FISHER CATS SCORE EIGHT UNANSWERED RUNS TO TOP YARD GOATS.: Five New Hampshire players recorded multi-hit efforts on Tuesday night, as the Fisher Cats defeated the Hartford Yard Goats 8-2 at Delta Dental Stadium. Samad Taylor went 3-for-3 with a walk and a hit by pitch. Kevin Vicuna, Tanner Kirwer, LJ Talley and Nick Podkul all recorded two hits, with Podkul and Vicuna registering multi-RBI efforts. Podkul hit the lone home run on the night, a two-run shot into the Brewhouse in the seventh to give the Fisher Cats a 5-2 lead.

STRONG PITCHING : Reilly Hovis picked up his second consecutive win to improve to 2-1. He went five innings. New Hampshire also received scoreless innings from Connor Law, Sean Rackoski, Marcus Reyes, and Kyle Johnston.

TRADE DEADLINE: Two Fisher Cats were involved in a deadline deal between the Blue Jays and Twins. The Blue Jays traded 2020 overall #5 pick Austin Martin and RHP Simeon Woods Richardson for Jose Berrios. Martin slashed .281/.424/.383 in 55 games for the Fisher Cats. Woods Richardson, who Toronto had acquired from the Mets in the Marcus Stroman deal, is currently with the US Olympic team in Tokyo. He went 2-4 with a 5.76 ERA in 11 starts for New Hampshire. Woods Richardson impressed with 67 strikeouts in just 45.1 IP. The pair have been added to the roster of Double-A Wichita Wind Surge. Martin made his debut last night with a single in three at-bats.

UP NEXT: The Fisher Cats will head on their second 12-game road trip of the season following this week. They will first visit Harrisburg (Washington Nationals) before heading to Hartford to close out the season series with the Yard Goats.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: August 4, 2006—The Fisher Cats rolled to a 9-1 win at Erie in the opener of a three-game series, limited the SeaWolves to four hits. Ricky Romero went the first four and Jordan DeJong picked up a win with three scoreless relief innings. Tim Olson and David Smith hit homers for New Hampshire.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays rolled past Cleveland 7-2 to improve to 4-1 on the first homestand at Rogers Centre. George Springer and Teoscar Hernandez hit first inning home runs to lead Toronto. Alums Reese McGuire and Lourdes Gurriel each had two hits. Ryan Borucki worked the ninth, scoreless. Hyun Jin Ryu earned his 11th win with a quality start...Buffalo fell 6-1 at Lehigh Valley...Vancouver 5 Hillsboro 2...Dunedin and the FCL Jays rained out.

RECENT ROSTER MOVES: August 2: Otto Lopez promoted to Triple-A Buffalo and Vinny Capra returned from the Bisons. Pitchers Adrian Hernandez and Brandon Eisert added from Adv. A Vancouver.

STARTERS:

Johnny Barbato looks for his second consecutive win. The 29-year old allowed one run in five innings last Friday night at Hadlock Field in New Hampshire's 5-3 win over the Sea Dogs. The former Major League reliever has found a home in 2021 in New Hampshire's rotation. This will be his tenth start.

For Hartford, Ryan Feltner looks for his second win in his ninth start since promotion from Adv. A Spokane June 17. Made debut at Delta Dental Stadium a winning one in a 10-6 victory in which he worked into the sixth scoreless. Was matched up against Barbato that day---and then again on July 17 at Dunkin Donuts Park. Both starters took no decisions in a 7-5 Hartford win. Feltner did have another quality start with three earned runs in 6.2 IP. Has four quality starts including last Thursday vs. Bing. (6.0 IP – 3 ER). Rockies 4th round draft pick 2018 (Ohio State).
