FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders hit a pair of home runs late to down the Palm Beach Cardinals in 10-innings on Tuesday night at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium. Esmerlyn Valdez belted a game-tying home run in the ninth before Javier Rivas hit a go-ahead two-run blast in the 10th. Magdiel Cotto tossed two scoreless frames to earn the win

TRADE DEADLINE MARKETPLACE: The Bradenton Marauders made a number of roster moves on Tuesday night which included the promotions of INF Garret Forrester and RHP Mike Walsh to High-A Greensboro. Forrester, the Pirates' No. 18 prospect was then traded to the Miami Marlins for OF Bryan De La Cruz. Other Pirates Top 30 prospects who have joined the team include **RHP Zander Mueth** and **INF Yordany De Los Santos**.

LOST AT SEA: The Marauders snapped their nine-game road losing streak on Tuesday night in Jupiter. It was Bradenton's first win away from LECOM Park since June 27th in Clearwater. Bradenton has lost three straight against Clearwater, Fort Myers, and Tampa. The .238 win percentage on the road is the worst in Minor League Baseball. Bradenton dropped their first nine road games to the start the year as well.

MINI VACATION: On Tuesday, the Bradenton Marauders start their longest stretch of games away from LECOM Park this season, beginning with a six-game set in Palm Beach before traveling to take on the St. Lucie Mets for six games as well.

SEARCHING FOR THE BIG HIT: Last week against the Lakeland Flying Tigers, the Marauders went just 7-for-46 (.152) hitting with runners in scoring position. The Marauders snapped an 0-for-14 stretch going for 2-for-2 on Sunday afternoon. On the other side, Bradenton held Palm Beach to hit just 1-for-15 on Tuesday night.

HOME RUNS SHOULD COME IN PAIRS: Esmerlyn Valdez hit his third multi-home run game of the season on Sunday. Last season, Termarr Johnson and Rodolfo Nolasco each recorded a pair of multi-home run games. There has never been a three-home run game by a Marauder in franchise history. He becomes the first Marauder to record three or more multi-home run games in the same season since Dylan Busby (2021).

AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold three of the top seven home run leaders in the Florida State League, with Esmerlyn Valdez leading the way in second with 15 longballs. Axiel Plaz is currently in fourth with 13 and Shalin Polanco is tied for seventh with 10. Carlson Reed tossed five innings on Thursday night against Lakeland to lower his season ERA to 2.43. He is currently second in the FSL in ERA while also holding opponents to a .199 average, the third-best in the league along with his 96 strikeouts.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Among players in Minor League Baseball this season aged 19 years old or younger, no player has more home runs than **Axiel Plaz**, who hit his 13th home run of the season last Tuesday against Lakeland. Plaz holds the fifth-highest SLG (.472) among players 20 years old or younger as well. Current New York Yankees slugger Giancarlo Stanton holds the record for most HR hit in a season as a teen when he mashed 39 in 2008 as a member of the Greensboro Grasshoppers in the South Atlantic League (now the current Pirates High-A affiliate).

BOMBS AWAY: Since May 1st, the Bradenton Marauders have clubbed 77 home runs in 75 games which is the most by any team in Single-A. Bradenton led Single-A with 31 longballs in the month of June and were just three shy of tying their franchise record. In July, Bradenton has 26 in their first 22 games with Axiel Plaz and Esmerlyn Valdez accounting for 12 of the 26. The 26 home runs are the third-most in Single-A this month, trailing the Inland Empire 66ers who have 26. Bradenton tied their season-high by hitting four home runs on Sunday against Lakeland. They had previously done so on May 9 vs St. Lucie.

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, RHP Khristian Curtis entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30. The Bradenton Marauders now hold 10 of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline after the addition of LHP Anthony Selements lost Thursday.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Saturday night's loss to the Flying Tigers marked the Marauders' 34th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 18-16 record in those games.
