By the Numbers

In Wednesday's 17-5 game one win versus Beloit, Lake County has scored 17-plus runs twice this season. The Captains scored a franchise record 20 runs on July 5 versus Dayton. <u>The 2024 season marks the 3rd time since at least 2005 a Captains team has scored 17+ runs in a game twice in a campaign (2007, 2022)</u>.

C Cooper Ingle has posted a .475 OBP since May 17, which leads full-season Minor League Baseball (Single-A through Triple-A) in that span, leading Double-A Portland/Triple-A Worcester C Mickey Gasper (.472) by 3 points.

Lake County leads the Midwest League with 446 walks, the 2nd-most in High-A. <u>The Captains have logged their most walks through 98 games since at least 2005.</u>

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: Beloit LF Dalvy Rosario made a diving catch with the bases loaded in the bottom of the 10th, denying Lake County 2B Jake Fox of a walk-off extra-base hit and handing the Captains a 3-2 loss on Thursday at Classic Auto Group Park. The Captains are now 7-3 in extra inninos in 2024.

Beloit took a 3-2 lead in the top of the 10th on an RBI fielder's choice by RF Brett Roberts. The Captains tied the game in the bottom of the 9th when RF Esteban González hit a game-tying RBI double. 2B Tyresse Turner was thrown out at home trying to score the winning run, and González was picked off trying to steal 3th.

ICING ON THE CAKE: On his 24th birthday, RHP Dylan DeLucia (ND) set Minor League bests in strikeouts (5), innings pitched (4.2), and total pitches (63). After allowing an RBI single in the top of the 1st and a solo homer in the top of the 2st. he refired 10 of his last 11 batters faced.

ZACH ATTACK: RHP Zach Jacobs pitched 3.1 no-hit innings of relief, striking out 4 and walking 1 to extend his scoreless innings streak to 8.2 innings. <u>His</u> 2.05 ERA as a reliever is the 2nd-lowest among MWL relievers with 40+ innings pitched.

BURGOS BASHES: DH Jorge Burgos recorded his 2nd multi-hit game in his ast 3 games on Thursday, going 2-for-5 and reaching base safely in 10 of his ast 11 games. He has 9 homers since June 14, the most in the MWL in that snan.

GET OUT THE RYE BREAD AND MUSTARD: On Wednesday, 2B Travis Bazzana, the No. 1 overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft, hit a grand slam for his 1st Minor League home run. It marks LC's 6th grand slam of the year, the 2nd-most by a Captains team since at least 2005 (7, 2022).

GENAO AND LATER: INF Angel Genao, MLB Pipeline's No. 11 Cleveland prospect, went 3-for-5 with a 2-run HR in and 4 RBI in game 1 and 2-for-4 in game 2. He has hit safely in 31 of his first 39 High-A games, and his 113 hits across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg are 7th in Mil.B. He is 1 of 2 players in MiLB with a .320+ AVG, 35+ XBH, and 20+ SB this season.

THE WORLDWIDE LEADER: In the top of the 3rd in Game 2 of Wednesday's doubleheader, CF Esteban González made a tumbling catch into the center field wall. His catch was the No. 2 play on Sports Center's Top 10 on Wednesday.

EASTSIDE JOHNNY & THE LAKE COUNTY NUKES: In Game 2 on Wednesday, C Johnny Tincher went 1-for-2 with a 2-run single, extending his hitting streak to 7 james and his on-base streak to 10. <u>Tincher's .333 AVG in July was tied for 3rd-</u> best in the MWL among hitters with 35+ plate appearances.

MEAN STREAKS: C Cooper Ingle, MLB Pipeline's No. 28 Cleveland prospect, is on a team-best 14-game on-base streak. C Johnny Tincher has a 10-game on-base streak and 7-game hit streak, tied for the 2nd-longest active hit streak in the MWL. INF Angel Genao is also on a 6-game hit streak.

