YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Sea Dogs, 8-7. Richmond scored two runs in the first on a passed ball and an RBI groundout by **Lisbel Diaz**. In the third, a run scored on a steal and **Sabin Ceballos** hit a solo homer for a 4-0 Richmond lead. Justin Gonzales hit a two-run homer in the fifth to close the score to 4-2. **Dayson Croes** hit an RBI single and Diaz hit a sac fly for a 6-2 lead in the fifth. Portland scored four runs in the top of the sixth to tie the score, 6-6. In the bottom of the sixth, **Trevor Cohen** and Croes hit RBI singles for an 8-6 Richmond lead. Johanfran Garcia hit an RBI single in the eighth to pull the Sea Dogs within a run.

POSTSEASON BOUND: The June 12 win clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division title for the Flying Squirrels, locking in a postseason berth. The Flying Squirrels will play the second-half division champion in the Division Series. Game 1 will be at the home of the second-half champion on Tues., Sept. 15. Game 2 and, if necessary, Game 3 will be at CarMax Park on Thurs., Sept. 17 and Sat., Sept. 18. If Richmond advances to the EL Championship Series, Game 1 will be at CarMax Park on Sun., Sept. 20. This year marks the fifth postseason appearance in franchise history and the first since 2023.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, for the first time this season. The Flying Squirrels are 25-14 against teams from the Northeast Division this year, including a 15-10 record at CarMax Park.

RECORD YEAR: The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak from April 4-15 was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 71-48 record is the best in team history through 118 games, ahead of a 67-52 record in 2014. Richmond has won eight series, split 10 and lost three so far this year. After opening the season with a 27-7 record through May 13, the Flying Squirrels are 44-41 in their last 85 games since.

RELENTLESS: In their 71 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in 35 of them. In 24 of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. The Flying Squirrels have 11 walk-off wins at CarMax Park this season, including at least one in all but one home series. **Diego Velasquez** has three walk-off hits this year, all in 10th innings. **Drew Cavanaugh**, **Parks Harber** and **Dayson Croes** each have two walk-off winners this year. Richmond has four wins after trailing by five-or-more runs this season. The Flying Squirrels are batting .283 in the ninth inning this year, which leads the EL and is seventh in MiLB. The Flying Squirrels have won 29 one-run decisions this year, the most in the EL. They are 10-0 in extra innings.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS won the Southwest Division first-half title by seven games over second-place Erie. For the year, Richmond is tied for second among all 30 Double-A teams in batting average (.268), first in sacrifice flies (50), fourth in hits (1056), fourth in doubles (212) and fourth in triples (29). The team has combined for 116 homers this year, surpassing 12 of the franchise's previous 15 season totals. On Aug. 18 at Chesapeake, the Flying Squirrels set new single-season record for stolen bases, passing 168 in 2014. The Flying Squirrels are on pace to set offensive single-season franchise records for batting average, runs, total bases, doubles, RBIs, OBP, SLG, OPS and sacrifice flies. Richmond's No. 9 batters have combined to hit .313 this year, which leads the minors. The Flying Squirrels have scored 10-or-more runs 12 times this year, passing 2023 (11) for the most in a season in franchise history. The Richmond pitching staff has thrown 10 shutouts this season, which is first in the Eastern League, second in Double-A and tied for third in MiLB.

THE SEA DOGS are in fourth place in the Northeast Division second-half standings, 5.5 games behind first-place Reading. Portland is 3-10 in its last 13 games and has lost five straight since August 20. The Portland roster features six players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including OF Justin Gonzales (No. 2), 2B/SS Henry Godbout (No. 5), 2B Yoelin Cespedes (No. 14), 3B/1B Jack Winnay (No. 21), LHP Hayden Mullins (No. 23) and 2B Mason White (No. 28). MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list features eight Portland players, including Gonzales (No. 2), Godbout (No. 6), Cespedes (No. 14), Winnay (No. 23), White (No. 26), Mullins (No. 27), OF Miguel Bleis (No. 28) and C Johanfran Garcia (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Shane Rademacher** makes his first start of the 2026 season. It is his first start since his last appearance of the 2025 season last September against Hartford. Rademacher last pitched on Friday in Bowie and allowed one run over 1.1 innings. He has gone 1-0 with a 2.81 ERA in last eight appearances since July 3. Rademacher signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent out of Chowan University in 2023. He made five starts and five relief appearances with the Flying Squirrels last year. **For more on Rademacher, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Left-hander Hayden Mullins makes his 18th start of the season and the second of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Thursday against Reading and allowed two runs (one earned) over six innings in a loss. He has gone 0-2 with a 1.84 ERA (3 ER/14.2 IP/24 SO/7 BB) in his three August starts. He faced the Flying Squirrels on July 22, 2025, at The Diamond and allowed one run over four innings. Mullins was selected by the Red Sox in the 12th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Auburn. He is in his second season with Portland. For the seasons, he is tied for seventh in the Eastern League in strikeouts (112).

