HAUNTED HUNTINGTON: With Friday evening's win and Saturday's rainout, the Saints ensured their first winning road trip to Huntingon Park in nine tries in franchise history. A win on Friday marked just the first time they've taken at least 3-of-6 from the Clippers in Ohio since June of 2022 (June 14-19), the only time in franchise history the Saints have split in eight prior attempts. The Saints had previously never won a series in Columbus, including being swept once in an abbreviated five game series. Now 28 of the Saints 51 games (55%) in Columbus since 2021 have been 'close late' by MLB.com's definition, meaning that in the seventh inning or later, the game is either within a run or the trailing team brings the potential tying run on base, at bat, or on deck. After Wednesday's comeback win, the Saints are now 8-20 in 'late/close' situations in Columbus in franchise history. The Saints had lost six straight "late/close" contests before stealing Wednesday night's game in extras. The Saints netured the week with a measeley .277 win% (13-34) at Huntington Park all-time, which ranked as one of the worst five winning percentages for any Triple-A team in a single park the past five seasons, but have nudged themselves outside the top-5 of that dubious leaderboard by taking 3 of the first 4 this week.

SAVE SOME FOR TOMORROW: The ups and downs of the St. Paul offense have continued in the past couple weeks with the Saints scoring as many as 16 runs in last Tuesday's homestand openner, while also being shutout for the fourth time this season in game one of last Friday's doubleheader. The Saints now rank 12th out of 20 International League teams in runs-per-game, averaging 4.6/ game entering play on Sunday. The Saints' low run-scoring rate is despite the team ranking 5th in team batting average (.263) and 4th in OPS (.776). In their 14 wins, the Saints have scored 88 runs (an average of 6.3/game) while in their 14 losses, they've scored just 31 (2.2/game). One of the Saints inconsistencies in run-scoring has been due to hitting with runners in scoring position. They now rank 7th in the International League with a .279 average (73-262) w RISP. In their 14 wins, St. Paul are hitting .345 (57-165) situationally and just .165 (16-97) in their 14 losses.

McCUSKER MASHING HIS WAY INTO RECORD BOOKS: Recently named the Twins minor league player of the month for March/April, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks t-3rd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below). McCusker has two of the top-5 hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and four of the top-10, including a 114.2 mph single on April 2 in Columbus that ranks t-9th in exit velocity among the hardest-hit balls in Saints history. The 6-8 slugger is one of 18 hitters in the minors with at least 7 homers this year and has the most home runs by a St. Paul batter by the end of April in franchise history (no other batter the past five years for the Saints has had more than four by the close of the month). At the end of April, the Sparks, NV native had already collected 23 RBI, the most in Saints history for March/April (see below), 27 total hits, which tied a Saints record for by the end of April, and accrued a 1.049 OPS & .651 SLG%, both the highest in Saints history by that point in the season (min 40 PA).

STRAIGHT GAS: The Saints pitching staff rank as the third-hardest throwing staff in Triple-A to start the season with an average velocity of 89.4 mph that ranks as a <u>harder throwing staff than 19 Major League teams</u>. Despite the extra few ticks, the Saints rank just 10th in K-rate (24.9%) and 8th in whitf-rate (29.0%). By average velocity on fastballs only, St. Paul ranks <u>1-6th in Triple-A</u> (92.6) and 1-2nd in the IL. Ryan Jensen (96.8, 16th) and Alex Speas (96.5, 21st) we both top-25 in the Triple-A circuit in <u>average fastball velo among arms with at least 100 pitches thrown</u>.

The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No 2. MLB.com, No. 2 BA), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17-currently on 7-day IL), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37 on Baseball America's Top-100 list.

TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (14-20) snapped a four-game skid with a win in Boston yesterday afternoon, 4-3. Infielder Kody Clemens broke a 1-1 tie with a two-run homer in the sixth with his father, Roger Clemens, in the stands at Fenway. Down on the farm, Double-M Clichia (15-11) have dropped back-to back games in Frisco, but still have have won 9 of their last 13. Outfielder Kyler Fedko, a 12th round pick out of UConn by the Twins, has reached base in 21 consecutive games to start the year and is hitting .304 with 5 HR and a 1.028 OPS that leads all qualified Minnesota farmhands. High-A Cedar Rapids (16-9) have won 5 of their last 6. Twins No. 14 prospect Billy Amick ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in hitting (.342) and OPS (.922). RHP Charlee Soto, the Twins' No. 8 prospect, was placed on the 7-Day IL with a right triceps strain on Tuesday. He is the third top-10 prospect in the org that is currently on the injured list (also #1-Walker Jenkins, #3 Luke Keaschall). Low-A Fort Myers are 14-12 to start this season.