MOON LANDING: On July 24 at Great Lakes, Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, went 1-for-3 with a double, <u>becoming the 4th Captain in</u> franchise history (2003-present) to record 30 XBH and 30 SB in a season.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

ALL THAT BAZ: 2B Travis Bazzana, Baseball America's No. 19 MLB prospect, hit a grand slam for his 1st career professional home run in Game 1 on Wednesday. He recorded his 1st Minor League multi-hit game in his 2nd contest on July 28th at Great Lakes, going 2-for-4 with a double and 2 runs scored. Bazzana joins Henry Davis (2021) and Carlos Correa (2012) as the only No. 1 picks since 2010 to homer within their first 5 games of full-season Minor League Baseball.

COOPER (NEVER) TIRES: C Cooper Ingle, MLB Pipeline's No. 30 Cleveland prospect, leads the MWL in AVG (.322) and ranks 2nd in OBP (.437). The last MWL player to win the batting title and OBP title in the same season was Cedar Rapids OF Mike Trout (.362/.454) in 2010.

LEADERS OF THE PACK: Lake County's pitching staff leads the Midwest League with a 3.53 team ERA. The Captains have not won their league's ERA title since the inaugural 2003 season, leading the South Atlantic League with a 2.67 ERA. 2010 AL All-Star and 11-year Major Leaguer Roberto Hernández (known as Fausto Carmona through 2011) led the SAL with 17 wins for the 97-43 Captains.

ACE OF BASE: The Captains have stolen 166 bases through their first 98 games, tied for the single season franchise record (166, 2009). <u>Lake</u>
County are 2nd in MiLB with an 87.4% stolen base percentage.

NAVAL POWER: LHP Matt Wilkinson is 3rd in MiLB with 137 strikeouts this season. Wilkinson (3rd, 137), and former Captains Austin Peterson (6th, 121), and Parker Messick (T-9th, 119) all rank top-10 in MiLB in strikeouts this season.

THE ATLANTIC CAMPAIGN: Since 2021, 13 of Cleveland's draft picks have come from the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), including 6 in the 2023 MLB Draft and 2 in the 2024 Draft. Of those 13 ACC draftees, 6 have played for the Captains this year (LHP Shawn Rapp, LHP Parker Messick, OF Angel Zarate, 1B/LF C.J. Kayfus, C Cooper Ingle, and INF Alex Mooney), with 5 total '23 draftees being current Top 30 Cleveland prospects by MLB Pipeline.

FEELS LIKE 2010: Lake County earned its 57th win in its 93rd contest, the franchise's most wins through 93 games since at least 2005. The 2010 Captains rank 2nd by going 56-37 through their first 93 games, en route to winning that year's Midwest League title.

EXTRA, EXTRA, RUN ALL ABOUT ITI: INF Alex Mooney (30 XBH, 34 SB) and OF Esteban González (31 XBH, 38 SB) are 2 of 7 MiLB players with 30+XBH and 30+SB this season. Cleveland is the only organization with multiple MiLB players in this group.

LAST TIME OUT: On July 27 at Great Lakes, Matt Wilkinson (2-3) got the loss pitching 5 innings, allowing 3 runs on 2 hits while striking out 8 and walking 2 in the 4-1 loss. After allowing a sacrifice fly and a 2-run home run in the bottom of the 1st, Wilkinson retired 13 of his last 15 batters.

MINOR LEAGUE RANKS: Across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, Wilkinson leads qualified Minor League pitchers with 14.34 strikeouts per 9 innings, a 40.7% strikeout rate, and a 32.6% strikeout-to-walk percentage. He also ranks 3rd with 137 strikeouts, a 2.09 ERA and a .173 opposing AVG. Wilkinson and then-Double-A Akron (current Triple-A Columbus) LHP Logan Allen are the only Cleveland Minor Leaguers since at least 2005 to reach 100+ strikeouts through a team's first 70 games.

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": Wilkinson has held the nickname "Tugboat" from a young age. His father's best friend growing up, Phil McNeil, gave Matt the nickname, "after seeing Wilkinson run around the bases at a pace he thought was similar to that of the boat designed to tow larger vessels," MLB.com's Rob Terranova wrote. "Ilove being called Tugboat," Wilkinson said to Terranova. "But I don't want people to forget that I'm Matt Wilkinson, too."