SABIN SURGING: **Sabin Ceballos** had his third two-homer game of the season last Wednesday night and added a homer on Tuesday. He has nine walks over his last nine games dating back to August 14. Ceballos has 64 walks this season, the fourth-most in a season in franchise history. He is two walks behind Hayden Cantrelle (66, 2023) for third place on the list. In his career, Ceballos has worked 111 walks, which is fifth-most in Flying Squirrels franchise history and one behind Ricky Oropesa (112, 2013-16) for fourth.

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 331 wins in his career, which is a franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Of Richmond managers since 1954, Pelfrey is second in wins behind Eddie Haas (1968, 1981-84), who had 351 wins.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Charlie Szykowny** is tied for third in triples (4), seventh in hits (109) and ninth in total bases (180). **Sabin Ceballos** is tied for fifth in walks (64). **Maui Ahuna** is tied for ninth in stolen bases (27). **Diego Velasquez** is fourth in batting average (.295) and sixth in OBP (.384). **Jonah Cox** is tied for first in triples (5) and tied for ninth in stolen bases (27). **Tyler Vogel** is first in saves (15) and tied for third in wins (9). **Trystan Vrieling** is first in shutouts (1), tied for first in complete games (1) and sixth in ERA (4.23).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features four players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Gavin Kilen** (No. 10), **Trevor Cohen** (No. 12), RHP **Miguel Mendez** (No. 20), and RHP **Yunior Marte** (No. 27). Jordan is rated as the organization's best athlete. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including Kilen (No. 6), Cohen (No. 14), Mendez (No. 16), **Jancel Villarroel** (No. 19), Marte (No. 25) and **Lisbel Diaz** (No. 30).

MISC NOTES: **Tyler Vogel** is the first Eastern League reliever to reach 15 saves in a season since Portland's Luis Guerrero (18) in 2023. He now has the fifth-most saves in a season in franchise history, with **Heath Hembre**'s 17 saves in 2011 next on the list. Vogel is also seventh in franchise history in career saves with 21, trailing **Josh Osich** (2013-16) and **Tyler Myrick** (2023-2025) for a tie for fifth with 22. His nine wins this season are the second-most as a reliever in team history, trailing Edwin Quirarte (11, 2014). // **Lisbel Diaz** hit his first Double-A homer on Friday and his 25th overall this season between Low-A San Jose, High-A Eugene and Richmond, which is tied with Bo Davidson, who also homered on Friday, for the most in the Giants organization this year. // **Ryan Vanderhei** is 2-0 with a 0.42 ERA (1 ER/21.1 IP) in his last 16 outings since June 20, allowed one earned run and three total runs in that stretch with 22 strikeouts and a .174 BAA. // There have been 47 Flying Squirrels alumni who have played in the majors this year (plus **Donovan Walton**, who had previous MLB experience before playing in Richmond), including 25 with the Giants. // The Flying Squirrels' series win over the Baysox last week was their first since going 5-1 against Akron from June 23-28 at CarMax Park and their first on the road since going 4-1 at Hartford from April 14-19. Richmond had split four consecutive series prior to last week.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1966: The Richmond Braves beat the Columbus Jets, 6-4, at Parker Field. After an early Richmond lead, Jose Martinez hit a two-run homer in the top of the sixth to tie the score, 3-3. Dave Wissman hit an RBI single in the top of the eighth to give Columbus a 4-3 lead before Chris Cannizzaro tied the game with a single in the bottom of the inning. With two outs in the bottom of the 10th, Tommie Aaron hit a two-run, walk-off homer to win the game. **1979:** The Richmond Braves beat the Tidewater Tides, 3-2, at Parker Field. Bob Beall added a solo homer in the third. Tommy Boggs allowed two runs over 7 1/3 innings and became the first Richmond pitcher to reach 15 wins in the R-Braves era. The win clinched a spot for Richmond in the 1979 Governors Cup playoffs in an attempt to defend their 1978 title. **2019:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Erie Sea-Wolves, 7-6, at UPMC Park. Joey Bart picked up four hits, including a double, and drove in one run. Heliot Ramos had two doubles and three RBIs. Zach Houchins hit a two-run homer. Bryce Johnson went 3-for-5 and scored a run.
