LAST TIME OUT

The Pelicans scored seven unanswered runs and took down the Augusta GreenJackets 7-1 in Tuesday's series opener. **SS Cristian Hernandez** tallied three hits with four RBI. He also broke the franchise stolen base record with number 59 and 60 for his career. **LHP Angel Hernandez** struck out six across 2.1 innings to earn the victory. The Pelicans have now won seven of their last 10 games.

THE SILVER SEASON

The Pelicans will be celebrating their 25th season in 2024. After the departure of the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes in 1992, the Pelicans were established in 1999 following the relocation of the Durham Bulls to Myrtle Beach. During their 25 seasons, the Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in 1999, 2000, 2015, and 2016. Myrtle Beach has been affiliated with three teams in their 25 seasons, including the Atlanta Braves (1999-2010), Texas Rangers (2011-2014), and the Chicago Cubs (2015-present).

PELICANS POWER

After pacing the league last year with 104 home runs, the Pelicans are once again leading the league this year with 66 on the season. After hitting 12 home runs last year to place second on the team, **OF Andy Garriola** currently leads the league with 16, and is fourth in Pelicans' franchise history with 28 career home runs. In his first year in Myrtle Beach, **OF Alfonsin Rosario** ranks second with 12 homers, seven of those being hit on the road. Just 30 of the 66 home runs hit by the Pelicans have been hit in Myrtle Beach, with 36 being hit in road ballparks. The 66 home runs have been hit by 16 different players.

TOP BIRDS

Currently, the Pelicans roster features four of the Cubs' top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. Interestingly, the top two prospects are brothers as **INF Cristian Hernandez** and his younger brother **INF Alexis Hernandez** stand as the No. 17 and No. 18 Cubs prospects, respectively. 20-year-old Cristian led the Pelicans in games played last year with 106, hitting .223 with four home runs while splitting time between shortstop and second base. 19-year-old Alexis hit .315 across 37 games in the Arizona Complex League last season while playing second, third, and shortstop. No. 27 Cubs prospect **RHP Nazier Mulé** was added to the Pelicans' roster in late May after missing all of 2023 with Tommy John surgery. He was the Cubs' fourth-round pick in 2022 out of high school. **OF Alfonsin Rosario** entered the Cubs' top prospects list at No. 30 in 2024. Rosario was a 6th round pick in 2023 out

of high school

BUDDY IS BACK

A familiar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2024 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his seventh year in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18 and 2021-23, and will be coaching his 18th season in the Cubs organization. During his Pelicans tenure, Bailey has recorded 467 wins, the most in franchise history. He has also guided the Birds to four half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau- he currently sits with 2,394. Bailey passed Mike Kelley (managed from 1901-1931) for third-place all time on the MiLB managers wins list on July 14th, 2024 with win number 2,391 over the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. 2024 will be his 36th season as a minor league manager.

PELICAN POINTS

The Pelicans return to Pelicans Ballpark for a six-game set with the Augusta GreenJackets. It will continue their monstrosous stretch of home games to start the second half, as 21 of their first 30 second half games are at home. The Pelicans split the series with the GreenJackets in Myrtle Beach from May 7-12, and dropped four of the six games in Augusta from June 4-9.

Through the first 91 games, the Pelicans lead all of Minor League Baseball with 137 wild pitches

Pelicans' **INF Cristian Hernandez** is currently sixth in the Carolina League with 81 hits.

Pelicans' **OF Andy Garriola** is currently the Carolina League leader with 16 HR and second with 59 RBI. He is also currently the leader with 36 extra-base hits.

OF Jacob Wetzel set the franchise RBI record on June 1st with a two-run triple, he currently stands at 131. He set the franchise record with his 128th career walk on 6/6 at Augusta. The third-year Pelican also holds the franchise record in runs scored at 161.

The Pelicans have won four Carolina League championships in team history, with the last one coming in 2016. The Birds have also won in 1999, 2000, and 2015.

BIRD DROPPINGS

- The Pelicans made back-to-back playoff appearances after winning the Carolina League South Half Championships in 2022 and 2023.
- After leading the league in home runs last year, the Pelicans lead the league with 66 in 2024
- The 23 strikeouts by the Pelicans pitching staff in the 12-inning game against Augusta on May 9th were the most strikeouts by a team in all of MiLB this season, the most by a Carolina League team since 2017, and the most for the Birds since they struck out 32 batters in a 23-inning game against Kinston in 2011

- Through the first 91 games, the Pelicans pitching staff leads all of MiLB with 137 wild pitches
- The Pelicans turned a triple play on May 7 against the Augusta GreenJackets
- Andy Garriola currently leads the Carolina League with 16 HR and is second with 59 RBI
- The Pelicans walked 17 batters on 4/17 setting a new single-game franchise high
- The Pelicans 1:50 game against the Columbia Fireflies was the shortest nine-inning game in the Carolina League this season, and the shortest game for the Pelicans since 7/23/11 at Frederick (1:46)
- The Pelicans eight game losing streak from 6/29-7/6 is the longest since 6/2-6/14/2019 (9)
