About Last Night: For the first time in 2021, Bowie earned a shutout victory, blanking the Reading Fightin Phils 9-0 in front of 1,103 people. Bowie's starting pitching continued to be spectacular, as **Kyle Bradish** threw five innings and scattered three hits with two walks and nine strikeouts to earn the win. Bradish has now thrown 9.2 shutout innings on the year. **Steven Klimek**, **Tyler Erwin**, and **Tim Naughton** pitched in relief to clinch the shutout. Offensively, Bowie scored four runs in the fourth, and then hit three home runs in the fifth. **Adley Rutschman** led off the home half of the fifth with a solo shot, his second of the year, and **Jaylen Ferguson** followed him up three batters later with a two-run homer. Three batters after Ferguson, **Chris Hudgins** got in on the home run derby, hitting a two-run shot the left to put the Baysox up 9-0, the eventual final score.

New Year, New League: The Eastern League is no more, and the Double-A Northeast League has taken its place. Joining the league this year are the Somerset Patriots, who have replaced the Trenton Thunder. The league is split in two divisions: the Northeast, which includes Binghamton, Hartford, New Hampshire, Portland, Reading, and Somerset, and the Southwest, which includes Akron, Altoona, Bowie, Erie, Harrisburg, and Richmond. A significant change to this year's format is a lack of playoffs at the end of the season; the season will finish upon the completion of the regular season schedule.

Bishop on the Bump: Thursday night will mark **Cameron Bishop's** first start of the season for the Baysox. Bishop threw 3.2 innings in relief in his season debut and earned the win, while allowing four runs (only two of which were earned), on six hits against the Altoona Curve. In the Other Corner: Righty **Kyle Glogoski** was added to the Reading roster late on Wednesday, replacing lefty **Jhordany Mezquita**, the pitcher originally scheduled to start on Thursday. Glogoski joins Reading after beginning the year at Triple-A Lehigh Valley, where he appeared in one game and surrendered six runs on two hits in one inning of work while being tagged with the loss against Rochester. Glogoski has never pitched at the Double-A level, as he spent 2019 in both Class-A and High-A. He was promoted directly to Triple-A to begin the 2021 campaign, and now joins the Fightin Phils.

Adding Adley: The No. 1 overall pick in the 2019 Draft, catcher **Adley Rutschman**, is in his first season with the Bowie Baysox. Rutschman is the focal point of an Orioles organization that is focused on building for the future. A College World Series champion at Oregon State, Rutschman got on base at a .575 clip his junior season, and was the first catcher selected with the first overall pick since Joe Mauer in 2001.

Top Tier Talent: The Bowie Baysox roster is filled with some of the top prospects in the Orioles' farm system. According to MLB.com, four of the top 30 prospects in the organization will begin the season in Bowie. Catcher **Adley Rutschman** (#1) headlines the roster, coming into the year as Baltimore's number one prospect. Left-handed pitcher **D.L. Hall** (#4) is just a few spots behind Rutschman. Infielder **Terrin Vavra** (#12) and RHP **Kyle Bradish** (#14) round out the rest of the Bowie squad in the rankings.

Injured List: Bowie made their first roster transactions of 2021 last night, placing INF Malquin Canelo, RHP Brenan Hanifee, and RHP Reed Hayes on the 7 Day Injured List.

This Day in Baysox History: All the way back on May 13, 2008, Nolan Reimold hit a game-winning two-run home run to beat Erie 5-3. Reimold went on to play in the majors for eight years, playing in 480 games, all but seven of which were for the Baltimore Orioles.
