#### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

Longest Losing Streak:

On this day in 2017, the Sounds clawed back from a first-inning 5-0 deficit to defeat the Round Rock Express 8-6 in 11 innings at the Dell Diamond. Down to their final out in the ninth, Jaff Decker doubled in Ryan Lavarnway to tie the game. Decker finished the night 4-for-4, while Franklin Barreto and Chris Parmelee knocked three hits (and a homer) apiece.

Quite a Jack by AJax: Catcher Alex Jackson launched a mammoth solo homer 471 feet off Tommy Parsons in the fourth inning of the series opener on Tuesday night. According to MLB Statcast, Jackson's homer was the longest up to this point in the Triple-A season and the third-longest including the Major Leagues. Only Giancarlo Stanton's 485-foot home run off Ross Stripling on April 2 and Austin Riley's 473-foot blast off Jake Woodford on April 3 went further.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 10 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 14 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 16 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 25 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 603-521 record during an eight-season span.
