LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones settled for a series split in an 8-2 defeat at Rome on Sunday afternoon...OF **Nick Morabito** picked up his first multi-hit game with the Cyclones, garnering three hits, including a double and a run scored...Brooklyn scored both its runs in the top of the fourth on an RBI single from 1B **Nick Lorusso** and a double by SS **William Lugo**...SS **E.J. Exposito** hit his South Atlantic League-leading eighth home run of the year for Rome.

RAINDROPS KEEPING FALLING ON MY HEAD: The Cyclones endured their second postponement of the 2024 season when they were rained out on Tuesday at Bowling Green...Brooklyn was also postponed due to inclement weather on April 11 vs. Asheville...Tuesday's contest will be made up as part of a doubleheader on Thursday, May 16, starting at 6:30 p.m. ET...Brooklyn swept their only doubleheader of the season from Asheville on April 13...The Cyclones won the opener, 6-2, and the nightcap, 3-1.

BINGO BOUND: The Cyclones announced on Monday that 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford** and RHP **Brandon Sproat** were transferred to Double-A Binghamton...In 31 games for Brooklyn in 2024, Clifford hit .216/.412/.304 with a .716 OPS, adding a home run and 10 RBI...At the time of his promotion, the 20-year-old led the South Atlantic League in walks (32) and was tied for fifth in on-base percentage (.412)...Clifford's 32 walks were also tied for the most in Minor League Baseball...Clifford went 0-for-4 in his debut on Tuesday night...Sproat made six appearances (five starts) on the bump, collecting a 2-1 record with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 16 walks, and 33 strikeouts...Among SAL pitchers with 25.0+ innings pitched, the 23-year-old was fourth in ERA (1.07) and batting average against (.141), fifth in strikeouts-per-nine innings (11.72), and seventh in strikeout rate (32.4%)...Sproat is expected to make his Double-A debut today.

NEW TO THE STABLE: Brooklyn added two arms to their bullpen on Monday with RHPs **Jimmy Loper** and **Jawilme Ramirez** joining the squad from Single-A St. Lucie...Loper, a 16th-round pick of the New York Mets in 2022 out of Duke University, was 0-1 with a 2.57 ERA (4 ER in 14.0 IP), two walks, and 19 strikeouts in seven relief outings for St. Lucie...Among Florida State League relievers with 14.0+ innings pitched, the 24-year-old was second in strikeout-to-walk rate (9.50), tied for second in fewest walks allowed (2), and tied for seventh in WHIP (1.00)...Loper did not allow a run in his final 7.2 innings in the FSL...Ramirez held a 1-1 mark and a 2.81 ERA (5 ER in 16.0 IP) with 10 walks and 16 strikeouts in eight relief outings...Among FSL relievers with 16.0+ frames, he was sixth in batting average against (.182) and opposing OPS (.573)...The 22-year-old finished the 2023 season in Brooklyn's rotation, going 1-1 with a 5.52 ERA (18 ER in 29.1 IP), 10 walks, and 15 punch-outs in six starts.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: OF **Nick Morabito** has reached safely all five games since making his High-A and Cyclones debut last Tuesday night...The now 21-year-old leads Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.516) and sits second in wRC+ (199) and third in batting average (.385)...Morabito is the only player at the full-season MiLB level with an OBP greater than .500...At the time of his promotion from Single-A St. Lucie, Morabito led the Florida State League in hitting (.397), on-base percentage (.530), and OPS (1.043)...He was also third in slugging (.513), hits (31), and stolen bases (11), tied for sixth in walks (18), and seventh in total bases (40).

JONAH'S WHALE OF A START: RHP **Jonah Tong**'s stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close last Wednesday night at 26.0 frames...In seven appearances (five starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 1-0 with a 0.33 ERA (1 ER in 27.2 IP)...Tong is tied with High-A Beloit's LHP **Emmett Olson** (0.33) for the lowest ERA among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball...The Markham, Ont. native is third among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (43.5%) and sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (32.4%)...Tong's 47 strikeouts are tied for 11th-most in the minors.

NICK THE STICK: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The Connecticut native's season-long hitting streak was snapped at nine last Saturday, but his on-base streak stands at 11...Since April 27, the former Maryland Terrapin has been 12-for-43 at the plate, hitting .279/.333/.419 with a .752 OPS...Lorusso has scored six runs, four doubles, a triple, and seven RBI in that time...The 23-year-old is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in triples (2), tied for third in doubles (8), and tied for 10th in extra-base hits (12).

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on Saturday afternoon marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has record a mark of 1,000-843 (.543) in 1,843 games since 2001...Tuesday's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 202-212 (.488) in 414 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's very first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

DOUBLE-DIGIT DOUGLAS: RHP **Douglas Orellana** set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on Saturday afternoon at Rome...The 22-year-old did not allow a run on two hits and walked just one...It was the second double-digit strikeout game of Orellana's career...The Caracas, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana is the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP **Robert Colina** punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023...Among South Atlantic League pitchers with 24.0+ innings of work, Orellana ranks fourth in ERA (.11) and WHIP (0.95).

