### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On July 21, 2016, the Sounds beat the Oklahoma City RedHawks twice. The first game completed a suspended contest from April 24. The Sounds ended up winning 9-2 with the help of Carlos Villanueva pitching the remaining 7 innings. Nashville then beat Oklahoma City 4-1 in 7 innings with Zach Sorensen going 4-for-4.

**Today's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp play game two of a six-game series at 121 Financial Ballpark. The Nashville Sounds' losing skid reached four on Tuesday night, as they totaled just three hits and were unable to take advantage of eight walks in a 4-0 loss against the Jacksonville Jumbo. Right-hander Josh Lindblom starts for Nashville against right-hander Josh A. Smith for Jacksonville.

**Josh Lindblom:** 34-year-old Josh Lindblom makes his 11th appearance (ninth start) for Nashville today. He pitched to a no decision in his last start on July 15 vs. Louisville. He set season-highs in innings pitched (6.2), pitches (100) and matched a season-high in strikes (69). Lindblom allowed six hits and struck out seven in Nashville's 5-4 win. The right-hander has eight appearances with Milwaukee where he was 0-0 with a 9.72 ERA prior to being designated for assignment on May 26. He was then sent outright to Nashville on May 28. Lindblom signed a three-year deal with the Brewers on December 16, 2019.

**Josh A. Smith:** 33-year-old Josh A. Smith starts for the Jumbo Shrimp today in game two. The Florida native is making his eighth appearance (sixth start) with Jacksonville and is 2-0 with a 2.76 ERA (9 ER/29.1 IP). He made 16 appearances (one start) with Miami in 2020 and went 1-1 with a 6.84 ERA (20 ER/26.1 IP). He was drafted by Cincinnati in the 21st round of the 2010 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Lipscomb University.

**2021 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 37, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

**Lindblom's Dominance:** Today's starter Josh Lindblom has been dominant away from First Horizon Park this season. He is 3-0 with a 0.89 ERA (2 ER/20.1 IP) in six appearances (four starts) and has 19 strikeouts. The right-hander is yet to allow more than one run in any appearance this season.

**Not a Familiar Foe:** The Sounds and the Jumbo Shrimp faced off for the first time as Triple-A teams last night. Jacksonville played in the Triple-A International League from 1962-1968 and the Double-A Southern League from 1970-2019.

**Goose Egg:** The Sounds offense was shutout for the second time in three games in last night's 4-0 loss. Nashville has been shutout five times this season and three times in July.

**Season-High Skid:** With last night's loss, the Sounds have matched a season-high with a four-game losing streak. They previously lost four consecutive games on the heels of their 15-game winning streak on June 12-16.

**Struggling at the Dish:** Nashville has found itself in an offensive funk the last four games, scoring just three runs and being outscored overall, 31-3. After hitting .261 with an .840 OPS in May, and .250 with a .764 OPS in June, the Sounds are hitting just .216 with a .648 OPS through the first 18 games in the month of July.

**Reyes Returns:** Infielder Pablo Reyes returns to the Sounds after being optioned from Milwaukee on July 16. Reyes has been up and down for the majority of 2021, getting optioned to Nashville on May 22, June 18, June 30 and July 16. He has been recalled by Milwaukee on June 4, June 28 and July 2. In 11 games with Nashville in 2021, Reyes is hitting .283 (15-for-53) with 15 runs, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 4 RBI and 8 walks while starting games at shortstop, second base and third base.

**Lipka's on a Roll:** Outfielder Matt Lipka has been on a tear since joining the Sounds via trade on June 28. He has reached base safely in 14 of his last 15 games, batting .354 (17-for-48) with 7 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 9 RBI, 7 walks and 5 stolen bases.

**How Sweet It Is:** Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,071-1,948. The 2,071 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

**The Milwaukee Era:** A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