PIPELINE PROMOTION: Wilkinson moved into MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Cleveland Prospects this week, slotting in at No. 30. He is the 6th current Captain and 6th member of the 2023 MLB Draft Class to make the list this year. His MLB Pipeline scouting grades are as follows: Fastball = 50, Slider = 40, Changeup = 50, and Control = 50.

A START FOR THE AGES: On April 25, Wilkinson made Minor League Baseball history in his start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC). The left-hander pitched 6 scoreless, hitless innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 15 strikeouts in 82 pitches (56 strikes). According to MiLB.com's Jesús Cano, Wilkinson became the 5th MiLB pitcher since 2005 to record at least 15 strikeouts without allowing a hit. The MLB pitchers to do this are Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn (1960), 1971 NL All-Star Don Wilson (1967), Hall-of-Famer Nolan Ryan (3 times), 3-time NL Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw (2014, whom Wilkinson said was his favorite player at the 2015 Little League World Series), and 3-time Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer (2015).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Wilkinson was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April as a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. In 4 starts, he went 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA, a Minor League-best 41 strikeouts, and a Minor League-best .091 opposing AVG. Wilkinson also allowed just 6 hits and 6 walks in 20.2 innings of work

VALIANT VAQUERO: After initially committing to the University of Washington, Wilkinson pitched collegiately at Central Arizona College (JUCO), where he was 2023 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year, a 2023 NJCAA 1st Team All-American, the 2023 ABCA/Rawlings Pitcher of the Year, and the Arizona Community College Athletic Association Pitcher of the Year In 2023, the he went 10-2 with a 1.07 ERA, 136 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP, and 2 complete games in 16 appearances (14 starts) and won the NJCAA Division I Baseball World Series in 2022. Following his 2023 campaign, Wilkinson eventually chose to forgo his commitment to Arizona State after being selected by the Guardians in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft.

LITTLE LEAGUE LEGEND: When he was 12 years old, Wilkinson had a remarkable performance at the 2015 Little League World Series as a member of Team Canada. In his only start, he pitched 5 scoreless innings against Team Mexico, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 16 strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat. "(The LLWS) was definitely a cool experience, it was like a dream come true," Wilkinson told The Daily Sentinel's James Burky. "It felt like more than a game for the first couple of weeks. Leading up to the tournament, you had to do ESPN interviews, all of those walkup things. I loved it because it was something that I wanted to do since I was eight."

MORE ON WILKINSON: Grew up in Ladner, British Columbia, the same hometown as current Boston Red Sox LHP James Paxton. Has 2 Australian Kelpie dogs, Reggie and Mookie, named after Baseball Hall-of-Famer Reggie Jackson and 8-time MLB All-Star Mookie Betts.

TRAVIS TRAVERSES THE WATERS: On Friday, July 19, the Cleveland Guardians announced that INF Travis Bazzana would begin his Minor League career with the Lake County Captains. After being officially assigned to Lake County on Friday, July 26, he is the 716th Captain of all-time.

MAKING HISTORY: On Sunday, July 14, the Guardians selected Bazzana with the 1st overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft. He is the first No. 1 overall pick in Cleveland franchise history, as well as the 1st second baseman and Australian-born player taken No. 1 overall in MLB Draft history.

INSPIRING HIS COUNTRY: Bazzana is seeking to become the 36th Australian-born player in MLB history. There have been 3 MLB All-Stars born in Australia: 3-time All-Star closer Liam Hendriks, 2013 All-Star closer Grant Balfour, and 1999 All-Star catcher Dave Nillson. "The premise of everything I want to achieve is I want to make Australia a powerhouse in baseball," Bazzana told MLB.com's Sonja Chen. "It's not going to come from me, but I want to start that trend."

