FROM THE CROW'S NEST

POSTSEASON-BOUND: The Marauders are headed to the postseason for the fifth time in franchise history, and the first time since 2016. That 2016 postseason featured Bradenton's first-ever trip to the Florida State League Championship Series, which the Marauders won over Tampa, 3 games to 1.

CHASING HISTORY: With six games remaining in the regular season, the Marauders have a chance to match the franchise's second-highest season win total of 76, set in the team's inaugural season in 2010. The franchise's record for wins in a season is 78, set in 2014.

STAY CLASSY, SAMANIEGO: Left-hander **Tyler Samaniego** has started strong in his first professional season, allowing just 2 runs (1 earned) over 5 IP. The Alabama native, drafted this season in the 15th round out of the University of South Alabama, has recorded 10 strikeouts while walking just 2, and opponents are batting just .200 against him.

ENDY'S GAME: **Endy Rodriguez** has hit safely in 16 of his last 18 games, batting .380 during that stretch while finishing a triple shy of the cycle on both Thursday and Saturday last week. Since the beginning of July (51 games), Rodriguez is batting .328 with a .976 OPS and 40 RBI. He is currently second in the league with 104 hits and tied for third with 67 RBI.

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: **Jackson Glenn** has reached base safely in each of his first 24 games at Low-A, batting .349 with a .476 OBP. The Pirates' fifth-round draft pick out of Dallas Baptist has hit safely in 21 of the 24 games, and has 21 walks and just 16 strikeouts.

THE OPPONENT: The Flying Tigers are coming off a rain-shortened 4-games-to-1 series win in Port St. Lucie, where weather interfered in some fashion Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Lakeland's 5-2 loss on Sunday ended a 5-game winning streak, the team's longest of the season. Between May 18-23, the Flying Tigers handed the Marauders their first series loss of the season. Lakeland outscored Bradenton 55-28 in the series.

TOP PROSPECTS: Per midseason prospect ranking updates, the Marauders roster currently includes four prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: **Hudson Head** (#12), **Jared Jones** (#15), **Endy Rodriguez** (#19), and **Maikol Escotto** (#20). Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the Joe Musgrove trade in January, while Escotto was one of four prospects obtained from the Yankees in the Jameson Taillon trade.

UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: Bradenton pitchers' 1,239 strikeouts are fourth-most in all of MiLB (San Jose leads with 1,368)... The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +103 (Tampa's +226 is second in all of MiLB)... Seven Marauders players rank within the league's top 10 in home runs: **Hudson Head** (15 HR, 3rd), **Jase Bowen** and **Endy Rodriguez** (14 HR, T-4th), **Jack Herman** (13 HR, 5th), **Daniel Lopez** and **Alexander Mojica** (9 HR, T-9th), and **Sammy Siani** (8 HR, T-10th).
