached Double-A for the first time with the Flying Squirrels. **For more on Vizcaino, see page two.**

FOR SOMERSET: Left-hander Ken Waldichuk makes his fifth Double-A start and second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Waldichuk allowed one run over 5.0 innings in a win at Erie on Wednesday. He faced Richmond on June 17 in his Double-A debut and allowed a season-high three runs over 4.2 innings in a no-decision. Waldichuk was drafted by the Yankees in the fifth round in 2019 out of St. Mary's. He began his professional career that summer with rookie-level Pulaski of the Appalachian League, going 0-2 with a 3.68 ERA in 10 starts.

POWER SURGE: Over the last six games since July 6, the Flying Squirrels have hit 11 home runs, which is the most in the Double-A Northeast. In the last series at Bowie, **Vince Fernandez** hit three home runs in his five games played. **Heliot Ramos** and **Frankie Tostado** homered twice last week. **Brandon Martorano**, **David Villar**, **Sandro Fabian** and **Andy Sugilio** have each hit one home run in the six-game span. For the season, the Flying Squirrels rank eighth in the circuit with 62 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 124 home runs this season in 120 games. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Villar leads the team with 11 home runs this season and is on pace to hit 22 for the year. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season.

RAMOS RAKING: In his last five games since Sunday, **Heliot Ramos** is batting .381 (8-for-21) with three home runs, two doubles and eight RBIs while scoring five runs. He began the season hitting .314 with three homers and 12 RBIs in 22 May games. In June, he posted a .155 batting average and homered twice with three RBIs in 26 games. Ramos is back with the Flying Squirrels after missing two games over the weekend while traveling to Denver for the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game as part of MLB's All-Star Week festivities.

TOASTY: Over his last 29 games since June 6, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .330 (37-for-112) with seven homers, eight doubles and 30 RBIs. Last Tuesday, he hit a two-run homer in the series opener at Bowie. His ten-game hit streak ended on Wednesday. He has at least one extra-base hits in 10 of his last 15 games. Tostado also has two hits in each of his last two games.

BREAKING OUT: After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, **David Villar** has hit .333 (27-for-81) with six homers and 14 RBIs over his last 22 games since June 16. In the last road series against Hartford, Villar hit three homers. He added a three-run homer on Saturday night at Bowie to put the Flying Squirrels ahead in the eighth inning. For the season, Villar leads the Flying Squirrels with 11 home runs.

SWINGING FOR THE VANCE: In his last eight games since June 30, **Vince Fernandez** is batting .482 (13-for-27) with three home runs, one double and eight RBIs. Fernandez is ranked second on the team with ten homers this season and fourth with 24 RBIs. He has picked up multiple hits in five of his last eight games.

SIMON SAYS: **Simon Whiteman** started his Double-A career 0-for-17 in his first four games from June 15-18 after being promoted from High-A Richmond. In his last 18 games since June 19, Whiteman is batting .288 (21-for-73) with six doubles and one homer. Since joining the Flying Squirrels, Whiteman has picked up eight stolen bases, which leads the team for the season.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with nine hits, six walks and six RBIs by pitchers at the plate. On the year, Richmond has gone 26-14 (.650) against National League affiliates, but have gone 6-11 (.353) against affiliates of American League clubs. After back-to-back series against National League affiliates Hartford and Binghamton, the Flying Squirrels now face American League clubs for the remaining four sets in July and will use the designated hitter.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for seventh in the Double-A Northeast with 40 RBIs and tied for fourth with 60 hits. **Shane Matheny** is fifth with 28 walks. **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for sixth in the circuit with five saves. **Joey Marciano** and **Frank Rubio** are tied for fifth with 20 games pitched. **Caleb Kilian** is ranked second with a 2.09 ERA, first with two complete games, first with one shutout, fifth with a .218 BAA, third with a 0.93 WHIP and first with a 1.000 winning percentage.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 33-27 record is the third-best record in the franchise's history through 60 games, trailing only a 34-26 start in 2013 and a 35-25 mark in 2014.

HALFWAY HOME: The conclusion of Sunday's game marked the halfway point of the 2021 season. This year, Double-A teams are playing 120 games rather than the normal 140. There is no All-Star Break for Minor League teams in 2021.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13), **Sean Hjelle** (14) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Five players, including Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
