HIGHLIGHTS

BYE-BYE BASEBALL'S: Somerset hit 11 HR over their six game set vs. Reading, the most times the Patriots have homered in any given series this season. They hit 3+ homers 3x in the series, including launching a season high 4 HR on Thursday night.

RUN SOMERSET RUN: The Patriots stole 14 bases over their six game set with Reading, including five from Caleb Durbin, giving him 9 SB in 10 G since being promoted to Somerset. Brandon Lockridge stole his team leading 17th base on Saturday, tied for third-most in the Eastern League. As a team, Somerset is 2nd in the league with 89 SB, averaging 2.34 SB per game. **BULLS IN THE PEN:** Somerset relievers have pitched to a 3.22 ERA this season, second best in the Eastern League. Between Wednesday and Saturday of last week, the Patriots bullpen did not allow a run over a span of 13.1 IP, over which a combination of eight pitchers combined to allow only 4 H with 18 Ks.

WELL, WELL, WELLS: Austin Wells went 8-for-22 with 3 HR, 7 RBI, and 5 R over 5 G in last week's series with Reading. Wells' 7 HR this season have come over a span of 45 at-bats in 12 G between 5/5 and 5/20. Since being activated from the IL on 5/2, Wells has 7 HR, 3 2B, 20 RBI, and an OPS of 1.009 with 1+ RBI in 11 of his 15 games played for Somerset this season. **LOCKED 'N LOADED:** Brandon Lockridge's 2nd

inning single on Sunday extended his on-base streak to 15 games, over which he's slashing .404/.517/.702 with 9 RBI, 10 SB, and 11 R. Additionally, Lockridge carries a seven game hit-streak into this week. Both streaks are the longest of any Patriot this season.

EVER (SON) LASTING: Everson Pereira's three hit game on Sunday marked his team leading 9th multi-hit game of the year. Over his last 12 G, Pereira is hitting .347 with 5 HR, 10 RBI, and 8 R. SOMPatriots

Castano earned his first Double-A win in his second start of the season on 4/23 vs. New Hampshire, allowing 3 ER over 5 IP with 6 K.

2022

Castano began 2022 in the starting rotation for High-A Hudson Valley, making 15 starts over 16 appearances and going 3-7 with a 3.62 ERA and 74 K compared 26 BB over 79.2 IP. His 79.2 IP led the Renegades at the time of his promotion to Somerset on 8/4/22. Castano started one game for the Patriots, before returning to Hudson Valley for the remainder of the season.

2021

Spent most of 2021 in Single-A Tampa, after beginning the season with a brief stint in the FCL. Combined, Castano went 6-2 with a 4.17 ERA over 45.1 IP.

2019

After three starts in the DSL to begin 2019, when Castano posted a 1.84 ERA over 14.2 IP, he moved to the United States and joined the GCL Yankees West rotation. Castano started 7/11 appearances in the GCL, going 2-5 with a 4.67 ERA.

2018

Castano spent his pro debut season with the DSL Yankees, going 1-5 over 11 appearances that included seven starts with a 5.40 ERA.

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (1st year)

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre 2(209-10). From 2012-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over. 500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL. He then began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as the Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic. >> > Assistant coach bios on next page. >> >
