Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds welcome the Columbus Clippers - the Triple-A affiliate of the Cleveland Indians - to town for the first of a six-game series. It's the second meeting between the two clubs in 2021. Right-hander Dylan File starts for Nashville against right-hander Eli Morgan for the

Dylan File: 25-year-old Dylan File makes a rehab start for the Sounds tonight. He missed the first half of the season after having right elbow surgery on May 2. He has made four appearances between the ACL Brewers and Advanced-A Wisconsin. The right-hander is 0-1 with a 5.87 ERA in 2021. In 2019, File went 15-6 with a 3.24 ERA in 26 starts between Single-A Carolina and Double-A Biloxi. His 15 wins led all Brewers farmhands and he ranked second in innings pitched (147.0) and fourth in strikeouts (136). He was named a Carolina League All-Star in 2019 and a Midwest League All-Star in 2018. He was drafted by Milwaukee in the 21st round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.

Eli Morgan: 25-year-old Eli Morgan starts for the Clippers in tonight's series opener. The right-hander is making his fifth start. Morgan is 0-1 with a 4.67 ERA and has given up 17 hits to go along with 15 strikeouts. He has made seven starts with Cleveland and is 1-3 with a 7.47 ERA. In 31.1 innings with Cleveland, Morgan has yielded 26 runs on 38 hits and five walks to go along with 33 strikeouts. In 70 career Minor League games, he has a 21-16 record with a 3.16 ERA. He was drafted by Cleveland in the eighth round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Gonzaga.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 42, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Another Four-Game Skid: The Sounds are riding a season-high four-game losing streak for the fourth time this season. Nashville dropped four straight to Jacksonville on July 23-25. The Sounds have lost four straight on June 4-8, June 12-16 and again July 16-20. Nashville is on their worst 10-game run of the season, winning two of their last 10 games.

Henry's Heating Up: After hitting just .105 (2-for-19) in his first six games with Nashville, catcher Payton Henry has hit .353 (12-for-34) in his last 11 games. In those 11 games he has 2 runs, 3 doubles, 3 RBI and 2 walks.

Wilson's Hot July: Weston Wilson continues to swing a hot bat in the month of July with a .304 (21-for-69) batting average. In 21 games in July, Wilson has 14 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs, 18 RBI, 7 walks, 3 stolen bases and owns a .992 OPS. Wilson hit .184 (7-for-38) in May before hitting .272 (22-for-81) in June.

Quality and Quantity: Alec Bettinger turned in Nashville's 7th quality start in July, their highest in any month of 2021. Nashville only had two quality starts in May and followed up with five in June. Zack Godley is still the team leader with three quality starts despite not pitching for Nashville since June 13.

Can't Close: As solid as Nashville's starters have been in the month of July, the bullpen has equally struggled to close ball games. After the blown save on July 25, the Sounds are now 1-for-7 in save opportunities in the month of July. The bullpen has a 5.36 ERA (51 ER/85.2 IP) during July compared to a 3.43 ERA (43 ER/112.2 IP) for the starters.

Ashby Deals: Sounds pitcher Aaron Ashby recorded nine strikeouts in the series finale at Jacksonville and leads the Triple-A East with 81 strikeouts. When pitching on the road, the left-hander is 3-1 with a 1.69 ERA (6 ER/32.0 IP) and 53 strikeouts.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,072-1,952. The 2,072 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

THIS DATE IN HISTORY

The Sounds scored an extra-inning, 4-2 win over New Orleans on July 27, 2019. Juremi Profar and Jose Trevino had run-scoring hits in the top of the 10th inning to propel Nashville to the win. Tim Dillard started and allowed 1 run on 2 hits in 7 2/3 innings.
