AMARILLO, TX – Despite three home runs and seven shutout innings from **Ángel Zerpa**, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals lost 5-4 to the Amarillo Sod Poodles on a walk-off Thursday night.

- Zerpa turned in the best start of his professional career, throwing 7.0 innings without allowing a run, surrendering just two hits and a walk, while striking out nine. The left-hander retired the final nine he faced and 15 of his last 16, his first time completing seven innings, with a career-high 96 pitches.
- He received run support early, as the Naturals drew three walks in the first inning and **Nick Loftin** scored from third on a wild pitch for a quick 1-0 lead. Loftin led off the third inning with a solo home run, his ninth of the season and third straight game with a homer to double the Northwest Arkansas lead ... moments later, **Robbie Glendinning** cranked his ninth homer of the year out to left field for a 3-0 lead, then **Jake Means** added insurance in the seventh with his first homer of the week and sixth of the season, a solo shot to left-center.
- After Zerpa finished the seventh, right-hander **Yefri Del Rosario** loaded the bases with singles in the eighth and surrendered a game-tying grand slam to Amarillo designated hitter **Leandro Cedeno**, knotting the score at 4-4.
- Northwest Arkansas was retired in order in the top of the ninth, with a flyout to the right field warning track from catcher **Tyler Copley**, who reached base twice with walks in the game.
- Del Rosario took the mound again in the bottom of the ninth, as the first Sod Poodle, **Tim Tawa**, reached on an error from right fielder **Seuly Matias**. Tawa took third on a subsequent single and scored on a deep sacrifice fly, as Amarillo walked off for its second win of the week.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 5-5 all-time when playing on July 1

On July 1, 2017, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the Corpus Christi Hooks, 6-3 at Arvest Ballpark, behind a strong start from starting pitcher **Foster Griffin**. Griffin struck out 10 across 6.0 innings of two-run baseball, improving his record to 6-1. **Jake Newberry** pitched 1.2 scoreless innings at the end of the game to earn his 12th save of the season. Four Naturals hitters recorded two-hit games, while all five runs were driven in by different players. After the Hooks scored twice in the seventh to bring the game within a run, the Naturals added two runs of insurance in the eighth, on RBI singles from **Logan Moon** and **Nicky Lopez**.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 16 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 8 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter** and **John Rave**.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 26-3, while when scoring six runs or less, just 6-36.
- The Naturals are 20-8 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 12-31.
- The Naturals are 30-10 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-29 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 21-12, whereas 11-27 when the opponent scores first ... in June, the Naturals scored first in 10 of 26 games (38.4%) and are 5-5 in those games ... in the recent 12-game homestand, the club scored first three times, the last three games against the Travelers on 6/17, 6/18 and 6/19, not scoring first at all against Springfield.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 3-14 in one-run games this season, meaning 14 of their 39 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in eight losses this season (six one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 15 losses this season (including 10 of their one-run losses).

YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 71 games, the Naturals have stolen 95 bases in 113 attempts (average 1.34 steals/game, 84.07% success rate).

- 95 steals ranks second in the Texas League, fourth in Double-A and tied 26th in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's** 23 steals (in 26 attempts) ranks third in the Texas League and tied fifth among all Double-A hitters/basestealers.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 13 times, meaning 26 of 95 steals this year (27.3%) have come on a double-steal.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 46 of 71 games this season, including 25 games with two or more steals ... there have been three occasions where the team has stolen five bases, with perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.
- Naturals players have stolen two bases in a game 11 times, led by FOUR two-steal games from Garcia.

THE JUNE SWOON

The month of June was filled with ups and downs for the Naturals, but generally was a month the Naturals are ready to move past.

- The team's 6.17 ERA (156 ER in 227.2 IP) is the highest single-month ERA in club history, the 174 runs are also a record, topping 172 in July 2018 ... 136 walks was the second-most ever in a single month, trailing only 141 in July 2012 ... the staff's 1.66 WHIP was the highest for a month where the team played 10 or more games.
- Despite the pitching woes, there were bright spots offensively ... 35 home runs is tied for the fourth-most in a single month, while 112 walks drawn is the fifth-most in a month.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 57 of the 67 games he has played in this season, reaching base multiple times on 37 occasions, including a team-best 21 multi-hit games.

- In 317 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 115 times (78 hits + 37 walks), for a .365 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 37 times and struck out 53 times, a 0.67 K/BB rate that ranks third among Royals minor league hitters with at least 230 plate appearances.
- The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking second in hits (78), third in steals (23) and fourth in doubles (21) ... he ranks among the Double-A leaders in hits (fifth), steals (tied fifth) and doubles (tied seventh).
- Maikel's 21 doubles are tied with Michael Massey for the most among all Royals Minor League hitters, while he ranks second in the organization with 78 hits and 23 steals ... he ranks tied third in runs scored (49) and walks (37), tied sixth in extra-base hits (24), seventh in total bases (107) and batting average (.288) and 10th in on-base percentage (.371).
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

PUSHIN P(ORTER)

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks eighth in on-base percentage (.448) and fifth among all Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is fourth in OBP and ninth in OPS (.937).
- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage, ranks third in OPS and batting average (.305) and fourth in slugging percentage (.489) ... his 40 walks are the second-most in the system, behind Omaha's Nick Pratto (42).
- Porter has reached base in 47 of 52 games he's played this season, with hits in 33 of 52 and 17 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
- Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied with Robbie Glendinning for the longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 on-base percentage.

LOFTIN THE BALL OVER THE FENCE

Naturals utility player Nick Loftin has loved playing in Amarillo, with home runs in each of the first three games of this series.

- Loftin has gone 3-for-10 at the plate this week, with all three hits leaving the ballpark ... a ninth-inning two-run homer on Tuesday, June 28, a first-inning solo homer on Wednesday, June 29 and a third-inning homer on Thursday, June 30.
- Loftin's stretch of three straight games with home runs is the second for a Naturals player this season, after Michael Massey homered three straight games in Frisco, April 22, 23 and 24 ... today, he'll try and become the first Natural to homer in four straight games since Wil Myers did so from May 5 to 8 in 2012 ... there have been 15 instances this season in the Texas League of a three-homer stretch, including Loftin and Massey ... only Frisco's Trey Hair has a stretch of more than three games in a row with a homer, as he left the park in five straight games, June 7 to 12 for the RoughRiders, here in Amarillo against the Sod Poodles.
- Tuesday's home run snapped a 70-plate appearance stretch without a homer, his longest of the season between two home runs, his last having come in the first game of the Naturals' doubleheader at Tulsa on June 9.
- Loftin has reached base in 49 of 60 games where he has at least one plate appearance this season, with hits in 42 of 60 games and a whopping 20 multi-hit games.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

* **May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (2)

* **April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

* **May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

Pitchers of the Week (3)

* **May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

* **May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

* **June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



#23 MIKE JIRSCHOLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.

- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.
- He was slated to serve in that role with Wilmington in 2020 and previously filled those roles with Lexington in 2019, Burlington from 2017-18 and with Surprise in 2016.
- Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.

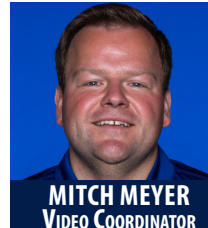