KING OF CORVALLIS: Bazzana played 3 collegiate seasons at Oregon State. The left-handed hitter set many school records, including career marks for: hits (251), doubles (52), home runs (45), total bases (460), stolen bases (66), and walks (180). His 36 stolen bases in 2023 also set a single-season school record, and he helped lead the Beavers to a pair of NCAA Super Regionals appearances in 2022 and 2024. **Bazzana** was a 3-time 1st Team All-Pac-12 honoree, while being named an All-American by multiple organizations in each of his last 2 years at Oregon State. Additionally, he played for the Corvallis Knights of the West Coast League in 2021. Bazzana had a remarkable season, leading the league in: batting average (.429, then-singleseason league record), hits (81), runs (46), triples (5, tied), slugging percentage (.593), OPS (1.064), and total bases (112) en route to WCL MVP honors and Corvallis's 5th straight league championship.

A SEASON TO REMEMBER: This year, Bazzana ranked top-10 in Division I in: walks (76, 2nd), on-base percentage (.568, 2nd), slugging percentage (.911, 2nd), runs (84, T-6th), home runs (28, T-7th), total bases (195, T-7th), and batting average (.407, 8th). His 84 runs, 28 home runs, and .911 slugging percentage, and 195 total bases were all Oregon State single-season school records, while his 70 walks tied a single-season school record. Bazzana was named the 2024 Pac-12 Player of the Year, while being recognized as a 1st Team All-American by the ABCA, Baseball America, the College Baseball Foundation, D1baseball.com, the NCBWA, and Perfect Game. He was also a Golden Spikes Award finalist (best amateur baseball player in U.S.) and Dick Howser Trophy semifinalist (national college baseball player of the year).

BAZZANA TAKES THE CAPE: Bazzana dominated in his lone season in the Cape Cod Baseball League (CCBL) last year. He was named the 2023 Cape Cod Baseball League Pat Sorenti MVP after winning the league's batting title with a .375 average. Bazzana also tallied 51 hits, 33 runs, 6 doubles, 6 home runs, 31 RBI, 14 stolen bases, and a 1.037 OPS in 33 regular-season

A PLAYER BEYOND HIS YEARS: When he was 3, Bazzana was playing baseball against 6-year-olds. Then, 12 years later, he was already playing professionally in the Australian Baseball League at just 15 years old. "I was always competitive," Bazzana told ESPN's Jeff Passan. "That's the one thing that I think was the base for me to go far in whatever I was pursuing: a competitive nature to where I was going to find a way to be a little bit better than the next guy or the guy next to me or whoever I was competing with '

THE ATHLETIC AUSTRALIAN: During his time at Turramurra High School in Australia, Bazzana represented Team Australia in the 2019 U18 Baseball World Cup. He recorded 6 hits and 4 RBI in 9 games. Bazzana also played cricket for his high school team, captaining his squad to its first state championship in school history. He also played basketball, soccer, and rugby for Turramurra, while participating in track and field (100m dash, long jump, and high jump) as well.

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING

Chris Antonetti, Cleveland Guardians President of Baseball Operations: "We view him to be a dynamic player. He's a guy that makes really good swing decisions, controls the strike zone really well, rarely swings and misses, and can really impact the baseball. And we think he's got a chance to impact the game in a variety of ways.

But as impressive as he is as an athlete and as a player, he's just as impressive, or more impressive, as a person. He has been relentless, I think from the time he was 3 years old, to take advantage of every resource available to him to become the best baseball player he can possibly be. And I think it's a testament to his hard work and the support system that he's had around him to be able to get to this point."

Rob Cerfolio, Cleveland Guardians Director of Player Development: "We are incredibly excited to welcome Travis to the organization and for him to make his Minor League debut with the Captains. Travis' on-field successes over his college career speak for themselves but we are even more impressed with the type of person he is and his dedication to maximizing his ability. We look forward to partnering with him on future growth both on and off the field."

