LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox let an early lead slip in a 9-5 loss against the Richmond Flying Squirrels from Prince George's Stadium in front of a season-high crowd of 8,975. **Ryan Higgins** and **Samuel Basallo** both homered and **Matthew Etzel** drove in a run with an infield hit all in the third inning but Richmond scored eight unanswered runs, including a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh from Alerick Soularie off **Levi Stoudt**. It was an uncharacteristic night from the bullpen which allowed six runs on the night.

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** was selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game on Tuesday and will represent the Orioles at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX on Saturday, July 13. The Orioles No. 2 prospect is the 14th Baysox player in franchise history to be named to the All-Star Futures Game and is the first since Adley Rutschman was named in 2021. The 19-year-old has reached base safely in 32 of his last 34 games dating back to May 21, including in his last 12 straight. After his three-run homer yesterday, Basallo is batting .327 with five homers and 12 RBI against Richmond this year.

ON-BASE BENCOSME

IF **Frederick Bencosme** has reached base in 17 consecutive games, the longest active on-base streak on the team and the fourth longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League. The Orioles No. 27 prospect has matched his career-long on-base streak of 17 games set back in 2022 with Single-A Delmarva.

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** was the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of So. Miss. The 22-year-old is slashing .297/.387/.856 in his first 19 games at Double-A, including his first two Double-A homers at Reading last week. His 37 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is tied for eighth-most in all of MiLB.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for second among active Eastern League players with 13 home runs on the season. Amongst all Double-A players, his 13 homers is tied for eighth-most. Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and hit five in June.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 56 of 67 games played in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.347) and leads the team in walks (39), tied for the most in the Eastern League.

YOU GOOD PHAM

RHP **Alex Pham** makes his 15th start of the season for the Baysox and his third against Richmond this year. The Orioles No. 24 prospect has struck out the second-most batters in the Orioles system (84) and the fourth-most batters in the Eastern League. The Baysox have won eight of the last 11 games that Pham has started in. The 19th round pick by the Orioles in 2021 pitched his best baseball of the season in the month of June with an ERA of 4.43 after recording a 6.64 ERA in April and May.

SIZING UP THE SQUIRRELS

The Richmond Flying Squirrels finished the first half in fourth in the Southwest Division with a record of 34-35. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants lost five of six to open the second half against Somerset but have won nine of 12 against Bowie in the season series. Richmond's active roster includes only three of the Giants' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Trevor McDonald (No. 12), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Nick Sinicola makes his sixth start with the Flying Squirrels since being promoted from High-A Eugene on June 4. The 24-year-old performed well in his first month at the Double-A level, posting a 2.73 ERA in five June starts over 26.1 innings pitched with 30 strikeouts over six walks. Sinicola was promoted from High-A Eugene after recording a 2.68 ERA in 10 appearances with the Emeralds. The Giants 2021, 7th round pick out of Maine is a native of Providence, RI.

2024: Struck out 7 batters over 4.1 IP across 4 H, 3 R and 3 BB in the loss on Thu. 6/28 @ REA. Has thrown 4th most innings in O's system (64.1) and has struck out 2nd-most batters (84). Ended month of June with a 4.43 ERA, best of the season thus far. Baysox have won eight of last 11 games that Pham has started in. Has struck out 7+ batters in five of last six starts. Threw first scoreless start of season by matching career-high 6.0 IP and 0 BB over 6 K to record win on 6/11 @ HBG. Ended month of May with a 5.64 ERA. Allowed just two runs or less in four of his five starts in May. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. 163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing 7th in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds.
