YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 10-1. Three errors by Erie in the second allowed Brett Auerbach to score, giving Richmond a 1-0 lead. In the third, Andrew Navigato brought in a run with a groundout, Colt Keith hit a sac fly and Dillon Dingler hit a two-run homer to give the SeaWolves a 4-1 lead. Ben Malgeri hit a three-run homer in the fourth to open a 7-1 Erie lead. Richmond starter Nick Zwack allowed a career-high seven runs over three innings of work. Erie added three runs in the eighth to pull ahead, 10-1. Ismael Munguia and Luis Matos each had two hits.

TUDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of the six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The two teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 18-23, with Richmond winning four-of-six. The SeaWolves return to The Diamond for a six-game set from May 30-June 4 and the Flying Squirrels close the regular season at UPMC where the four set of the Southwest Division and the South and 7-3 in games following a loss.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are in first place in the division, 2.5 games ahead of Altoona, and split last week's six-game series at home against the Curve. The Flying Squirrels offense is ranked fourth in the Eastern League in runs (135), batting average (.240) and hits (208). The Richmond pitching staff is ranked second in ERA (3.37) and third in strikeouts (263).

THE SEAWOLVES were swept in five games against the Sea Dogs from April 26-30 before taking four-of-six against the Baysox in Bowie last week. The Erie offense leads the Eastern League in runs (146), homers (35) and RBIs (136). Erie's roster includes 10 of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), INF Colt Keith (No. 4), RHP Ty Madden (No. 5), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8), C Dillon Dingler (No. 14), RHP Dylan Smith (No. 15), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21), RHP Elvis Alvarado (No. 23), RHP Austin Bergner (No. 27) and INF Gage Workman (No. 29). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Flores (No. 3), Madden (No. 4), Keith (No. 5), Dingler (No. 7), Smith (No. 17), Perez (No. 19), Hurter (No. 26) and Workman (No. 27). Baseball America also including the following Erie players on their Best Tools list: Perez (best hitter for average), Andrew Magno (best current). Flores (host doffnerive) and Workman (host doffnerive) folded prev Magno (best current). curveball), Flores (best control), Dingler (best defensive catcher) and Workman (best defensive infielder and best infield arm).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Mason Black** makes sixth Double-A start and second against the SeaWolves. He last pitched on Thursday against the Curve and allowed a season-high-tying four runs over 3.1 innings of work in a loss. Black pitched against the SeaWolves on April 21 at The Diamond and allowed four runs (two earned) in 2.1 innings in a loss. A native of Scranton, Pa., Black was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University, where he was the Patriot League Pitcher of the Year as a junior. He made his professional debut last season with the Low-A San Jose Giants, posting a 1.57 ERA in eight starts. Black led the minors with a 0.35 ERA for the month of May last season and earned a promotion to High-A Eugene on May 24. For the season, he ranked fourth in the Giants organization with 136 strikeouts last year and was named aw NII B come Giants Organization All Star Black in Plack is recorded by Baschall America as the Ne 0. Giants proceed and Ne 10. named an MiLB.com Giants Organization All-Star. Black is rated by Baseball America as the No. 9 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. For more on Black, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Ty Madden makes his sixth start of the season and second against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Madden worked five innings and allowed three runs in a no-decision at Bowie on Thursday. He pitched at The Diamond against the Flying Squirrels on April 21 and allowed two unearned runs over four innings with five strikeouts in a no-decision. Madden made his final regular-season start of 2022 against the Flying Squirrels on September 16 at The Diamond and struck out nine but allowed four runs in 4.2 innings. He started Game 2 of the Southwest Division Series in Richmond on September 22 and allowed solo homers to Ricardo Genoves and Carter Aldrete over two innings. Madden was selected by the Tigers with the 32nd-overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Texas. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 4 Tigers prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop Marco Luciano was activated with the Flying Squirrels last Tuesday and made his official Double-A debut on Wednesday night. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Lu-ciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. On Thursday night, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. He has reached base in each of his five games played this season, including a double on Tuesday.

FULL MUNGUIA: After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, Ismael Munguia is batting .359 (14-for-39) with a homer, four doubles and five RBIs over his last 10 games, including six two-hit games. He kicked off the stretch on April 27 in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. Munguia is tied for sixth in the league in hits (29) and tied for sixth in runs scored (18). For the year, he is batting .375 (9-for-24) in the first inning.

MATOS MANIA: Luis Matos reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base in six-of-his-eight games since then and in 24-of-26 games overall this season. For the year, Matos has struck out just 11 times in 110 plate appearances (10.0 percent), the third-lowest rate in the league. Matos clubbed his second Double-A home in Sunday's win over the Curve and collected two hits, including a double, on Tuesday night to open this carries are actively for the second Double on Tuesday night to open this double. second Double-A homer in Su series against the SeaWolves.

DLD FRIENDS: Erie's roster includes former Flying Squirrels outfielder Diego Rincones, who signed with the Tigers as a free agent in December. Rincones played 142 games with Richmond over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, batting .269 (140-for-520) with 20 homers and 80 RBIs. Three total former Flying Squirrels are playing with other teams in the Eastern League this year. Pitcher Gray Fenter, who was with Richmond last season and with Bowie in 2021, is now with Somerset. First baseman Frankie Tostado, a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for Harrisburg.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Tyler Fitzgerald is ranked fifth in batting average (.324), sixth in OBP (.410), fourth in SLG (.588), fourth in OPS (.998), tied for sixth in doubles (6), first in triples (3) and eighth in extra-base hits (11). Ismael Munguia tied for sixth in hits (29) and tied for sixth in runs scored (18). Riley Mahan is tied for eighth in RBIs (16). Carter Aldrete is tied for eighth in RBIs (16). Andy Thomas is tied for fifth in walks (19). Luis Matos is tied for eighth in hits (28) and 10th in batting average (.295). Kai-Wei Teng is tied for seventh in strikeouts (32). Juan Sanchez and Nick Swiney are tied for second in wins (3). Evan Gates is tied for seventh in saves (3).

WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Wenceel Perez is seventh in batting average (.304). Trei Cruz is tied for fifth in homers (5), 10th in SLG (.488), Colt Keith is tied for fifth in homers (5), second in RBIs (20), tied for fourth in extra-base hits (12) and tied for third in total bases (54). Gage Workman is tied for second in triples (2). Angel De La Cruz is tied for third in games pitched (10).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America*'s Top-30 Giants prospects, including Marco Luciano (No. 1, No. 30 overall), Luis Matos (No. 5), Mason Black (No. 9), Carson Seymour (No. 12), Landen Roupp (No. 13), Ryan Murphy (No. 20), Nick Swiney (No. 24) and Randy Rodriguez (No. 30). ROAD TO THE SHOW: Infielder Casey Schmitt made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants on Tuesday night at Oracle Park. He hit a solo homer in the fourth inning for his first major league hit in his second at-bat. He finished the game 2-for-4. Schmitt played 29 games for the Flying Squirrels in 2022, batting .342 with three homers and 16 RBIs. He was also named the MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove Award winner as the top defensive third baseman in the minors last year. With his MLB debut, Schmitt became the 86th Flying Squirrels alum in franchise history to reach the majors. He is the second alum to debut in the big leagues this year, joining 2021-22 Richmond pitcher **Tristan Beck**.
