YESTERDAY: Four Great Lakes Loons pitchers combined to no-hit the Captains. Clayton Beeter pitched the first two innings. Bobby Miller pitched the next five with seven strikeouts. Jake Cantleberry tossed the eighth inning and Cameron Gibbens closed out the game in the ninth. Great Lakes won, 14-0. It was the first no-hitter in Loons history (established 2007). It was the first time the Captains had been no-hit since July 8, 2011 in a seven-inning game against the Bowling Green Hot Rods.

VALERA GOES DEEP: George Valera has hit six home runs in his last 11 games. He has gone deep in every other game he has played since last Friday.

ROCCHIO ON A ROLL: Since July 4, Brayan Rocchio has hit .313/.375/.438 (.812 OPS).

SUPER NOVA: Victor Nova has hit .327/.424/.673 (1.097 OPS) in July with four home runs in 15 games. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games.

LEADERBOARD: Captains OF Will Brennan and INF José Tena are neck-and-neck on the High-A Central League leaderboards. Brennan is seventh in the league in batting average (.288) and second in doubles (21). Tena is eighth in batting average (.285) and tied for sixth in doubles (16).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 19-9 at home, compared to 18-24 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.55 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.83 ERA on the road.

HOT LAVA: Bryan Lavastida is riding a 22-game on-base streak. Over the last 22 games (since June 24), Lavastida is hitting .395/.479/.684 (1.163 OPS) with four homers and 10 doubles. Lavastida has eight multi-hit games during that span, including four three-hit performances.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF **Ka'ai Tom** (2016), RHP **Luis Oviedo** (2018-19), LHP **Sam Hentges** (2016), RHP **Louis Head** (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on May 11, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or younger.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Gaddis was haunted by poor defense and home runs for the second straight start and took the loss at Lansing last Saturday. The right-hander allowed four runs, but only one was earned, over five innings. The first inning began with a two-base throwing error by third baseman **Raynel Delgado** and Austin Beck hit a two-run homer later in the frame to score two unearned runs. In the third, Cobie Vance hit a solo homer to break a 2-2 tie. Michael Guldberg then hit an infield single and reached second on a wild throw by Delgado. Jordan Díaz later knocked in Guldberg with a single to give the Lugnuts a 4-2 lead. The Captains nearly mounted a comeback, but fell one run short in the ninth and lost, 7-6.

**PROSPECTING**: Gaddis ranks as Cleveland's #29 prospect, according to FanGraphs. He is unranked on Cleveland's top prospect lists published by MLB.com and Baseball America. 2019: Across 13 appearances and 11 starts in 2019, Gaddis posted a 2.73 ERA across two levels – the Rookie Level Arizona League Indians Blue and Short Season Mahoning Valley.

**NO-HITTER:** On August 23, 2019, Gaddis threw three perfect innings after a 93-minute rain delay to begin what turned into a combined no-hitter against the Williamsport Crosscutters. It was the first no-hitter for Mahoning Valley since 2013. After Gaddis left the game, RHP Matt Waldron and RHP Luis Sanchez finished the game for the Scrappers. Gaddis set his career high with six strikeouts, throwing 35 pitches in the outing. Also in the starting lineup for Mahoning Valley that day were current Captains INF Brayan Rocchio, C Bryan Lavastida and OF Will Branan

**THE MAGIC NUMBER:** Gaddis has thrown exactly three innings 10 times in his first 14 appearances as a professional. He has never thrown more than three innings so far in his professional career. To open the 2021 season against Lansing, Gaddis worked into the fourth inning for the first time as a pro, however he could not record an out exiting the game after three innings of work. In college Gaddis worked 266.2 total innings over 46 appearances, or 5.2 innings pitched per appearance.

**GEORGIA STATE STAR**: Gaddis is in the history books as an all-time great at Georgia State finishing his career with a program best 3.81 ERA. He also is second all-time in program history with 266 strikeouts, fourth in innings pitched (266.2) and sixth in games started (40). His junior season he finished with 112 strikeouts to lead the Sun Belt and finish 14th in the country. He wrapped up 2019 with his second consecutive second-team allSun-Belt selection.

**PANTHER PRO'S**: David Buchanan is currently the only Georgia State Panther to ever make the big leagues. Gaddis is trying to become the second, after being drafted in the 5th round at 160 overall he is also the highest ever draft pick from Georgia State. Buchanan was a starting pitcher from 2014-15 for the Philadelphia Phillies and was drafted in the seventh round of the 2010 draft.

**TEAM USA**: In 2017 Gaddis became the first ever player from Georgia State to be chosen by Team USA when he joined the USA Collegiate National Team.