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Sunday in his second consecutive outing against Indianapolis and failed to reach five innings for the second game in-a-row. Despite walking a career-high four batters, left the game having not allowed a run with two away in the fifth, before both inherited runners scored against Alex Speas to affect his final line. After allowing a leadoff double to Ji Hwan Bae to start the game, did not allow another hit until the fifth, a single by Bae, before striking out Liover Peguero to finish his afternoon. Walked three to load the bases in the fourth after having only walked three in a game once prior in his mi. Threw 38 four-seamers, 19 sliders, 17 cutters, 6 changeups, and 4 curveballs. HITTING THE GLOVE: Last season, Matthews opened up the year on an incredible stretch without walking a batter. He issued his first walk of the season on May 22, seven starts into the campaign (also his 24th birthday). He struck out 49 batters before issuing a walk, facing 141 hitters before issuing a free pass. Since 1893, when the mound was moved to its current position, only tow Major League pitchers began a season with more strikeouts before issuing a walk. Kenley Jansen with the Dodgers in 2017 (51 K) and Corbin Burnes for the Brewers in 2021 (58 K). Matthews led the Minors with a 1.6 29 K:BB ratio last season among all arms with at least 40 IP, and was 6th among all MLB rookies with at least 35.0 IP with a 3.91 ratio during his time in the Bigs to end the year. Since going pro, his career 10.55 K:BB ratio in the minors leads MiLB entering the season (min 200 IP).

TINKERING WITH THE ARSENAL: A big reason for Matthews' success over the past two seasons has been a jump in velocity, which he attributes to attending the Twins' velocity camp before the start of Spring Training. He went from a college pitcher who sat in the low-90's, sometimes touching 96 mph, to a guy who regularly sits at 96 with his fastball while occasionally reaching back for 98. Working with Tommy Bergjans in the Spring of 2024, he scrapped a sweepy slider he threw in 2023 for a harder slider in 2024, which pairs well with his cutter, curveball, and changeup.

WHAT THE HECK IS A CATAMOUNT?: After starting his college career at Walters State Community College (TN) in 2019, Matthews transferred to the Divison 1 ranks at Western Carolina, where he would put together one of the best careers for a Catamount pitcher in school history. After being limited to just 61.1 innings due to an elbow injury as a RS sophomore, he put together a 1st Team All-Southern Conference campaign in 2022, striking out 122, the only pitcher in the SoCon's history to eclipse the century mark; it was the third-most strikeouts in a single-season in program history for Western Carolina. When he went in the 8th round (234th overall) in 2022, he became the highest draft pick in Western Carolina history.

**HIGHS & LOWS:** While a high school pitcher, Zebby once gave up a walk-off homer in the 2nd round of the 2A NCHSAA playoffs while with Smoky Mountain High. After the game, he retrieved the ball from beyond the fence and kept it as motivation. The ball stays on his shelf next to the ball from the game he threw a perfect game in during his senior season.

The right-hander came on in extended relief for the Mariners on July 21, 2021 at Coors Field vs the Rockies. McCaughan managed to give up a run despite throwing five hitless innings; he worked around three walks without recording a strikeout, becoming only the third pitcher since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893 to throw five hitless innings in his MLB debut, and the first in 54 years to do so (per the Elias Sports Bureau). The others to accomplish the feat were Bill Dillman on April 14, 1967 for the Orioles against the Kansas City A's, and Hank Borowy on April 18, 1942 for the Yankees vs the Red Sox. McCaughan retired Raimel Tapia for a lineout in the Bot 2 for his first Big League out, and faced the minimum through his first two innings of work with the help of a double-play. THIS GUY'S A REAL DIRTBAG, AND WE MEAN THAT AS A COMPLIMENT!: Before being drafted in the 12th round THIS GUY'S A REAL DIRTBAG, AND WE MEAN THAT AS A COMPLIMENT: Before being drafted in the 12th round of the 2017 Draft by the Mariners, McCaughan had a remarkable career for Long Beach State, where he pitched three seasons from 2015-17, accruing a 23-5 record and a sparkling 2.31 ERA with 234 strikeouts in 280.2 innings. McCaughan appeared on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list as a sophomore in 2016 and earned 2nd-team All-American honors in both 2016 & 2017 from multiple outlets, becoming the first Long Beach State pitcher since Jared Weaver (2003-04) to do so in consecutive seasons. Long Beach's program compete in the Big West and are nicknamed "The Dirtbags," a moniker that dates back to 1989, when the then-head coach Dave Snow inherited a program in the doldrums. He put an emphasis on finding "hard-nosed players with something to prove" and drove his players to take a tough and gritty approach that included making diving plays, sliding hard into second, and generally dirtying the uniform. The nickname has stuck to this day. McCaughan is one of more than 60 former Dirbtags" that have appeared in a Major League game, a list that includes Jason Giambi, Evan Longoria, Troy Tulowitzki, Jeff McNeil, and Jered Weaver.
