#### **JACKSONVILLE HOLDS ON IN 12-11 THRILLER**

Griffin Conine socked a grand slam and Victor Mesa Jr. added a home run, three hits and four runs scored as Jacksonville earned a rollercoaster 12-11 victory over Gwinnett. Conine's grand slam in the first and Mesa Jr.'s solo shot in the second made it 5-0. The Jumbo Shrimp eventually built an 8-2 lead, only for a five-run Stripers fourth to cut it to one. Jacksonville eventually went up 12-8 in the top of the seventh, only for Gwinnett to plate a run in the bottom of the seventh and two in the eighth to pull to within 12-11. The Jumbo Shrimp held on from there to win.

#### SO. ABOUT LAST NIGHT...

Jacksonville's wild 12-11 victory on Thursday marked several significant milestones for the club in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp scored their second-most runs in a game this season, tying for their third-most hits (13). Additionally, Jacksonville's 10 walks equaled a season-high. Pitching-wise. the Jumbo Shrimp won despite surrendering their secondmost runs (11) and hits (15) in a game this season.

#### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 32 of Jacksonville's 48 games (66.7 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 14 of the club's last 17 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 15 of its last 17 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 14-18 (.438) in these affairs.

#### ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 42-for-135. (.311/.457/.622/1.079) with 10 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 28 RBIs, 33 walks and 23 runs scored in 39 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks second in the IL in OPS, third in both slugging percentage and OBP, tied for eighth in walks, tied for ninth in extra-base hits (31), tied for 10th in extra-base hits and 13th in batting average. Among the 133 qualified hitters in the IL. Bride ranks third in swinging-strike rate (5.0 percent) and 14th in line drive rate (30.6 percent).

#### HAIL TO THE VICTOR

Jacksonville outfielder Victor Mesa Jr. missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 39 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 46- (T-11th in IL) for-159, slashing .289/.360/.484/.844 with seven doubles, eight home runs, 29 RBIs (T-18th), 18 walks and 31 runs scored (T-16th). In 123 games last season with Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 17.9 percent this season with Jacksonville.

#### LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A. Javier Sanoia was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances, meaning he was still making contact and putting the ball in play. That has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 14 of his last 15 games, notching seven multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 23-for-61 (.377/.458/.492/.950) with five doubles, one triple, eight RBIs, 10 walks and eight runs scored. Among the 176 IL hitters with at least 100 plate appearances, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (51.5 percent) and the third-lowest swinging-strike rate (3.1 percent).

#### TOUGH TIMES DON'T LAST

Even with a 12-11 win over Gwinnett on Thursday, Jacksonville has still lost 17 of its last 21 games. The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled particularly on offense during this stretch. Offensively since April 30, when this run began, the club ranks 26th in Triple-A in batting average (.238), 26th in OBP (.329), 30th in SLG (.360), 28th in OPS (.689), 3rd in hits (170) and 28th in runs scored (87). Jacksonville has scored three runs or fewer in 11 of these 21 games, falling from 1.5 games back of first in the standings to 11.5.

#### RUN, DON'T WALK

Despite yielding 417 hits thus far, the fouurth-most in the International League, Jacksonville's 1.36 WHIP ranks second in the circuit. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled at not giving out many free passes to first base for opponents. The club's 172 walks are the third-fewest in the IL heading into play on Friday. Jacksonville has issued three walks or fewer in 26 of the squad's 48 games in 2024 (54.2 percent).

#### **ABOUT MAX**

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Optioned to Jacksonville on April 15.

#### 2023 SEASON

-Did not pitch while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

#### 2022 SEASON

-Meyer made his major league debut for the Marlins on July 16 by throwing 5.1 innings with five strikeouts in a game against the Philadelphia Phillies at loan Depot park. He made two starts before undergoing Tommy John surgery on August 9.

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

#### 2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in IP (101.0).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

#### ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
