RIDERS FORCE EXTRAS, FALL ON WALK-OFF SINGLE:

Frisco RoughRiders erased a four-run deficit to force extra innings on Saturday night, but eventually fell 8-7 in 11 innings to the Wichita Wind Surge from Riverfront Stadium. **Sandro Fabian** paced the Riders offense with four hits and two RBIs in the loss. The RoughRiders (27-23) fell behind early in the first inning when Chris Williams blasted a three-run home run for Wichita (29-19) off of Riders starter **Avery Weems**. Weems allowed five runs over 4.2 innings for Frisco. In the second, Frisco countered back when Fabian hammered a solo home run to left, his sixth of the season, to cut into the deficit 3-1. After Matt Wallner singled in a run in the third, Edouard Julian blasted a solo home run to make it 5-1. The Riders started their comeback in the sixth. **J.P. Martinez** knocked in **Blaine Crim** on a fielder's choice before stealing second, third and then coming into score on a wild pitch in a three-pitch sequence to cut the score to 5-3. Wallner then cracked a solo home run in the sixth for the Wind Surge, but Frisco volleyed back with two in the eighth. **Trey Hair** plated Fabian with a fielder's choice and **Kellen Strahm** made it a one-run game, 6-5, with an RBI single. In the ninth inning, **Jonathan Ornelas** tied the game with a solo home run at 6-6. The home run was his fifth of the season and his fourth to lead off an inning. The 10th inning brought the Riders second extra-innings game of the season and their first on the road. On a 3-0 pitch to lead off the frame, Fabian roped an RBI double down the left-field line to give Frisco the lead, but Wallner tied the game in the bottom of the 10th with an RBI single of his own. In the 11th, Dennis Ortega wasted no time, singling home DaShawn Keirse Jr. on the first pitch he saw from **Grant Wolfram** (2-1) to win the game 8-7. Steven Cruz (1-1) earned the win, allowing just one unearned run over two innings with three strikeouts for the Wind Surge.

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER:

Frisco has played a lot of close games this season and when scoring or allowing three runs, the Riders have seen a pretty predictable result. This season, the Riders are 2-15 when scoring three runs or fewer and 14-2 when allowing three runs or fewer.

BROKEN BATS:

Over the Riders last five games, Frisco is just hitting .188 (9-for-48) with runners in scoring position and have stranded 49 on the basepaths (9.8 per game). With that being said, Frisco is 2-3 over those games, in part due to a 3.43 ERA over the last five games (16ER/42IP).

RIDERS OFFENSE BLOOMING LIKE MAY FLOWERS?

In the month of May, the RoughRiders exploded on the offensive side, trailing just the Tennessee Smokies (Double-A, Cubs, 45 home runs) with 44 home runs to place second in all of Minor League Baseball. Their .466 slugging percentage as a team was second in the Texas League (Tulsa, .486) and seventh in Minor League Baseball as well. Their 6.0 runs per game in the month were third in the Texas League as well and 16th in the minors.

NO ONE MAN SHOULD HAVE ALL THAT POWER:

The RoughRiders have relied heavily on the home run ball this season. Through 50 games, Frisco has hit 67 long balls (1.3 per game) which is third in the Texas League and tied for 17th in Minor League Baseball. At this rate, the RoughRiders would finish the season with 185 home runs, a mark which would be the most in franchise history (beating 2007 when Frisco hit 176 home runs). In May, the RoughRiders hit 44 home runs in 26 games, the second-best total in Minor League Baseball (and averaging 1.7 per game). Out of their 50 total games, the Riders have hit home runs in 34 games, which means that when they hit a home run, they are averaging 2.0 home runs per game when they hit them. In the 16 games that the Riders have not hit a home run, Frisco is just 7-9. **Blaine Crim** leads the Riders with 10 long balls - and is tied for seventh in the league - while **Dustin Harris** is tied for 10th with his nine homers.

