Reading and Binghamton resume yesterday's suspended game tonight at 5:15. The game will be played to a nine-inning completion, then a seven-inning game two will follow 30 minutes later.

Rain Rain Go Away

Reading and Binghamtom made it through a little over one-and-a-half innings before it was suspended yesterday. The game was called in the bottom of the second, one out, Casey Martin up in a 3-0 count, with the game still scoreless.

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just eight wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique's win totals with each organization have been: Royals (102), Astros (158), Diamondbacks (225), Yankees (394), Miami (75) and Phillies (38).

Reading's pitching has been strong as of late, especially the starting staff. Last week at Altoona, Reading's pitchers threw 51 innings, allowed 43 hits (0.8/inning), walked 20 batters (3.5 per nine) and had 49 strikeouts (8.6 per nine). In the Altoona series, the staff had a 2.29 ERA, which was best in the Eastern League last week. Reading's starters combined to allow just four-earned runs. Mick Abel (5.0), Griff McGarry (7.0) and Zach Haake (5.0) all did not allow an earned run in their respective outings.

Off the Board

Between the start of the second inning on Saturday, until the bottom of the seventh inning Sunday, Reading pitching did not allow a run. It was a 14-inning shutout streak, marking the longest such streak Reading pitching has had in 2023.

Reading's catchers have combined to be very difficult to run against as of late. Over the last ten games, the group of Max McDowell, Cody Roberts and Herbert Iser have thrown out 17 of 38 would-be base stealers. That's good for a 45% clip.

Around the Organization

The Phillies defeated the Baltimore Orioles 4-3 on an Alec Bohm walk-off hit. Johan Rojas also had a hit and RBI in the win. Lehigh Valley fell to Syracuse 10-3 in a game that was called in the sixth inning due to rain. Kody Clemens, Dustin Peterson and Weston Wilson all homered. Jersey Shore and Aberdeen were postponed due to rain in Lakewood. Clearwater fell 8-5 at Jupiter yesterday to open a series. Cade Fergus had two doubles, a homer and scored three runs. Emaarion Boyd stole two more bases and is up to 43 on the season. Just Crawford also doubled in the loss.

Ponies Rumbling into Town

Binghamton enters today with a 7-13 record in the second half and 42-47 overall record in 2023. Binghamton split a six-game series last week at home against Erie, posting wins on Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday. After this week, the Rumble Ponies return home for a six-game series against New Hampshire. Brandon McIlwain leads the team offensively with a .267 average and 44 RBI entering today. Binghamton ranks last in the Eastern League with a .227 average and is 10th with a 4.49 ERA. Luke Ritter is currently with triple-A Syracuse after a strong start with Binghamton.

Righty Dom Hamel is scheduled to start the second game tonight. In 2023, Hamel is 4-5 with a 5.09 ERA over 17 games/16 starts. Across 76 innings, he's allowed 76 hits, walked 32 batters and has 99 strikeouts. Hamel pitched at Reading on June 10, going six innings and allowing just one run on three hits, with nine strikeouts in a no-decision. He last pitched July 20 against Erie, going five innings, and allowed three-earned on five hits and two strikeouts in another no-decision. Hamel pslit 2022 between St. Lucie and Brooklyn and went 10-3 with a 3.25 ERA over 25 games. He made his pro debut in 2021 with the Rookie Mets after being selected in the third round in 2021 out of Dallas Baptist.