MLB Pipeline Draft Profile: "A native of Sydney, Australia, Bazzana came to the United States and immediately made an impact with a .902 OPS as a freshman. He upped that to 1.122 with 11 homers and 36 steals a year later, then raised his profile even more when he won the Cape Cod League batting title (.375) and MVP Award, putting him near the top of most Draft boards. The left-handed-hitting infielder is compact and strong with plenty of bat speed. He has an advanced approach at the plate with a ton of raw power he taps into, though he can occasionally be susceptible to offspeed stuff on the outer half. He's proven he can hit lefties as well as righties. A plus runner, he's a legitimate base-stealing threat. While some worry about where he can play defensively, some scouts think he's going to be just fine at second base. His athleticism helps him have good range, he has enough arm for the spot and he can turn the double play effectively. A second-base profile isn't one often seen at the top of a Draft, but the conviction in his bat is so strong, he's going to get a lot of attention in

Baseball America Draft Profile: "Bazzana has put on a hitting clinic in three years at Oregon State. The Australia native played in the college summer West Coast League as an 18-year-old in 2021 and excelled, setting the stage for a strong freshman season in 2022. Bazzana hit over .300 in each college season and improved year over year, culminating in a 2024 campaign in which he battled Georgia's Charlie Condon for the best overall offensive season in the country. A 6-foot, 199-pound lefthanded hitter and second baseman, Bazzana's offensive profile is built around his elite bat-to-ball skills. He has an unusual-looking swing with a deep bat tip behind his shoulder and a sizable leg kick, but he has always found the barrel at a high clip and produced an 84% contact rate in his three seasons with the Beavers. He pairs that skill with a savvy approach at the plate and strong swing decisions, helping him walk more than he struck out in his career. In 2024, his excellent 25.8% walk rate ranked second only to Nick Kurtz for the best among Division I hitters. Bazzana added more home run power in his draft season as well, going from 11 home runs in 2023 to 28 in 2024, with a corresponding increase in his exit velocity data. Bazzana's swing seems optimized to maximize the power he does have, and while he's nearly maxed-out physically, he might be the sort of player who always makes the most of his natural raw power. Bazzana is a plus runner and strong athlete who should be able to play second base, though he frequently throws with an odd sidearm slot that some scouts question. He could be athletic enough to play center field as well. Bazzana has all-star upside and is the best prospect from Oregon State since Adley Rutschman in 2019—with a chance to match his No. 1 overall status on draft day.'

Oregon State Head Coach Mitch Canham (via The Oregonian/OregonLive's Joe Freeman): "He wants everything. Scouting reports, data, video. He doesn't get locked up mentally by all the analytics. He wants them all."

Trent Oeltien, former Australian MLB outfielder and current mentor to Bazzana (via ESPN's Jeff Passan): ""He understands that he's doing this for the whole country. And he knows all the kids are now looking up to him and want to be in **Travis** Bazzana's shoes. He remembers where he comes from, and he's very proud of where he did come from, and he's driving to really change the game of international students and Australians to follow behind him."

Steven Kwan, Cleveland Guardians left fielder, 2024 American League All-Star starter, and former Oregon State Beaver (during Captains rehab media availability on 5/25): "He's a leader. He's playing for something bigger than himself, which I think is really cool. He plays fundamental baseball, and I think that's a really cool thing."

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. In his 1st MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4th player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1st career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1st player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1st MLB pitch on September 2, 2006. Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

LHP Raymond Burgos: On Monday, June 24, LHP Raymond Burgos made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. Burgos made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

INF Angel Martínez: On Saturday, June 22, INF Angel Martínez made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Toronto Blue Jays. He started at designated hitter and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-3 with 1 strikeout. Martínez played 77 regular-season games for the Captains in 2022, hitting .288 with 81 hits, 17 doubles, 3 triples, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 10 stolen bases, and an .861 OPS.

INF/OF Daniel Schneemann: On Sunday, June 2, INF Daniel Schneemann made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2nd base and batted 8th in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

1B/OF Trenton Brooks: On Tuesday, May 28, 1B/OF Trenton Brooks made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1st base and batted 9th in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. Brooks played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Tuesday, May 21, OF Johnathan Rodríguez made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. Rodríguez played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, RHP Cade Smith made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. Smith made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
