YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels won the series opener against the Harrisburg Senators, 4-0. Trenton Toplikar worked 6.0 innings to pick up his first Double-A win. Raffi Vizcaino, Joey Marciano and Jose Marte each pitched a scoreless inning. Vince Fernandez gave the Flying Squirrels the lead and their first hit of the game with a solo home run in the bottom of the fifth inning. Andres Angulo, playing his first game back with the Flying Squirrels after playing for Colombia in the Olympic qualifiers, drove an RBI single in the bottom of the sixth that plated Heliot Ramos. In the bottom of the seventh, Sandro Fabian entered as a pinch-hitter and drove in Ryan Howard and Bryan Torres to extend the lead to 4-0. The game was played in two hours and 21 minutes, which was the fastest game of the year so far for the Flying Squirrels. Harrisburg outhit Richmond, 4-0, but went 0-for-9 with runners in scoring position and left eight runners on base.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, at The Diamond. This series marks the only trip to Richmond this season for the Senators. The Flying Squirrels played the Senators on their first road trip of the season from May 11-16 at FNB Field. Richmond won the first three games of the series, capped by a no-hitter on May 13. Harrisburg recovered to win the final three games of the series, earning a six-game split.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS won three of their last four games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 5.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked eighth in the league with a .236 batting average. The pitching staff is second fourth in the league with a 3.41 ERA for the season.

THE SENATORS have lost eight of their last 11 games and are currently in sixth place in the Double-A Northeast, 12.5 games behind first-place Bowie and 6.5 games behind Richmond. The Harrisburg offense is ranked 12th in the league with a .184 batting average. The Senators pitching staff is ranked third in the league this season with a 3.46 ERA. Harrisburg's roster includes four of MLB.com's top Nationals prospects, including LHP Tim Cate (8), 1B Drew Mendoza (11), SS Jackson Cluff (17 - on IL) and Jakson Reetz (26).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Caleb Kilian** makes his third Double-A start and first against the Senators. In his first two outings for Richmond, Kilian has worked 9.0 innings and allowed three runs, all scoring in the first inning. He opened the season with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.25 ERA in four starts with 32 strikeouts in 21.2 innings. He was named High-A West Pitcher of the Week twice in the three weeks he spent with the Emeralds. He was drafted by the Giants in the eighth round in 2019 out of Texas Tech, where he was a First-Team All-Big 12 pitcher. **For more on Kilian, see page two.**

FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander Carson Teel makes his seventh start of the season and his second against Richmond. Last time out, Teel worked 7.0 innings and allowed one run in a win against Portland at FNB Field on Friday. He last faced the Flying Squirrels on May 12 in Harrisburg and worked 6.0 innings, allowing three runs with four strikeouts, and was hit with a loss. Teel was drafted by the Washington Nationals in the 16th round in 2018 out of Oklahoma State. In 2019, Teel spent most of the season with High-A Potomac, going 7-3 with a 3.12 ERA in 25 appearances (16 starts). He also pitched three games that season for Low-A Hagerstown. For his career, Teel has pitched 48 games (28 starts), going 10-6 with a 2.99 ERA.

FABULOUS FABIAN: Over his last seven games since June 1, **Sando Fabian** is batting .533 (8-for-15) with one homer, two doubles and six RBIs while scoring three runs. On Friday, he hit his third home run of the season and picked up his second two-hit game of the year. He followed on Saturday by going 3-for-4 with a run scored, a Double-A career high in hits. He entered as a pinch-hitter on Tuesday against Harrisburg and drove a two-run double. Fabian hit .184 through his first 18 games of the season, but his performance since June 1 has raised his season average to .266.

STRINGING THEM TOGETHER: Vince Fernandez has homered in back-to-back games for the second time this year. He went deep in back-to-back games in Harrisburg on May 15 and May 16. Fernandez homered on Sunday against Altoona, a two-run shot, and followed with a solo home run against the Senators in the series opener on Tuesday.

LOBBYING IN THE UPPER HOUSE: Vince Fernandez clubbed four home runs in 18 at-bats against the Senators during the 2021 season. He is batting .389 (7-for-18) against Harrisburg on the year. In 2019 as a member of the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies), Fernandez hit .235 (8-for-34) with two homers.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the third-best bullpen ERA in the Double-A Northeast at 2.99 on the season. The bullpen leads the league with 12 saves. **Patrick Ruotolo** and **Norwith Gudino** are tied for third in the Double-A Northeast this season with four saves each.

RUBIO RIDING HOT: Reliever **Frank Rubio** entered in the ninth inning on Saturday night and struck out the only Curve batter he faced on three pitches. It marked the tenth consecutive appearance for him this season without allowing an earned run. Rubio is in his third overall season with the Flying Squirrels. He appeared in one game for Richmond in 2018 and made 11 appearances during the 2019 season.

AMAYA REBOUNDS: After surrendering five runs (four earned) in his first two Double-A appearances on May 4 and May 8 (G2), reliever Luis Amaya has worked seven straight appearances without allowing an earned run. That stretch spans 9.0 innings of work. The span has lowered his season ERA from 15.43 through the first two outings to 3.18. He has not allowed a run in his last five outings, covering 7.1 straight scoreless innings.

STRONG START: The Flying Squirrels' 18-13 record is the second-best start in team history through 31 games. It trails only an 18-12 start in the 2010 season. The best record through 32 games is 19-13, set during the inaugural 2010 season.

GETTING ON THE BOARD: Dating back to August 25, 2019, the Flying Squirrels have scored at least one run in 40 consecutive games. That streak includes all 31 games of the 2021 season. Portland had a streak of scoring in 40 straight games before being shut out in Harrisburg on Saturday. Richmond is the only team in the Double-A Northeast that have not been shut out this year.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects: Heliot Ramos (3), Tristan Beck (12), Sean Hjelle (13) and Jose Marte (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and Caleb Kilian (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
