LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped a pair of contests to the Drive on Saturday afternoon and evening...Greenville captured the lid-lifter, 9-2, and secured the nightcap in 8 innings, 2-1...The Drive tallied 3 in the 2nd inning and added 6 in the 7th in Game 1...DH **Miguel Ugueto** added a 2-run single for Greenville in the 7th...Drive RHP **Wikelman González** struck out 9 over 5.1 innings for his 3rd win...C **Drake Osborn** provided a solo home run for Brooklyn in Game 2...Greenville took the lead for good in the 8th on a C **Ronald Rosario** RBI single...RHP **Tyler Stuart** whiffed 9 over 5.0 frames of 1-run ball.

BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN: RHP **Blade Tidwell** is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision last Sunday, but hurled 2.2 innings without allowing an earned run...Over his last 4 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, Tidwell is 2-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER in 16.1 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 16 and struck out 23...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.4% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .106 batting average (6-55) against him.

TY-NAMIC: At 6-foot-9, RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out 9 in Game 2 on Saturday and has been as consistent and imposing as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old permitted just 2 earned runs over 25.1 frames (0.71 ERA) in 5 starts during May...Stuart leads the SAL and all of High-A in ERA (1.47)...Only RHP **José Ramírez** (1.24) of Boston's Single-A Salem has a better mark...Stuart is also tied for 8th in the circuit in strikeouts (61) and 10th in innings pitched (49.0)...The Kankakee, Ill. native leads the league in LOB% (86.8%) and FIP (2.66), 4th in xFIP (3.27), 6th in strikeout rate (30.5%), and 7th in strikeouts per 9 innings (11.20).

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** suffered the loss in Game 1 on Saturday, but permitted just 1 earned run over 5.1 innings...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts on May 26 vs. Winston-Salem...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 4 appearances (3 starts), Colón is 1-0 with a 1.93 ERA (4 ER in 18.2 IP), allowing 14 hits and 8 walks, striking out 21...In his last 3 starts at Maimonides Park, Colón has hurled 18.2 innings, allowing 6 runs (4 earned) on 13 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 1.93 ERA and permitted only 6 walks and punched out 20 in that span.

THE BEST AROUND: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 24 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 55 earned runs (79 total) on 156 hits through the last 202.0 innings...That is good for a 2.45 ERA...That mark is the best in the SAL and the High-A level...It is also the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball in that stretch...Only Kansas City's Single-A Columbia (2.49) is 2nd in the minors...Cyclones' pitching has walked 91 (10.7 BB%) and struck out 245 in that span (28.9 K%)...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 98-79, over the 24-game stretch...Brooklyn is 12-12 during that span.

RELIEF READY: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Sunday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.19) in the entire South Atlantic League and among all High-A teams...Hudson Valley (3.36) is 2nd in the circuit and the Twins' High-A Cedar Rapids is 2nd (3.22) at the classification...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system and 4th best in all of MiLB...Kansas City's Single-A Columbia leads MiLB (2.98).

DYLAN THROWS HOT FIRE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** has been nearly untouchable since being reinstated from Brooklyn's injured list...Since being activated on May 14, the 23-year-old has made 7 relief appearances...Tebrake has not allowed an earned run (1 total) on 3 hits and 4 walks over 11.1 innings, registering 19 strikeouts (15.1 K/9)...That equates to a 45.2 K% (19/42).

GREAT SCOTT! RHP **Christian Scott** punched out a career-high 9 batters in a no-decision vs. Greenville on Friday night...This came after the 23-year-old whiffed a then-career-best 8 in his first home start of 2023 vs. Winston-Salem on May 27...Over his last 4 starts dating back to Game 2 of May 21's doubleheader at Hudson Valley, Scott has permitted just 1 run on 6 hits over his last 18.0 innings...The former Florida Gator has walked 3 and punched out 22 (11.0 K/9 & 34.9 K%).

POWER OF PAUL: RHP **Paul Gervase** garnered a career-high 6 strikeouts over 3.0 spotless innings of relief on Friday evening vs. Greenville...The 23-year-old did not allow a hit and walked 1 hitter, tossing 40 pitches and a season-high 28 strikes...Among South Atlantic League relief pitchers with at least 20.0 innings pitched in 2023, Gervase ranks 2nd in ERA (1.46)...Only Rome's RHP **Luis Vargas** (1.11) has registered a better ERA in relief this season...Gervase averages 13.14 strikeouts-per-9-innings and holds a 32.7% strikeout rate.