PITCHING IN: The Cyclones have one of the best pitching staffs in all of Minor League Baseball in 2024...Entering play on Wednesday, Brooklyn holds a 3.12 ERA (100 ER in 288.1 IP), the best in the South Atlantic League...The Cyclones' .598 opposing OPS is also the lowest in the circuit...Brooklyn's 3.12 ERA ranks sixth in all of Minor League Baseball...Double-A Akron (Cleveland) holds the best mark at 2.48...The Cyclones' .598 opposing OPS is the second-lowest in the minors, while the 120 WHIP is tied for 10th...Brooklyn is also tied for fourth in MiLB with five shutouts.

EXTRA! EXTRA! Brooklyn's 6-3 win over Rome on Friday night marked the Cyclones' first win in extra innings in 2024...The Cyclones had started the season 0-2, dropping contests on April 7 at Wilmington and May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Friday was Brooklyn's first win in added frames since a 13-12 triumph in 10 innings at Asheville on August 24, 2023...Since the start of 2023, the Cyclones are 7-10 in extra-inning contests.

vs. BOWLING GREEN: Brooklyn continues its only two-week road trip of the season against the Rays' High-A affiliate...The Hot Rods possess eight of Tampa Bay's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: 1B **Xavier Isaac** (3), INF **Brayden Taylor** (4), OF **Chandler Simpson** (10), INF **Tre' Morgan** (13), OF **Colton Ledbetter** (14), RHP **Yoniel Curet** (16), RHP **Trevor Martin** (19), and INF **Cooper Kinney** (22)...This marks the third-ever series between Bowling Green and Brooklyn franchises since the Cyclones entered the South Atlantic League in 2021...Brooklyn dropped 4-of-6 in their first visit to Bowling Green Ballpark in 2022...The Cyclones are 5-7 against Hot Rods in 12 all-time meetings.

YIPPEE KI-YAY: TWP **Nolan McLean** has had an incredible start to his Cyclones career...On the mound, McLean had his team-best scoreless inning streak halted at 15.1 innings in a no-decision last Friday at Rome...Over his last four starts, McLean is 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER in 18.0 IP), allowing just 10 hits and five walks (7.81 BB%), adding 21 strikeouts (32.81 K%)...On the year, he is tied for ninth in the South Atlantic League in WHIP (1.00) among pitchers with 24.0+ innings...At the plate, the 22-year-old tied a career-high with three hits and collected a pair of extra-base hits with a double and a two-run home run last Wednesday...McLean enters play on Tuesday with 11 extra-base hits, tied for 10th in the SAL...The Willow Springs, N.C. native has registered 40 fewer plate appearances (61) than any other player with 11+ extra-base knocks in the circuit and 12 fewer plate appearances with that total across the minor leagues...Among players with 60+ plate appearances, McLean is third in the league in slugging (.579) and eighth in OPS (.874).

OMAR-I-GONE: With a pair of stolen bases off the bench last Thursday afternoon, OF **Omar De Los Santos** (58) became the Cyclones' all-time stolen base king, breaking a tie with UT **Jaylen Palmer** (50)...In 2023, the 24-year-old eclipsed INF **Walter Rasquin**'s (32) single-season stolen base record with 37 swipes...Omar is 16 swipes away from tying his previous record and on pace for 84 in 2024...De Los Santos is 21-for-23 stealing bases to start the season...The 21 swipes are second in the South Atlantic League and tied for third-most throughout the minors...Bowling Green's OF **Chandler Simpson** (27) leads the SAL and MiLB...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for third across the Minors in steals (128)...Simpson is second in MiLB (129).

WALK THIS WAY: INF **William Lugo** has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 26 free passes are fourth-most in the league...Lugo's 21.8% walk rate is also fourth in the league and 12th in all of Minor League Baseball.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 50 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.59 ERA (23 ER in 80.0 IP) and 4 saves, walking just 19 and striking out 70.

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** has started his 2024 with a bang...The former member of the N.C. State Wolfpack is tied for fourth in the circuit in saves (4) with teammate RHP **Joshua Cornielly**...Among South Atlantic League relievers with at least 15.0 innings pitched, the 23-year-old leads the circuit in ERA (0.59), WHIP (0.72), and the fewest hits allowed (5).

KING STANLEY: With his RBI double in the bottom of the first inning on May 3, OF **Stanley Consuegra** became the first player in Cyclones history to reach the century mark in RBI...The 23-year-old is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 67 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 101 RBI...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the first in April 30's 9-2 win vs. Aberdeen...They also accomplished the feat in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on April 24...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frames are the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, vs. Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The Cyclones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Nolan McLean** (No. 1), **Jonah Tong** (22), and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: McLean (19), Ziegler (22), **Wilfredo Lara** (23), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

Exposito** RBI double with one out in the bottom of the third...Walked a career-high four and struck out four...Tossed a season-high 86 pitches and 50 strikes (58.14%)...Relieved by RHP **Dakota Hawkins** to start the bottom of the fifth inning with Brooklyn leading, 3-2...Cyclones carried a 7-3 lead into the bottom of the eighth, but the Emperors scored five runs in the frame to win, 8-7.

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 22 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America*.

2023: After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season...Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an 0-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP **Zachary Fruit** and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP **Jordan Geber**, whose rotation spot he is taking...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
