FRISCO FALLS IN SIXTH STRAIGHT:

The Frisco RoughRiders erased a four-run deficit on one swing with **Thomas Saggese**'s grand slam but couldn't hold back the Wichita Wind Surge in a 13-5 loss on Friday night at Riders Field. In the second game of his rehab assignment, **Corey Seager** went 1-for-3 with a single. He exited after the fifth inning and is slated to return on Saturday for another rehab game. Trevor Hauver pinch hit for Seager with an eighth-inning home run, his second of the season. Wichita scored in three of the first four innings to cobble together a 4-0 lead, but Frisco wiped out the deficit in the fourth inning before recording an out. Seager started the rally with a single, **Luisangel Acuña** singled as well, **Dustin Harris** walked, and Saggese homered to left field. It was the fifth grand slam for Frisco this year, more than any minor league baseball club. Between Saggese's grand slam and Hauver's solo homer, all five of Frisco's runs came via the long ball. Frisco has homered eight times in the series but has yet to win a game versus Wichita in four tries. **Owen White** started for Frisco on Friday and made it through 3.2 innings, allowing four earned runs with four strikeouts. **Michael Brewer** made his Double-A debut in relief, allowing one run in 2.1 innings.

BREAK THE STREAK

The Riders are on a season-worst six-game losing streak. It's the longest streak for a RoughRiders team since 6/22/19 - 7/1/19 when the Riders also lost six in a row. Frisco has not lost seven in a row since 6/6/19 - 6/13/19. Over this streak, the RoughRiders have been outscored 60-29, allowing the most runs in the league over this span.

EAGER FOR SEAGER:

The RoughRiders are expected to host their second rehabbing Texas Rangers player this season in the form of Rangers shortstop Corey Seager beginning on Thursday. Seager, who was signed by the Rangers as a free agent prior to the 2022 season, was placed on the 10-day injured list with a hamstring strain on April 12th. To begin the season, Seager was hitting .359/.469/.538/1.008 with a home run and 4 RBIs over 11 games prior to the injury. The three-time All-Star, two-time Silver Slugger and 2016 National League Rookie of the Year began his career with the Los Angeles Dodgers in 2015. In 2020, Seager helped the Dodgers to their first World Series championship since 1988 with MVP performances in both the NLCS and the World Series, clubbing a combined seven home runs between the two series. In his first season with the Rangers, Seager set an MLB record for the most home runs by a left-handed hitting shortstop with 33. He was named to the American League All-Star Team. When coming up through the Dodgers organization, Seager played 38 games with Double-A Chattanooga in 2014 and 20 games with Double-A Tulsa in 2015, batting .355/.390/.583/.973 with seven home runs and 42 RBIs over his 58 combined contests. Through two games, Seager is 2-for-6 with a two-run double.

APRIL SHOWERS BRING HARDWARE:

The RoughRiders had three players honored by their parent club in their April awards. **Evan Carter** won Player of the Month in the org, hitting .343/.500/.543/1.043 with a league-best 21 walks while **Grant Wolfram** earned Reliever of the Month honors by not allowing a run over 9.2 innings with 11 strikeouts. **Luisangel Acuña** anchored the best defensive team in the minors to take home Defender of the Month, playing both shortstop and second base.

PITCHING STRUGGLING:

Over the last 16 games, Frisco has a 7.59 ERA, which is the worst in the Texas League over that stretch. The Riders allowed 21 home runs over that stretch, which is the second-most in the league. The Frisco bullpen had a 8.30 ERA over the last two weeks, ballooning their reliever ERA to 4.99 this season, which is still fifth in the league. After the tough two weeks, Frisco is still sixth in the league with

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .333/.397/.526/.923 with three doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBIs while walking six times. Over the last 14 games, he has raised his average 113 points and his OPS 284 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .321 (44-for-137)/.377/.474/.851 through the first 31 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (44), tied for fifth in doubles (10), fourth in total bases (65) and second in stolen bases (15). Over his last 27 games, he is batting .345/.406/.521/.927. When the 21-yearold arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (124).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 163 walks are first among Double-A teams while their .359 team OBP is third in Double-A. Evan Carter and **Dustin Harris** have the Double-A lead with 26 walks while Carter is second in OBP (.443) in the league.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
