RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (9-7)

AT

Inland Empire 66ers (6-10)



RHP Aidan Foeller (0-1, 4.38 ERA) vs. RHP Chris Clark (0-1, 3.65 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue a six-game road trip to San Bernardino, taking on the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels) in the second game of a six-game series at San Manuel Stadium.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the second of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the second of 12 here at San Manuel Stadium. Last year, the Quakes went 10-2 here in San Bernardino, 17-7 overall.

LAST GAME: The Quakes' bullpen struggled with their command late on Tuesday night, as the 66ers scored six times in the last of the eighth and went on to defeat Rancho Cucamonga by a final of 10-4 at San Manuel Stadium. Rancho reliever Felix Cabrera (0-1) gave up a one-out hit, then proceeded to walk four of the next five batters, as the 66ers broke a 4-4 tie. Inland Empire's Raudy Rodriguez smacked a three-run two-out triple off Cody Morse to finish off the six-run outburst. Inland reliever Kyle Roche (1-0) got the win with two innings of work. Mike Sirota (1) and Samuel Munoz (1) both hit solo homers in the loss, which snapped a two-game win streak.

STEADY IMPROVEMENT OFFENSIVELY: The Quakes had an up-and-down series offensively against San Jose, but were much better over the last two games of that series. After being held to just 15 hits over a three-game stretch, the Quakes had 19 hits over their final two games, including 11 in their 11-10 victory on Sunday. Last night in the opener against Inland Empire, the offense was held to just five hits. Rancho is now hitting .234, fifth in the league. They have scored 89 runs, also fifth in the league.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes activated Niko Perez on Tuesday, after hitting the Injured List with a hamstring injury during the team's first road trip in Stockton. In addition, Rancho received LHP Octavio Becerra and RHP Connor Godwin from the Arizona Complex League. RHP Domingo Geronimo was sent to the ACL.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes have welcomed back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zerpa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

PROSPECT HEAVY: According to MLB Pipeline's rankings the Dodgers have stocked the Quakes with seven of their top-30 prospects. In order, they are: INF Kellon Lindsey (#8), OF Eduardo Quintero (#9), INF Joendry Vargas (#12), RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (#17), OF Mike Sirota (#21), OF Jaron Elkins and RHP Samuel Sanchez (#28). Of the 29 active players on the Rancho roster, 15 of them saw time in a Quakes' uniform in 2024.

AIDAN FOELLER: Right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his fourth start and his first against Inland Empire. In his last start overall, he allowed a season-worst six runs (five earned) on seven hits over 4.1 innings in a loss to San Jose on April 17th. Last year, Foeller got a brief taste of the Cal League, striking out four, without surrendering a hit or run over three scoreless innings for Rancho. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

CHRIS CLARK: Chris Clark makes his fourth start and his first against the Quakes. In his last outing, he allowed three unearned runs on two hits with one walk over 4.1 innings in a loss at Modesto on April 17th. Clark made six appearances for the 66ers in 2023, before spending all of 2024 in High-A Tri-City of the Northwest League, when he went just 3-12 with a 6.09 ERA across 22 starts. Clark was a fifth-round pick for the Angels out of Harvard back in 2023.
