#### JUNK DOMINATES IN 2-1 WIN

Janson Junk struck out a career-high 10 batters on Wednesday in Jacksonville's 2-1 victory over Charlotte. The right-hander worked 6.0 innings, yielding just one hit without walking a batter. Agustín Ramírez started the scoring with a solo home run in the fourth inning. Later in the inning, Brian Navarreto collected an RBI single to make it 2-0. The Knights did not breakthrough until the eighth inning on a Tristan Gray sacrifice fly. Austin Roberts and Christian Roa combined for 3.0 innings of one-run ball out of the bullpen.

#### JUNKYARD DOG

Janson Junk became the first Jacksonville hurler in 2025 to log more than 5.0 innings in a start, and he did so in a sparkling way. The Federal Way, Wash., native yielded only one hit and fanned a career-high 10 hitters, a feat that only one Jumbo Shrimp pitcher was able to accomplish last season (Yonny Chirinos, August 24, 2024 at Nashville). The last time a Jacksonville pitcher fanned 10 in 6.0 shutout innings while ceding just one hit was Edward Cabrera, who did so on August 12, 2023 vs. Norfolk.

#### THE TWO TOWERS

After winning two of three in Nashville, the Jumbo Shrimp took four of six contests against Worcester. Thus, this marks just the fourth time since 2005 (2009, 2013, 2021) that the club started a season with consecutive series victories. Each of those prior three teams had winning records, with the 2009 squad going 82-58 (.586) en route to a Southern League championship, the 2013 Jacksonville Suns posting a 73-63 (.537) mark and the 2021 team going 75-55 (.577). Only the 2021 Jumbo Shrimp won each of their first three sets of the season, starting 13-5 (.722).

#### MAXIMO OVERDRIVE

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Maximo Acosta** is off to an absurd start to the 2025 season. In 11 games thus far, the native of Caracas, Venezuela has recorded five multi-hit contests and two multi-RBI affairs. Acosta is 14-for-44 in total at the plate, slashing .318/.400/.409/.809 with one double, one home run, six RBIs, six walks, seven runs scored and four stolen bases. He is tied for second in the IL in hits (14), tied for ninth in steals (4) and 23rd in batting average (.318).

#### MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in nine of their last 10 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have recorded two games with five stolen bases (March 29 at Nashville, April 5 vs. Worcester, April 9 vs. Charlotte), a mark the club reached only twice in the prior three seasons. Jacksonville currently leads the International League with 31 stolen bases. Moreover, their 91.2 percent success rate ranks second in the IL. Jakob Marsee's 12 stolen bases are double the two players tied in second with six walks. That 12-steal figure is also equal to or more than the totals for 21 Triple-A teams.

#### 'PEN PALS

Jacksonville starting pitchers have gone at least 5.0 innings just five times in 12 games. The club's bullpen has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.21 ERA, the second-best such mark in the International League. The club's bullpen also ranks tied for second in the circuit in strikeouts (67), third in batting average against (.168) and fifth in fewest hits allowed (31). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 53.0 innings through 11 games (4.8 per game), fifth-most in the IL and just 3.2 away from first-place Norfolk.

#### **BOOM OR BUST**

With little in-between thus far in 2025, Jacksonville's offense has either been extraordinary or has really struggled depending on the game. In three of their 10 contests thus far, the Jumbo Shrimp have plated double-digit runs - something they accomplished only 10 times in 149 games last season. However, in their other eight contests, Jacksonville has plated a total of 17 runs.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jumbo Shrimp starters rank first in the International League in fewest walks (6), second in batting average against (.187), fourth in ERA (2.54) and tied for fourth in fewest hits allowed (31)... Both **Declan Cronin** and **Jesús Sánchez** will begin injury rehab assignments tonight against Charlotte. Cronin is scheduled to start the contest on the mound with Sánchez hitting third as the DH.



-Following the 2023 season, Piña elected free agency. He signed with the Philadelphia Phillies as a minor league free agent and spent the 2024 campaign between Double-A Reading and Triple-A Lehigh Valley.

#### 2024 SEASON

- -Piña posted major platoon splits; While he held right-handed hitters to a .195/.245/.312/.557 batting line in 249 plate appearances, left-handed batters hit .324/.366/.591/.957 against him over 303 plate appearances.
