Schofield-Sam** was unable to field a **Yerlin Confidan** grounder cleanly as **Connor Burns** scored from third, lifting Dayton to victory on a rainy Thursday night at Day Air Ballpark. **Jake Garland** tossed five scoreless innings in a no-decision in the losing cause.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play the Dragons through Sunday, enjoy a day off on June 9, and then return to Michigan's state capital to welcome in the archival West Michigan Whitecaps for a six-game series at Jackson Field from June 10 - June 15.

At 3 p.m., Miami (pitcher **Jake Garland**) played Louisville. At 6 p.m., Florida State plays Oregon State (pitcher **Jake Pfennigs**). Tomorrow, West Virginia plays LSU (third baseman **Tommy White**), Tennessee (outfielder **Jared Dickey**) plays Arkansas (pitcher **Mark Adamiak**), and UTSA (head coach **Pat Hallmark**, who played for the Lugnuts in 1996-97) plays UCLA.

A Gauge on Gage: 2025 Lugnuts Opening Day starter **Gage Jump** jumped into Baseball America's Top 100 prospects, going from being unrated to No. 71, and was named Minor League Baseball's May Pitcher of the Month for the Texas League, going 4-0 in four starts with a 0.72 ERA: 25 innings, 15 hits, 2 runs, 5 walks, 29 strikeouts, 0.80 WHIP, .176 avg. Overall for the year, Jump is 8-1 with a 1.61 ERA and 74 K / 10 BB in 56 innings. He starts tonight for the RockHounds vs. San Antonio at 8:05 p.m.

The Future is Now: The Athletics blasted the Minnesota Twins and former Cedar Rapids Kernel David Festa yesterday, 14-3, with home runs from the A's first-round draft picks in 2020 (**Tyler Soderstrom**, 2 HR, grand slam), 2021 (**Max Muncy**) and 2023 (**Jacob Wilson**). Soderstrom and Muncy were teammates in Lansing in 2022 and Wilson spent 23 games with the Lugnuts in 2023.

Plunked: T.J. Schofield-Sam was hit by yet another pitch yesterday, giving him a team-leading 14 for the year, trailing only Cedar Rapids' Khadim Diaw (16) for the league lead. In 98 games last year, Schofield-Sam was hit by a career high 19 pitches, putting him on pace to comfortably surpass that mark. Weirder still, he's been hit in bunches: three times in four games between April 12-18, three times in six games between May 14-20, twice on May 27, and now four times in his last five games, May 31-June 5. Because of all of the HBPs, Schofield-Sam has a .420 OBP to go along with his league-leading .350 batting average.

Midwest League Outlook: With 12 games remaining in the MWL's first half, first place West Michigan leads Lansing by eight-games in the East Division, 38-16 to 30-24. Next week, the Whitecaps travel to Lansing for a pivotal six-game series before the Lugnuts wrap up the first half at Quad Cities while West Michigan hosts Wisconsin.

In a Nutshell: Youngest player on the roster... **Pipeline's No. 12 A's prospect / No. 4 pitching prospect** (behind Mason Barnett, Luis Morales and Jack Perkins); their grades: Fastball 55, Slider 55, Changeup 50, Control 50, Overall 45... **Fangraphs' No. 7 A's prospect**; grades present/future - Fastball 45/55, Slider 55/60, Changeup 40/55, Command 25/50, sitting 90-94 and touching 96 mph.

Last Time Out: On May 31 vs. Beloit, Echavarria set a new career high (the third time in his last four starts he had set a new career high) with 6 1/3 innings on 90 pitches, limiting the Sky Carp to three hits and two runs, one earned, with two walks and a career high-tying seven strikeouts... departed with the Lugnuts trailing 2-1, but the offense rallied with four runs in the 7th (Schofield-Sam grand slam) and three in the 8th for an 8-2 win.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

19-year-old Steven Echavarria is part of an exclusive club: players who suited up for the Lugnuts as teenagers. Future Major Leaguers include 19-year-old Max Muncy, who joined the Nuts for the final 42 games of 2022; 19-year-old Gabriel Moreno, who homered in his first Lugnuts at-bat in 2019; Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. and Bo Bichette, who were 18 and 19 respectively when they dominated the 2017 Midwest League and appeared in the Futures Game; 18-year-old Carlos Beltrán, who was in the Lugnuts' very first Opening Day lineup on April 5, 1996; and the 1999 Lugnuts teenage duo of 19-year-old Corey Patterson, who was named the Midwest League Prospect of the Year, and 18-year-old Carlos Zambrano, who won 13 games and worked 153 1/3 innings.

Path to Lansing: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... vs. right-handers: .306/.386/.387, 1 HR, 5 GiDP... vs. left-handers: .316/.431/.474, 3 HR, 1 GiDP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
