TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express continue a six-game series at Sutter Health Park with the Sacramento River Cats (San Francisco Giants) on Wednesday afternoon. Round Rock RHP Johnny Cueto is slated to take the mound against River Cats LHP Carson Whisenhunt. First pitch is scheduled for 2:05 p.m. CT.

DOMINANT START TO THE SERIES

The Round Rock Express snapped a four-game losing streak as they shut out the Sacramento River Cats by a final score of 5-0 on Tuesday night at Sutter Health Park. Round Rock starter RHP Jack Leiter earned the win after a stellar outing that included 7.0 shutout innings. Leiter's start included five hits and eight strikeouts. Sacramento starter RHP Carson Seymour was tagged with the loss as he allowed three runs, four hits and two walks with three Ks over his 5.0 innings on the mound. Round Rock 2B Jax Biggers brought home three runs in the second inning with a home run to right field. The dinger scored RF Derek Hill and SS Jose Barrero, who had both reached base on singles. After both sides saw six scoreless innings, Biggers crossed home plate again for the Express in the top of the ninth. Biggers worked a leadoff walk, moved to third base on a single from CF Dustin Harris, then made it a 4-0 game on a wild pitch. Harris found second on the wild pitch, moved to third as 3B Jonathan Ornelas lined out, and scored on a River Cats error. A three up, three down bottom of the frame sealed the 5-0 victory.

CUETO IS BACK IN THE SAC

Round Rock RHP Johnny Cueto is slated to take the ball on Tuesday in Sacramento. The right-hander leads spent six seasons with the San Francisco Giants from 2016-21, making six rehab starts for the River Cats in that stretch, recording an 0-1 record with a 1.62 ERA (4 ER/22.2 IP) and 21 strikeouts. This season, Cueto owns a 1-1 record with a 5.91 ERA (14 ER/21.1 IP) and 18 strikeouts over five starts for the Express.

BACK ON TRACK

Tuesday night's 5-0 win in Sacramento marked the end of a four-game losing skid for the Express. It was their longest losing streak since their seven-game skid from April 11-18.

JACK ATTACK

Round Rock RHP Jack Leiter put on a clinic last night, earning the win after a stellar outing that included 7.0 shutout innings. He allowed five hits while striking out eight and no walks. This was the longest start of his minor league career. Tuesday also marked the third quality start of the season for the former second overall pick. Leiter now owns a record of 3-3 with a 3.61 ERA (19 ER/47.1 IP) with 62 strikeouts in 2024.

BLANK SPACE

Entering Tuesday's contest, the Express had been shutout five times in the last 18 games. Round Rock bounced back with a clean sheet of its own, thanks to the 5-0 victory, its third shutout win of the 2024 campaign.

GETTING BIGGERS

Round Rock INF Jax Biggers has found his power stroke recently, going 1-for-3 with a home run, three RBI, two runs, and a walk on Tuesday. Biggers' long ball on Tuesday was his second home run in his last four games on Tuesday. The Texas native had played in 49 games before going yard in 2024, and he only has 22 homers in 440 career minor league games.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

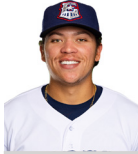
