### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The 2026 season has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.

- After an 0-4 start to the year, the Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, then went 3-11 from April 22 to May 8 ... Omaha won 10 of 15 from May 9 to 24 but have gone 3-8 in the last 11 games since May 25.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Omaha has been under .500 following 35 of their last 36 games (since April 24) and the Storm Chasers have spent just 18 days at or above .500.

#### SERIES SPEAKING

Last week's series loss was Omaha's 3rd of the season and the team's first since dropping back-to-back series to Toledo and Louisville from April 21 to May 3 ... the Chasers will need to win today to force a split and avoid a second straight series loss.

- The Chasers have won 5 of their 10 week-long series this season - taking series against Buffalo (4-2), Iowa (3-2), Indianapolis (4-2), Toledo (4-2) and St. Paul (4-2).
- In 4 of this season's 5 series wins, Omaha won the series opener ... in 3 of the series wins - against Buffalo, Toledo and St. Paul - the clubs split the first four games before the Storm Chasers took both remaining contests to claim the series.

#### COMEBACK KIDS

The Storm Chasers have 17 comeback wins this season, tied for the 5th-most in the International League and tied 8th at the Triple-A level.

- Prior to Friday, Omaha's previous 10 wins (from May 13 to June 4) had all been comeback wins (games the team won despite trailing at some point in the game) ... Friday's 11-2 win was the first game the Storm Chasers won without trailing at any point since a 9-0 win on May 10 @ Indianapolis ... Friday was also the first time the Chasers won by more than 2 runs since an 11-3 win on May 21 @ St. Paul.
- On the flip side, Omaha has lost 18 games in which the team led, tied 2nd-most in the league and tied 4th-most in Triple-A ... the Storm Chasers have led at some point in 6 of their last 9 losses, including a brief lead before last night's walk-off.
- In the last 26 games (since May 9), Omaha is 13-13 ... they have trailed at some point in 10 of 13 wins and led at some point in 8 of 13 losses, meaning 18 of Omaha's last 26 games have been a comeback win for one of the two teams.

#### CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.

- Omaha's 83.1% success rate (64-for-77) ranks 4th in the IL and 6th in Triple-A ... however, the team has the 11th-most steals in the 20-team IL.
- John Rave leads Omaha in steals (14) ... Gavin Cross has 11 steals in as many tries, the 2nd-most steals in the IL without being caught ... Kameron Misner has swiped 9 bags, while Drew Waters has 6 steals and Peyton Wilson has 5.

#### COLUMBUS DAY SALE

The Chasers have had good success against the Columbus Clippers, specifically at Huntington Park since Omaha joined the International League in 2021.

- Since joining the International League in 2021, Omaha has won 56 of 95 games against the Clippers (.589) ... it is the club's 3rd-best winning percentage against any IL opponent (min. 12 games, of 13 matchups) and 14th-best among all IL team matchups with at least 80 games against a single opponent (of 55 matchups).
- At Huntington Park, the Chasers are 33-26 (.559) since 2021 ... it is Omaha's 2nd-best road winning percentage at any IL ballpark (min. 12 games, of 10 matchups) and 15th-best among visiting IL teams with at least 50 games at a single park (of 38 matchups).

#### PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

- The Storm Chasers are seeing 3.967 pitches per plate appearance, 6th-most in the International League and 9th at the Triple-A level.
- Among 226 Triple-A players with 150+ plate appearances this year, Kameron Misner is 5th in pitches seen/PA (4.410) while John Rave ranks 10th (4.373).

HENRY'S HUNCH

- ROAD TO OMAHA:** Williams was assigned to Omaha on May 12 for his second stint with the Storm Chasers after making his Triple-A debut last May ... he allowed 9 ER in 8.0 innings (10.13 ERA) across 2 starts at Triple-A last year (May 27 to June 5) ... in 20 appearances (18 starts) after returning to Double-A, he posted a 4.16 ERA (45 ER in 97.1 IP) for the Naturals.
- STRENGTH AND STAMINA:** Williams got off to a hot start in 2026, allowing 2 earned runs or less while going 5.0+ innings in 4 of his last 6 starts at Double-A ... following his stretch with the Storm Chasers in 2025, Williams went back to Northwest Arkansas (AA) and pitched 5.0+ innings in 13 of his last 18 starts at Double-A.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, JUNE 2 @ COLUMBUS

- Made his 3rd Triple-A start of the season in the series opener against Columbus ... allowed an RBI double in the 1st inning and an RBI single in the 2nd inning ... retired 7 straight hitters between the 2nd and 4th innings, working back-to-back perfect frames in the 3rd and 4th ... allowed a walk and single to begin the bottom of the 5th inning, then Andrew Pérez took over for him ... struck out a season-high 6 batters.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Made 7 starts for Northwest Arkansas before his promotion to Omaha ... worked a 4.72 ERA (18 ER in 34.1 IP) with a 1.37 WHIP ... 3 of his 7 starts went 5.0+ innings with 1 or less runs allowed.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025**  
 Spent most of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also made a pair of starts for Omaha ... among Royals Minor League pitchers, ranked 5th in innings pitched (115.1), tied 6th in strikeouts (106) and tied 6th in starts (21).  
 Opened the year with the Naturals and threw 5 quality starts over his first 8 appearances ... made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers on May 28 vs. St. Paul (MIN) ... in 2 starts for Omaha and allowed 9 ER in 8.0 IP (10.13 ERA) before returning to Northwest Arkansas on June 6 to finish his season.  
 In Northwest Arkansas, totaled 21 appearances (19 starts) and worked a 4.24 ERA (51 ER in 108.1 IP) with 100 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP throughout the season ... named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for his start on July 2 @ Springfield (STL), tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit and 7 strikeouts

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire **2024** season with Quad Cities (A+) ... appeared in 22 games (21 starts) with a 3.68 ERA (42 ER in 102.2 IP) and 92 strikeouts at High-A ... 7 of his 21 starts were scoreless, including his last 3 of the season, for a career-high 21.0-inning scoreless streak that stretched into April **2025**.
- Split the **2023** season between the Royals and Padres organizations ... opened the year with San Diego's Single-A affiliate, the Lake Elsinore Storm, but the Padres traded him to Kansas City at the trade deadline ... after the trade, made 5 starts for Columbia (A) and posted a 3.38 ERA (9 ER in 24.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts for the Fireflies..
- Made his professional debut at the start of the **2023** season with Lake Elsinore after San Diego drafted him in the 3rd round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Duke University ... made 12 starts for the Storm before his trade to the Royals, working a 5.74 ERA (27 ER in 42.1 IP) with 40 strikeouts for Lake Elsinore ... missed the **2022** season as he recovered from Tommy John surgery.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Attended Duke University (**2019-2021**), where he appeared in 9 games (7 starts) over 3 seasons with the Blue Devils (ACC), going 3-3 with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER in 37.2 IP) and 45 strikeouts ... only pitched one full season in Durham (**2021**) due to the COVID-19 pandemic shortening his freshman campaign (**2020**) and Tommy John surgery in December **2021**, keeping him out of action his junior year (**2022**).
- Lettered in both baseball and basketball all 4 years at Darien High School (CT) ... was a team captain for the basketball team his senior season.
- Father David played collegiate baseball at Davidson College from **1987** to **1991**.
