SOUND BITE

On this date in 2023, The Sounds lost 19-2 to the Columbus Clippers in a game that included a 44 minute delay. Janson Junk allowed nine earned runs and only recorded one out in his start. The soldout crowd of 10, 704 got to witness Nashville get battered for 18 hits and saw two position players (Payton Henry & Patrick Dorrian) combine for 4.0 innings pitched.

Home Sweet Home: The Sounds and Redbirds finally meet in Nashville after playing all 15 games this season. The teams will play a three-game series and meet again in Nashville from September 10-15. The Sounds have played 36 home games compared to 48 on the road. They have played the least amount of home games in all of Triple-A with Omaha (39 games) as the only other team with

Dorrian has a multi-hit game in three of his last five after only having five during his previous 33

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 726-624 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,318-2,144 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).

LAST OUTING: Hall 3.0 innings and threw 62 pitches at Jacksonville on June 29, which were both high's for him during his rehab stint.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Hall has faced the Redbirds six times (three in 2022 and three in 2023). All six came while pitching for Norfolk with his most recent outings coming on August 16 & 18, 2023 where he tossed 1.0 scoreless innings in both outings. In his outings on August 23, 2023 and July 26, 2022 he allowed a combined 12 runs in 2.1 innings of work.
