The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators on Friday night. It is the fourth-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and fourth-of-six games in Reading. The Fightin Phils went 7-5 against Harrisburg in 2024, including a 4-2 record at home and 3-3 record on the road. Following this week, the Fightin Phils head to Harrisburg from June 3-8. Harrisburg leads the season-series 2-1. **Game 22 Recap**The Fightin Phils rallied to a 5-4 win over Harrisburg on Thursday night, snapping a season-long 10-game losing streak. Jean Cabrera started and allowed two runs on two hits over five innings, with four strikeouts. Braeden Fausnaught pitched the final-four innings in relief and allowed two runs on four hits, with

seven strikeouts, earning the win. Leandro Pineda hit his first home run of the season in the first inning and Robert Moore hit a two-run home run in the fifth inning, his team-leading third of the season. Andrick Nava also had a big RBI double, his first double of the season.

#### Back in the Win Column

With their win on Thursday night, the Fightin Phils snapped their 10-game losing streak. It was the Fightin Phils longest losing streak since losing eight in a row from July 22-30, of the 2022 season. It was Reading's first 10+ game losing streak since dropping 12 in a row from June 17 to 29, of 2014.

#### Miller Gets on Base

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller extended his season-best on-base streak to 15 games on Wednesday night. Over the on-base streak, Miller has a .343 onbase percentage. Miller's 15-game on-base streak leads the Fightin Phils and is currently the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League.

#### Awesome Anthony

Keaton Anthony hit his team-leading seventh double of the season on Tuesday night. Entering play tonight, Anthony is tied for fourth in the Eastern League in doubles, with his seven two baggers. Anthony additionally is on an eight-game hitting streak and 13-game on-base streak. Over his eight-game hitting streak, Anthony is slashing .310/.382/.379 (.761 OPS), along with two runs, two doubles and four RBI.

#### A Look at Some Numbers

Through 21 games this season, Reading has scored first in nine games. But, in those games, the Fighitn Phils hold just a 2-8 record. Through the first six innings of games this season, Reading has a -5 run differential, and in innings 7-9 the R-Phils' run differential is -23.

#### Moore Please

Robert Moore hit his team leading third home run and added his team-best 14th RBI on Thursday night. Moore is currently tied for ninth in the Eastern League in RBI. His home run on Thursday night was his first homer from the right-handed side of the plate since the 2023 season, as all nine of Moore's home runs last season, and his first two this season, were from the left side for the switch hitter. Moore also leads Reading in multi-RBI games with five.

#### Mashing Mendez

Hendry Mendez turned in one of his best games of the season on Tuesday night. Mendez had three hits, one run, a double and two RBI. Entering play today, Mendez leads the Fightin Phils in hits, average and runs scored. He also leads Reading in multi-hit games with seven and three-hit games with three. Mendez stayed hot on Wednesday when he had two more hits and scored two runs, and he now owns back-to-back multi-hit games.

#### Hitters Park

FirstEnergy Stadium is known as a hitters park and the Fightin Phils have the numbers to back that up. Over 12 home games this season, Reading has hit 13 home runs, which is tied for second in the Eastern League for home numeruns. When on the road, the Fightin Phils have hit just two home runs across 10 games, which is the least amount of road home runs in the league.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

May 2, 1970: At Reading, Greg Luzinski hits his first Double-A home run, a blast that reportedly lands five feet shy of the brick wall in left field, an estimated 500 feet from home plate. Reading beats Manchester, 7-3, in a game that is called in the 6th inning due to rain.

#### Coming from the Capital

Harrisburg enters tonight with an 11-13 record, sitting tied for fourth place in the Eastern League Southwest Division. In 2024, the Senators finished with a 68-70 record, which was the third best record in the Southwest Division, and didn't qualify for the playoffs. Harrisburg's roster features seven of the Nationals' top-30 prospects: Jarlin Susana (2), Cade Cavalli (7), Daylen Lile (9), Cayden Wallace (10), Yohandy Morales (12), Marquis Grissom Jr. (23) and Kevin Made (27).

#### Throwing for the Senators

Righty Kyle Luckham makes the start tonight for Harrisburg. Between Rochester (AAA) and Harrisburg this season, Luckham is 1-1, with a 2.59 ERA (24.1 IP, 25 H, 9 BB, 16 SO). Luckham last pitched on Apr. 26 for Rochester at Buffalo. He took a no-decision, allowing no runs on six hits over five innings, with two walks and three strikeouts. Luckham made the first four starts of the season for Harrisburg, was assigned to Rochester on Apr. 26 and back to Harrisburg on Apr. 29. Luckham spent most of 2024 with Harrisburg, but also made four starts for Rochester. In total, he went 6-10, with a 5.06 ERA. He faced Reading three times in 2024. The 25-year old was drafted by the Nationals in the 15th round of the 2022 draft out of Arizona State.