CRIM CRUSH:

Blaine Crim has heated up as the season has shifted into late May. Over his last 29 games, Crim is hitting .321 (35-for-109)/.406/.642 with eight doubles, nine home runs and 25 RBIs. Crim is also on a season-best 17-game on-base streak, hitting .323/.429/.554 with six doubles, three home runs, 11 RBIs and 14 runs. Crim led the Rangers organization in 2021 with 29 home runs and he is atop the org again this season with 10 so far in 2022. His eight homers in May were tied for the most in the Texas League. Overall, Crim was sixth in the league with a 1.096 May OPS.

JONNY ON THE SPOT:

Riders infielder **Jonny Ornelas** has been tearing the cover off of the baseball in recent days. Ornelas has batted .356 (53-for-149)/.400/.517/.917 in his last 35 games. He has eight games with at least three hits this season to lead the club. Ornelas is also the youngest player on the Riders and the 22-year-old is the 10th-youngest in the Texas League. Ornelas owns a .339 average on the season, which is fourth in the Texas League, fourth in Double-A, the best in the Texas Rangers organization and 14th in MiLB. Ornelas owns 63 hits, the second-most in the Texas League and tied for sixth in MiLB.

DURAN DEBUTS:

Former Riders infielder **Ezequiel Duran** made his MLB debut with the Rangers on Saturday, June 4th. He went 0-for-3 in the Rangers 3-2 win over the Seattle Mariners. Duran becomes the 179th former Riders player to make his major league debut, joining Christian Lopes and Jacob Lemoine and Josh Smith to become the fourth former RoughRiders player to crack the majors in 2022.

REARVIEW MIRRORS:

Since the 2019 season ended and the standings reset on September 3rd, 2019, the RoughRiders have not been in second place for 1,006 days. From the season-opening game in 2021, the RoughRiders held first place the entire season and have now been in first place for every game in 2022 as well.

ABOUT JUSTIN

-5A Hallsville High School in Hallsville, Texas (a little over two hours from Frisco toward the Louisiana border). Thought he was going to play in junior college before owning a 1.49 ERA his senior year. He received an offer from University of New Mexico. Helped Hallsville to a 5A regional quarterfinal appearance in 2016 as a senior.

-At New Mexico, Slaten was a three-year player with two spent in the starting rotation. After owning a 7.02 ERA his sophomore season, Slaten went 5-5 with a 2.51 ERA while striking out 98 in 82.1 innings to earn 2nd-Team All-Mountain West Conference honors.

-His third-round selection (86th overall), made Slaten the highest New Mexico pitcher taken in the MLB draft since Kevin Andersh was taken in the first round (15th overall) by the Pirates in 1984.

-After being acquired in the offseason by the Rangers, catcher Mitch Garver is the only former Lobo on Texas. Garver was drafted out of New Mexico in 2013 by the Twins.

2022 SEASON

-First appearance for the Riders came out of the bullpen on Opening Night, throwing a scoreless inning with a pair of strikeouts.

-Pitched first shutout outing among Riders starters on April 28th at Midland, going five shutout innings. The Riders trailed 1-0 into the ninth before scoring six runs in a 6-1 victory.

-Piggy backed with Zak Kent on May 22nd, striking out a season-best seven over 3.2 innings against Corpus Christi.

2021 SEASON

-Finished the 2021 season as the No. 29 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Ended the year with the 5th-most strikeouts (110) and 10th-most innings (82.1) among Rangers minor leaguers in his 20 games (19 starts) with High-A Hickory.

-Over last 12 games, Slaten went 4-4 with a 4.14 ERA to conclude the year.

-Entered the season as the No. 15 prospect in the system by Fangraphs.

2020 SEASON

-Struck out 17 of 44 (38.6 percent) batters faced in the Fall Developmental league while allowing just two runs over 10.2 innings.

2019 SEASON

-Averaged 12.1 K/9 over his 11 games (10 starts) during first professional season.