GOING, GOING, GIL: INF **Mateo Gil** has reached base safely in 17 of his last 19 games dating back to May 18 at Hudson Valley...The 22-year-old is slashing .258/.352/.548 and he has registered an impressive .901 OPS, 141 wRC+, .401 wOBA, and .290 ISO in that time...Gil is 16-for-62 at the plate (.258) with 11 runs scored, 6 doubles, 4 home runs, and 13 RBI adding 8 walks...Since that date, Gil is tied for 2nd in the league in extra-base hits (10), tied for 3rd in home runs (4), 5th in slugging (.548), tied for 5th in doubles (6), tied for 6th in RBI (13), and 8th in OPS (.900).

vs. GREENVILLE: Brooklyn returns home to open up a 6-game homestand against the Red Sox' High-A affiliate...The Drive posses 6 of Boston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: SS/3B **Eddinson Paulino** (9), RHP **Wikelman González** (12), 1B/3B **Blaze Jordan** (16), IF **Brainer Bonaci** (18), RHP **Ángel Bastardo** (24), and LHP **Dalton Rogers** (26)...Brooklyn and Greenville are meeting for the first time since the 2021 season...The Drive captured 4-of-6 from the Cyclones at Fluor Field in Greenville from May 11-16, 2021...This is the Drive's first-ever visit to Coney Island and the first by a Red Sox affiliate in the regular season since the Lowell Spinners came to town from June 18-20, 2019, in the New York-Penn League.

1-2, E-STEP: After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...In his last 28 games dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old slashes .292/.352/.458 with a .811 OPS...Estep has accumulated 15 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, and 14 RBI in 105 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 122 wRC+...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21...Estep has also raised his batting average by 169 points in that time (.047 to .216).

WALK (OFF) ON THE WILD SIDE: DH **Kevin Parada** delivered Brooklyn's 5th walk-off victory of 2023 with a bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 9th on Wednesday afternoon vs. Greenville...C **José Mena**'s added game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on May 26...1B **Chase Estep** delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF **Alex Ramírez** registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF **Omar De Los Santos** provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign... 20.8% (11-of-53) of Brooklyn's games this season have ended in walk-off fashion.

REMEMBER US?: This week marks the first time a Boston Red Sox affiliate has played at Maimonides Park since the Cyclones captured the final New York-Penn League championship against the Lowell Spinners in Game 3 of the 2019 NYPL Championship Series on September 10, 2019...PH **Alex Erro** — who made the final out for Lowell on a strikeout against LHP **Andrew Edwards** — OF **Nick Decker** and OF **Gilberto Jiménez** appeared in that contest and are currently on Greenville's roster...Jiménez is presently on the 7-day injured list...Current New York Mets 3B **Brett Baty** started in all 3 games of the series for Brooklyn.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: After dropping Saturday's twinbill to Greenville, Brooklyn dropped to 1-9 in doubleheader games in 2023...4-of-5 doubleheaders Brooklyn has played have been in visiting ballparks...This year, the 'Clones are 22-23 in regularly scheduled 9-inning games.

OH YEAH, OMAR: In addition to his 21 stolen bases in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 91 stolen bases in that span, which is 6th most in MiLB...Only Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (98), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (97), Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (96), Mariners prospect OF **Jonatan Clasé** (95), and Royals prospect OF **Dairon Blanco** (92) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 52 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 39... Omar is already 11 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

CANARSIE'S CROWN PRINCE: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Sunday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (189), at-bats (622), plate appearances (744), runs scored (96), walks (102), and stolen bases (46)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 (63) for 2nd place in Cyclones history in RBI (66) on May 23 and is 3 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie, Brooklyn native is 2nd all-time in total bases (193), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 5th in hits (115).


AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn boast the top 2 Mets per MLB Pipeline in C **Kevin Parada** and CF **Alex Ramírez**...They also hold 3 of the Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include **Parada** (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), **Ramírez** (2/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (5/9)...INF **William Lugo** (23/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (27/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 18 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

BLADE RUNNER: Tidwell is in the midst of his best stretch of baseball in 2023...The 21-year-old did not factor into the decision last Sunday, but hurled 2.2 innings without allowing an earned run...Over his last 4 starts dating back to May 17 at Hudson Valley, the 2023 2nd-round pick is 2-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER in 16.1 IP) with just 6 hits allowed...The Loretto, Tenn. native has walked 16 and struck out 23...Tidwell's strikeout rate is 32.4% during the stretch and opponents hold a meager .106 batting average (6-55) against him.

BLADE CUTS 'EM DOWN: Tidwell whiffed a career-high 10 batters on May 4 vs. Aberdeen...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher to strike out 10+ batters in a single game since RHP **Carson Seymour** punched out 10 hitters on July 22, 2022, at Jersey Shore...Tidwell was the first Cyclone to do it at home since RHP **Dominic Hamel** accomplished the feat with 10 K's on July 16, 2022, vs. Greensboro.

TOP PROSPECT: Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 5 overall on the Top 30 list...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by *Baseball America*...Only RHP **Kodai Senga** is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

2022: Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts...Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

VOLUNTEER SERVICE: Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game.
