TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock begins its first road trip of the season on Tuesday night at Sugar Land's Constellation Field. Express RHP Kohei Arihara is scheduled to start up against Space Cowboys RHP Brett Conine. First pitch is set for 7:05 p.m.

LAST TIME OUT

The Round Rock Express rode a two-run first inning to a 3-2 victory in Sunday afternoon's series finale against the El Paso Chihuahuas at Dell Diamond. Round Rock LHP Jake Latz claimed his first win of the season with a 5.0-inning outing that saw just one run with four punchouts. The loss went to El Paso RHP Reiss Knehr, who allowed three runs during 4.1 innings. Round Rock took an early lead when the contest's first two E-Train batters scored. LF Bubba Thompson knocked a leadoff single before CF Josh Smith blasted a home run to score the pair. The Chihuahuas trimmed the Express lead to 2-1 in the fifth when C Brett Sullivan and SS Matthew Batten tallied back-to-back doubles that scored Sullivan. Thompson responded for Round Rock in the bottom of the fifth frame when he hit a double, stole second base then came home on a double from RF Zach Reks. El Paso put one more run on the board when Sullivan scored again in the seventh inning. The catcher knocked a single then found third on a Batten double and finally scored as 2B Domingo Leyba hit a sacrifice fly. The run made it a 3-2 contest, which went on to be final.

ARIHARA TAKES THE MOUND

Express RHP Kohei Arihara is set to make his second start of the season on Tuesday night. The righty was tagged with a loss against El Paso after tossing 3.0 innings that saw three runs on four hits. Arihara walked two and struck out four during his first appearance of 2022.

A DAY OF FIRSTS

Round Rock's Josh Smith made his first career start in the outfield on Sunday afternoon as the team's center fielder. Throughout the 2019 and 2021 seasons, Smith made 96 starts at shortstop, 16 as the designated hitter and one at second base. With the Express this season, he has recorded two starts at shortstop, two at third base and now one at center field. Smith also hit his first Triple-A home run during the contest, which came one game after recording his first hit at the Triple-A level.

MULTI-HIT PERFORMANCES

The Express had three players record multi-hit games on Sunday with LF Bubba Thompson, RF Zach Reks and 1B Elier Hernandez all finishing with two. It was the fourth straight contest that saw at least one multi-hit performance from the Round Rock offense.

FINDING RELIEF IN RELIEF

Round Rock RHP Jesus Tinoco earned the save on Sunday afternoon after throwing a hitless ninth inning for the second E-Train save of the season. Two more relievers, RHPs Ryder Ryan and Justin Anderson, also recorded hitless outings as they each threw one inning. Anderson recorded one strikeout while on the mound.

NEW SEASON, NEW NAME

The Round Rock Express is set to play its first ever contest against the Sugar Land Space Cowboys on Tuesday. During the off-season, the former Sugar Land Skeeters rebranded to the Space Cowboys ahead of their second season as the Houston Astros' Triple-A affiliate. Round Rock finished 19-16 against Sugar Land in 2021, including a 7-4 record at Constellation Field.

BIG LEAGUER SET FOR ACTION

Texas Rangers RHP Garrett Richards is scheduled to make a Major League rehab appearance in Sugar Land on Tuesday night. After being signed as a free agent on March 20, 2022, the righty was placed on the 10-day injured list on April 4 with a right middle finger blister. He is scheduled to pitch an inning out of the bullpen against the Space Cowboys.

RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 12 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and Texas. The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
