FISHER CATS FORCE EXTRAS BUT FALL 7-5 TO YARD GOATS: Chris Bec went 2-for-4 and doubled home the go-ahead run in the top of the tenth inning, but the Hartford Yard Goats rallied in the bottom of the frame for a 7-5 win over the Fisher Cats last night at Dunkin Donuts Park. Sean Bouchard hit a three-run homer off Mike Ellenbest (L, 1-3) to give Hartford the walk-off win.

DEMI GOES DEEP AGAIN: New Hampshire's Demi Orimoloye hit his first two homers of the season in consecutive at bats Friday and Saturday. Demi's first of the season was a solo shot in the top of the eighth inning on Friday night, and then he homered again in his first at bat Saturday off Ryan Feltner. Selected in the 4th round of the 2015 draft by the Brewers, Orimoloye moved to the Blue Jays organization on August 31, 2018 in a trade for Curtis Granderson. He is now 9-36 with 2 HR, 2 2B, and 7 RBI since returning to NH's active roster on July 7.

BULLPEN NOTES: New Hampshire's bullpen ERA has dropped from 5.02 to 4.58 since the roadtrip started July 6 in Binghamton. In 33.2 IP in the nine games, Fisher Cats relievers have allowed just 7 ER (1.87 ERA) with 54 strikeouts. It's been needed, because the starting pitcher for the Fisher Cats has not won on the trip, and one only once since June 25...Mike Ellenbest was 5-for-53 (.094) vs. right handed batters before allowing the game-winning homer to Sean Bouchard last night...Fitz Stadler had his fifth consecutive scoreless outing. Over the stretch (9.2 IP), he's allowed one hit and struck out 18.

UP NEXT: The Fisher Cats and Reading meet for the first time in 2021 in a series starting Tuesday night. Reading moved into third place ahead of the Fisher Cats last Tuesday, but have now dropped down after losing the first five games of the series with Portland.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: July 18, 2007—The Fisher Cats rolled to a 9-2 win over the Sea Dogs in the finale of a three-game series in Manchester. Chip Cannon homered in a five-run third inning---and Sergio Santos and Aaron Mathews went deep in the fourth as the Fisher Cats opened an 8-2 lead. Picking up his first New Hampshire win was Yusaku Iriki, who at 34, had joined the Blue Jays organization. John Schneider, the Fisher Cats Manager in 2018, doubled and drove in a run.

MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays were rained out in Buffalo against the Rangers – they will play a doubleheader today. Buffalo and Lehigh Valley will finish a suspended game before the regularly scheduled game today in Trenton...Hillsboro edged Vancouver last night 4-3...and in Dunedin's 17-6 win over Clearwater, Orelvis Martinez had a 3 HR/9 RBI night. The 19-year old Dominican is hitting .292 with 15 homers and 56 RBI. He leads Low-A Southeast in homers, doubles, and RBI.

STARTERS:

Elvis Luciano makes his second start of the series. Luciano, who pitched out of the Toronto bullpen in 2019, is transitioning into a starter, but still looking for his first New Hampshire win. Allowed three homers Tuesday night, allowing five runs (three earned) in five innings. 21-year old Dominican was taken Rule 5 12/12/18 from the Royals.

For Hartford, Nick Bush makes his second start of the series, and third since joining the Yard Goats from Adv. A Spokane. Bush allowed four runs (two earned) on eight hits Tuesday, including a home run by LJ Talley in the third inning. He was drafted by the Rockies in the 8th round of the 2018 draft (LSU). Went 4-2 with a 2.58 ERA in 10 games for Spokane before promotion.

LAST TIME OUT: Started the Tuesday opener here at Dunkin Donuts Park, allowing five runs (three earned) in 5.0 in game the Fisher Cats won 11-5. Did not figure in the decision. Allowed three home runs in a game for the first time in his career (Hannah, Bouchard, Montero).

VS. HARTFORD: Makes his third start of the season against the Yard Goats. Was lifted in second inning June 19 in Manchester in his first start off injury. New Hampshire won the game 15-2. Luciano only faced eight batters in that game, allowing a double (Montero) and walking two. Then pitched here Tuesday night when also matched up against Nick Bush.

2019: Luciano was selected in the Rule 5 draft in December 2018 from the Royals, and spent all of 2019 with the Blue Jays. Made his MLB debut on March 31, 2019. Appeared in 25 games, all out of the bullpen, going 1-0 with a 5.35 ERA.

2018: Was in the Royals system, appeared in 13 games – 2 with Pioneer League Idaho Falls – and 11 (all starts) with Burlington, NC (Appy League). KC had acquired Luciano as part of a trade which sent OF Jon Jay to Arizona.

2017: In Arizona's system, pitched for Arizona League Diamondbacks and Pioneer League Missoula.

Career/Personal Notes: On the opening day roster for the Fisher Cats for the first time. Although he has pitched in the Majors, had not pitched higher than Rookie League level prior to this season.

Obtained: Signed by Arizona as a non-drafted free agent in 2017. Traded to Kansas City, and picked up by Toronto in the Rule 5 draft 12/12/18. On Toronto's 40-man roster.

Maximo Castillo is due up to pitch the opener on Tuesday against the Reading Fightin Phils at Delta Dental Stadium.

Castillo, a native of Caracas, Venezuela, had a four-game win streak snapped in Binghamton July 8 in a 5-1 loss. Did not figure in the decision in his other start on the trip, last Wednesday in Hartford. Allowed three runs in 5.1 with eight strikeouts in a strong effort.

The 22-year old is pitching at the Double-A level for the first time. He has spent his entire career in the Blue Jays organization after signing with them on 9/25/15. Was named a Florida State League Post-Season All-Star in 2019 after going 11-5, 2.69 ERA in 24 starts (7 quality starts).
